lacked for as [44 ACT 04 34](#) # Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,

lacked moisture [42 LUK 08 06](#) # And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because it lacked moisture.

lacked not one [10 2SA 17 22](#) # Then David arose, and all the people that [were] with him, and they passed over Jordan: by the morning light there lacked not one of them that was not gone over Jordan.

lacked nothing their [16 NEH 09 21](#) # Yea, forty years didst thou sustain them in the wilderness, [so that] they lacked nothing; their clothes waxed not old, and their feet swelled not.

lacked nothing [11 1KI 04 27](#) # And those officers provided victual for king Solomon, and for all that came unto king Solomon's table, every man in his month: they lacked nothing.

lacked nothing [05 DEU 02 07](#) # For the LORD thy God hath blessed thee in all the works of thy hand: he knoweth thy walking through this great wilderness: these forty years the LORD thy God [hath been] with thee; thou hast lacked nothing.

lacked with me [11 1KI 11 22](#) # Then Pharaoh said unto him, But what hast thou lacked with me, that, behold, thou seekest to go to thine own country? And he answered, Nothing: howbeit let me go in any wise.
