kindle a burning <u>23\_ISA\_10\_16</u># Therefore shall the Lord, the Lord of hosts, send among his fat ones leanness; and under his glory he shall kindle a burning like the burning of a fire.

kindle a fire 30\_AMO\_01\_14 # But I will kindle a fire in the wall of Rabbah, and it shall devour the palaces thereof, with shouting in the day of battle, with a tempest in the day of the whirlwind:

kindle a fire 26\_EZE\_20\_47 # And say to the forest of the south, Hear the word of the LORD; Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will kindle a fire in thee, and it shall devour every green tree in thee, and every dry tree: the flaming flame shall not be quenched, and all faces from the south to the north shall be burned therein.

kindle a fire <u>23\_ISA\_50\_11</u># Behold, all ye that kindle a fire, that compass [yourselves] about with sparks: walk in the light of your fire, and in the sparks [that] ye have kindled. This shall ye have of mine hand; ye shall lie down in sorrow.

kindle a fire 24\_JER\_17\_27 # But if ye will not hearken unto me to hallow the sabbath day, and not to bear a burden, even entering in at the gates of Jerusalem on the sabbath day; then will I kindle a fire in the gates thereof, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall not be quenched.

kindle a fire <u>24\_JER\_21\_14</u> # But I will punish you according to the fruit of your doings, saith the LORD: and I will kindle a fire in the forest thereof, and it shall devour all things round about it.

kindle a fire 24 JER 43 12 # And I will kindle a fire in the houses of the gods of Egypt; and he shall burn them, and carry them away captives: and he shall array himself with the land of Egypt, as a shepherd putteth on his garment; and he shall go forth from thence in peace.

kindle a fire <u>24\_JER\_49\_27</u># And I will kindle a fire in the wall of Damascus, and it shall consume the palaces of Benhadad.

kindle a fire <u>24\_JER\_50\_32</u> # And the most proud shall stumble and fall, and none shall raise him up: and I will kindle a fire in his cities, and it shall devour all round about him.

kindle fire on 39\_MAL\_01\_10 # Who [is there] even among you that would shut the doors [for nought]? neither do ye kindle [fire] on mine altar for nought. I have no pleasure in you, saith the LORD of hosts, neither will I accept an offering at your hand.

kindle in the <u>23\_ISA\_09\_18</u># For wickedness burneth as the fire: it shall devour the briers and thorns, and shall kindle in the thickets of the forest, and they shall mount up [like] the lifting up of smoke.

kindle in them <u>31\_OBA\_01\_18</u># And the house of Jacob shall be a fire, and the house of Joseph a flame, and the house of Esau for stubble, and they shall kindle in them, and devour them; and there shall not be [any] remaining of the house of Esau; for the LORD hath spoken [it].

kindle it <u>23\_ISA\_30\_33</u> # For Tophet [is] ordained of old; yea, for the king it is prepared; he hath made [it] deep [and] large: the pile thereof [is] fire and much wood; the breath of the LORD, like a stream of brimstone, doth kindle it.

kindle meat offerings 24\_JER\_33\_18 # Neither shall the priests the Levites want a man before me to offer

burnt offerings, and to kindle meat offerings, and to do sacrifice continually.

kindle no fire 02\_EXO\_35\_03 # Ye shall kindle no fire throughout your habitations upon the sabbath day.

kindle strife 20 PRO 26 21 # [As] coals [are] to burning coals, and wood to fire; so [is] a contentious man to kindle strife.

kindle the fire <u>26\_EZE\_24\_10</u># Heap on wood, kindle the fire, consume the flesh, and spice it well, and let the bones be burned.

kindle the fire 24 JER\_07\_18 # The children gather wood, and the fathers kindle the fire, and the women knead [their] dough, to make cakes to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto other gods, that they may provoke me to anger.

kindle upon thee <u>23\_ISA\_43\_02</u> # When thou passest through the waters, I [will be] with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.

kindled a fire <u>44\_ACT\_28\_02</u> # And the barbarous people showed us no little kindness: for they kindled a fire, and received us every one, because of the present rain, and because of the cold.

kindled a fire <u>24\_JER\_17\_04</u> # And thou, even thyself, shalt discontinue from thine heritage that I gave thee; and I will cause thee to serve thine enemies in the land which thou knowest not: for ye have kindled a fire in mine anger, [which] shall burn for ever.

kindled a fire 25\_LAM\_04\_11# The LORD hath accomplished his fury; he hath poured out his fierce anger, and hath kindled a fire in Zion, and it hath devoured the foundations thereof.

kindled a fire <u>42\_LUK\_22\_55</u># And when they had kindled a fire in the midst of the hall, and were set down together, Peter sat down among them.

kindled against Amaziah <u>14\_2CH\_25\_15</u># Wherefore the anger of the LORD was kindled against Amaziah, and he sent unto him a prophet, which said unto him, Why hast thou sought after the gods of the people, which could not deliver their own people out of thine hand?

