Mesha and Malcham [13 ICH 08 09](#) # And he begat of Hodesh his wife, Jobab, and Zibia, and Mesha, and Malcham,

Mesha as thou [01 GEN 10 30](#) # And their dwelling was from Mesha, as thou goest unto Sephar a mount of the east.

Mesha his firstborn [13 ICH 02 42](#) # Now the sons of Caleb the brother of Jerahmeel [were], Mesha his firstborn, which was the father of Ziph; and the sons of Mareshah the father of Hebron.

Mesha king of [12 2KI 03 04](#) # And Mesha king of Moab was a sheepmaster, and rendered unto the king of Israel an hundred thousand lambs, and an hundred thousand rams, with the wool.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 02 49](#) # Then Daniel requested of the king, and he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of the province of Babylon: but Daniel [sat] in the gate of the king.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 12](#) # There are certain Jews whom thou hast set over the affairs of the province of Babylon, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; these men, O king, have not regarded thee: they serve not thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 13](#) # Then Nebuchadnezzar in [his] rage and fury commanded to bring Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Then they brought these men before the king.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 14](#) # Nebuchadnezzar spake and said unto them, [Is it] true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, do not ye serve my gods, nor worship the golden image which I have set up?

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 16](#) # Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we [are] not careful to answer thee in this matter.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 19](#) # Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: [therefore] he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 20](#) # And he commanded the most mighty men that [were] in his army to bind Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, [and] to cast [them] into the burning fiery furnace.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 22](#) # Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flame of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 23](#) # And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 26](#) # Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the mouth of the burning fiery furnace, [and] spake, and said, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, ye servants of the most high God, come forth, and come [hither]. Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, came forth of the midst of the fire.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 29](#) # Therefore I make a decree, That every people, nation, and language, which speak any thing amiss against the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, shall be cut in pieces, and their houses shall be made a dunghill: because there is no other God that can deliver after this sort.

Meshach and Abednego [27 DAN 03 30](#) # Then the king promoted Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, in the province of Babylon.

Meshach and to [27 DAN 01 07](#) # Unto whom the prince of the eunuchs gave names: for he gave unto Daniel [the name] of Belteshazzar; and to Hananiah, of Shadrach; and to Mishael, of Meshach; and to Azariah, of Abednego.
