lodge all night <u>07_JUD_19_13</u> # And he said unto his servant, Come, and let us draw near to one of these places to lodge all night, in Gibeah, or in Ramah.

lodge and get <u>42_LUK_09_12</u> # And when the day began to wear away, then came the twelve, and said unto him, Send the multitude away, that they may go into the towns and country round about, and lodge, and get victuals: for we are here in a desert place.

lodge here that <u>07_JUD_19_09</u># And when the man rose up to depart, he, and his concubine, and his servant, his father in law, the damsel's father, said unto him, Behold, now the day draweth toward evening, I pray you tarry all night: behold, the day groweth to an end, lodge here, that thine heart may be merry; and to morrow get you early on your way, that thou mayest go home.

Lodge here this <u>04_NUM_22_08</u># And he said unto them, Lodge here this night, and I will bring you word again, as the LORD shall speak unto me: and the princes of Moab abode with Balaam.

lodge in a 23_ISA_01_08 # And the daughter of Zion is left as a cottage in a vineyard, as a lodge in a garden of cucumbers, as a besieged city.

lodge in Gibeah <u>07_JUD_19_15</u># And they turned aside thither, to go in [and] to lodge in Gibeah: and when he went in, he sat him down in a street of the city: for [there was] no man that took them into his house to lodging.

lodge in it <u>07_JUD_19_11</u> # [And] when they [were] by Jebus, the day was far spent; and the servant said unto his master, Come, I pray thee, and let us turn in into this city of the Jebusites, and lodge in it.

lodge in the <u>23_ISA_65_04</u> # Which remain among the graves, and lodge in the monuments, which eat swine's flesh, and broth of abominable [things is in] their vessels;

lodge in the <u>18_JOB_31_32</u> # The stranger did not lodge in the street: [but] I opened my doors to the traveller.

lodge in the <u>40_MAT_13_32</u># Which indeed is the least of all seeds: but when it is grown, it is the greatest among herbs, and becometh a tree, so that the birds of the air come and lodge in the branches thereof.

lodge in the 22_SON_07_11 # Come, my beloved, let us go forth into the field; let us lodge in the villages.

lodge in the <u>36_ZEP_02_14</u># And flocks shall lie down in the midst of her, all the beasts of the nations: both the cormorant and the bittern shall lodge in the upper lintels of it; [their] voice shall sing in the windows; desolation [shall be] in the thresholds: for he shall uncover the cedar work.

lodge in <u>01_GEN_24_23</u> # And said, Whose daughter [art] thou? tell me, I pray thee: is there room [in] thy father's house for us to lodge in?

lodge in <u>01_GEN_24_25</u># She said moreover unto him, We have both straw and provender enough, and room to lodge in.

lodge not in <u>07_JUD_19_20</u> # And the old man said, Peace [be] with thee; howsoever [let] all thy wants [lie] upon me; only lodge not in the street.

Lodge not this <u>10_2SA_17_16</u># Now therefore send quickly, and tell David, saying, Lodge not this night in the plains of the wilderness, but speedily pass over; lest the king be swallowed up, and all the people that [are] with him.

lodge O ye 23_ISA_21_13_# The burden upon Arabia. In the forest in Arabia shall ye lodge, O ye travelling companies of Dedanim.

lodge this night <u>06_JOS_04_03</u># And command ye them, saying, Take you hence out of the midst of Jordan, out of the place where the priests' feet stood firm, twelve stones, and ye shall carry them over with you, and leave them in the lodging place, where ye shall lodge this night.

lodge thy people <u>08_RUT_01_16</u> # And Ruth said, Entreat me not to leave thee, [or] to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people [shall be] my people, and thy God my God:

lodge under the <u>41_MAR_04_32</u> # But when it is sown, it groweth up, and becometh greater than all herbs, and shooteth out great branches; so that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow of it.

lodge with the <u>10_2SA_17_08</u># For, said Hushai, thou knowest thy father and his men, that they [be] mighty men, and they [be] chafed in their minds, as a bear robbed of her whelps in the field: and thy father [is] a man of war, and will not lodge with the people.

lodge ye about 16_NEH_13_21 # Then I testified against them, and said unto them, Why lodge ye about the wall? if ye do [so] again, I will lay hands on you. From that time forth came they no [more] on the sabbath.

lodge <u>44_ACT_21_16</u># There went with us also [certain] of the disciples of Caesarea, and brought with them one Mnason of Cyprus, an old disciple, with whom we should lodge.

lodge <u>07_JUD_20_04</u># And the Levite, the husband of the woman that was slain, answered and said, I came into Gibeah that [belongeth] to Benjamin, I and my concubine, to lodge.

lodged and laid <u>06_JOS_04_08</u> # And the children of Israel did so as Joshua commanded, and took up twelve stones out of the midst of Jordan, as the LORD spake unto Joshua, according to the number of the tribes of the children of Israel, and carried them over with them unto the place where they lodged, and laid them down there.

lodged in the <u>44_ACT_10_32</u> # Send therefore to Joppa, and call hither Simon, whose surname is Peter; he is lodged in the house of [one] Simon a tanner by the sea side: who, when he cometh, shall speak unto thee.

lodged in the <u>06_JOS_06_11</u># So the ark of the LORD compassed the city, going about [it] once: and they came into the camp, and lodged in the camp.

lodged in the <u>42_LUK_13_19</u># It is like a grain of mustard seed, which a man took, and cast into his garden; and it grew, and waxed a great tree; and the fowls of the air lodged in the branches of it.

lodged round about 13_1CH_09_27 # And they lodged round about the house of God, because the charge [was] upon them, and the opening thereof every morning [pertained] to them.

lodged strangers if <u>54_1TI_05_10</u> # Well reported of for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, if she have washed the saints' feet, if she have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed every good work.

lodged that night <u>01_GEN_32_21</u># So went the present over before him: and himself lodged that night in the company.

lodged that night <u>06_JOS_08_09</u> # Joshua therefore sent them forth: and they went to lie in ambush, and abode between Bethel and Ai, on the west side of Ai: but Joshua lodged that night among the people.

lodged them And 44_ACT_10_23 # Then called he them in, and lodged [them]. And on the morrow Peter went away with them, and certain brethren from Joppa accompanied him.

lodged there again <u>07_JUD_19_07</u># And when the man rose up to depart, his father in law urged him: therefore he lodged there again.