kindled against Balaam <u>04\_NUM\_24\_10</u> # And Balak's anger was kindled against Balaam, and he smote his hands together: and Balak said unto Balaam, I called thee to curse mine enemies, and, behold, thou hast altogether blessed [them] these three times.

kindled against David <u>09\_1SA\_17\_28</u># And Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle.

kindled against his <u>23\_ISA\_05\_25</u> # Therefore is the anger of the LORD kindled against his people, and he hath stretched forth his hand against them, and hath smitten them: and the hills did tremble, and their carcases [were] torn in the midst of the streets. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

kindled against his <u>19\_PSA\_106\_40</u> # Therefore was the wrath of the LORD kindled against his people, insomuch that he abhorred his own inheritance.

kindled against Israel <u>12\_2KI\_13\_03</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he delivered them into the hand of Hazael king of Syria, and into the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael, all [their] days.

kindled against Israel <u>10\_2SA\_24\_01</u># And again the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.

kindled against Israel <u>04\_NUM\_25\_03</u># And Israel joined himself unto Baalpeor: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel.

kindled against Israel <u>04\_NUM\_32\_13</u># And the LORD'S anger was kindled against Israel, and he made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation, that had done evil in the sight of the LORD, was consumed.

kindled against Jacob <u>19 PSA\_78\_21</u> # Therefore the LORD heard [this], and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel;

kindled against Jonathan <u>09\_1SA\_20\_30</u> # Then Saul's anger was kindled against Jonathan, and he said unto him, Thou son of the perverse rebellious [woman], do not I know that thou hast chosen the son of Jesse to thine own confusion, and unto the confusion of thy mother's nakedness?

kindled against Judah <u>14\_2CH\_25\_10</u># Then Amaziah separated them, [to wit], the army that was come to him out of Ephraim, to go home again: wherefore their anger was greatly kindled against Judah, and they returned home in great anger.

kindled against Judah <u>12 2KI 23 26 # Notwithstanding the LORD</u> turned not from the fierceness of his great wrath, wherewith his anger was kindled against Judah, because of all the provocations that Manasseh had provoked him withal.

kindled against Moses <u>02\_EXO\_04\_14</u> # And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and he said, [Is] not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his heart.

kindled against Rachel <u>01\_GEN\_30\_02</u> # And Jacob's anger was kindled against Rachel: and he said, [Am] I in God's stead, who hath withheld from thee the fruit of the womb?

kindled against the <u>10\_2SA\_12\_05</u># And David's anger was greatly kindled against the man; and he said to Nathan, [As] the LORD liveth, the man that hath done this [thing] shall surely die:

kindled against the <u>06\_JOS\_07\_01</u># But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel.

kindled against the <a href="Mailto:04\_NUM\_11\_33">04\_NUM\_11\_33</a> # And while the flesh [was] yet between their teeth, ere it was chewed, the wrath of the LORD was kindled against the people, and the LORD smote the people with a very great plague.

kindled against the <u>38\_ZEC\_10\_03</u> # Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.

kindled against thee <u>05\_DEU\_06\_15</u># [For the LORD thy God [is] a jealous God among you] lest the anger of the LORD thy God be kindled against thee, and destroy thee from off the face of the earth.

kindled against thee <u>18\_JOB\_42\_07</u> # And it was [so], that after the LORD had spoken these words unto Job, the LORD said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is kindled against thee, and against thy two friends: for ye have not spoken of me [the thing that is] right, as my servant Job [hath].

kindled against them <u>05\_DEU\_31\_17</u># Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them; so that they will say in that day, Are not these evils come upon us, because our God [is] not among us?

kindled against them <u>28\_HOS\_08\_05</u> # Thy calf, O Samaria, hath cast [thee] off; mine anger is kindled against them: how long [will it be] ere they attain to innocency?

kindled against them <u>04\_NUM\_12\_09</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against them; and he departed.

kindled against this <u>12\_2KI\_22\_17</u> # Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched.

kindled against this <u>05\_DEU\_29\_27</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book:

kindled against us 12\_2KI\_22\_13 # Go ye, inquire of the LORD for me, and for the people, and for all Judah, concerning the words of this book that is found: for great [is] the wrath of the LORD that is kindled against us, because our fathers have not hearkened unto the words of this book, to do according unto all that which is written concerning us.

kindled against us <u>19\_PSA\_124\_03</u># Then they had swallowed us up quick, when their wrath was kindled against us:

kindled against Uzza 13\_1CH\_13\_10 # And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God.

kindled against Uzzah <u>10\_2SA\_06\_07</u> # And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God smote him there for [his] error; and there he died by the ark of God.

kindled against you <u>05\_DEU\_07\_04</u> # For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly.

