lucre but of [60\\_1PE\\_05\\_02](#) # Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight [thereof], not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;

lucre but patient [54\\_1TI\\_03\\_03](#) # Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous;

lucre [54\\_1TI\\_03\\_08](#) # Likewise [must] the deacons [be] grave, not doubletongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre;

lucre [56\\_TIT\\_01\\_07](#) # For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre;

lucre's sake [56\\_TIT\\_01\\_11](#) # Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake.