kindled against you <u>05\_DEU\_11\_17</u># And [then] the LORD'S wrath be kindled against you, and he shut up the heaven, that there be no rain, and that the land yield not her fruit; and [lest] ye perish quickly from off the good land which the LORD giveth you.

kindled against you <u>06\_JOS\_23\_16</u># When ye have transgressed the covenant of the LORD your God, which he commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and ye shall perish quickly from off the good land which he hath given unto you.

kindled and he <u>07\_JUD\_14\_19</u># And the spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle. And his anger was kindled, and he went up to his father's house.

kindled and he <u>04\_NUM\_22\_27</u># And when the ass saw the angel of the LORD, she fell down under Balaam: and Balaam's anger was kindled, and he smote the ass with a staff.

kindled and the <u>04\_NUM\_11\_01</u># And [when] the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the LORD heard [it]; and his anger was kindled; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed [them that were] in the uttermost parts of the camp.

kindled because he <u>18 JOB 32 02</u> # Then was kindled the wrath of Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite, of the kindred of Ram: against Job was his wrath kindled, because he justified himself rather than God.

kindled because he <u>04\_NUM\_22\_22</u># And God's anger was kindled because he went: and the angel of the LORD stood in the way for an adversary against him. Now he was riding upon his ass, and his two servants [were] with him.

kindled because they <u>18\_JOB\_32\_03</u> # Also against his three friends was his wrath kindled, because they had found no answer, and [yet] had condemned Job.

kindled but a 19\_PSA\_02\_12 # Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish [from] the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed [are] all they that put their trust in him.

kindled by it <u>10\_2SA\_22\_09</u> # There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured: coals were kindled by it.

kindled by it 19\_PSA\_18\_08 # There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured: coals were kindled by it.

kindled fire upon 24\_JER\_11\_16# The LORD called thy name, A green olive tree, fair, [and] of goodly fruit: with the noise of a great tumult he hath kindled fire upon it, and the branches of it are broken.

kindled greatly Moses <u>04\_NUM\_11\_10</u># Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased.

kindled greatly <u>09\_1SA\_11\_06</u># And the spirit of God came upon Saul when he heard those tidings, and his anger was kindled greatly.

kindled his wrath <u>18\_JOB\_19\_11</u># He hath also kindled his wrath against me, and he counteth me unto him as [one of] his enemies.

kindled in mine <u>05\_DEU\_32\_22</u># For a fire is kindled in mine anger, and shall burn unto the lowest hell, and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains.

kindled in mine 24\_JER\_15\_14 # And I will make [thee] to pass with thine enemies into a land [which] thou knowest not: for a fire is kindled in mine anger, [which] shall burn upon you.

kindled in the <u>24\_JER\_44\_06</u># Wherefore my fury and mine anger was poured forth, and was kindled in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem; and they are wasted [and] desolate, as at this day.

kindled in their 19\_PSA\_106\_18 # And a fire was kindled in their company; the flame burned up the wicked.

kindled it it <u>26\_EZE\_20\_48</u> # And all flesh shall see that I the LORD have kindled it: it shall not be quenched.

kindled the fire <u>02\_EXO\_22\_06</u># If fire break out, and catch in thorns, so that the stacks of corn, or the standing corn, or the field, be consumed [therewith]; he that kindled the fire shall surely make restitution.

kindled the same <u>04\_NUM\_32\_10</u># And the LORD'S anger was kindled the same time, and he sware, saying,

kindled 10\_2SA\_22\_13 # Through the brightness before him were coals of fire kindled.

kindled <u>01\_GEN\_39\_19</u> # And it came to pass, when his master heard the words of his wife, which she spake unto him, saying, After this manner did thy servant to me; that his wrath was kindled.

kindled <u>18\_JOB\_32\_05</u> # When Elihu saw that [there was] no answer in the mouth of [these] three men, then his wrath was kindled.

kindled <u>07\_JUD\_09\_30</u># And when Zebul the ruler of the city heard the words of Gaal the son of Ebed, his anger was kindled.

kindled <u>03\_LEV\_10\_06</u># And Moses said unto Aaron, and unto Eleazar and unto Ithamar, his sons, Uncover not your heads, neither rend your clothes; lest ye die, and lest wrath come upon all the people: but let your brethren, the whole house of Israel, bewail the burning which the LORD hath kindled.

kindled 42\_LUK\_12\_49 # I am come to send fire on the earth; and what will I, if it be already kindled?

kindleth coals and 18\_JOB\_41\_21 # His breath kindleth coals, and a flame goeth out of his mouth.

kindleth it and 23 ISA 44 15 # Then shall it be for a man to burn: for he will take thereof, and warm himself; yea, he kindleth [it], and baketh bread; yea, he maketh a god, and worshippeth [it]; he maketh it a graven image, and falleth down thereto.

kindleth <u>59\_JAM\_03\_05</u> # Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!
