makest a dinner [42 LUK 14 12](#) # Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor [thy] rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompense be made thee.

makest a feast [42 LUK 14 13](#) # But when thou makest a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind:

makest account of [19 PSA 144 03](#) # LORD, what [is] man, that thou takest knowledge of him! [or] the son of man, that thou makest account of him!

makest darkness and [19 PSA 104 20](#) # Thou makest darkness, and it is night: wherein all the beasts of the forest do creep [forth].

makest him drunken [35 HAB 02 15](#) # Woe unto him that giveth his neighbour drink, that putteth thy bottle to [him], and makest [him] drunken also, that thou mayest look on their nakedness!

makest his beauty [19 PSA 39 11](#) # When thou with rebukes dost correct man for iniquity, thou makest his beauty to consume away like a moth: surely every man [is] vanity. Selah.

makest it soft [19 PSA 65 10](#) # Thou waterest the ridges thereof abundantly: thou settlest the furrows thereof: thou makest it soft with showers: thou blessest the springing thereof.

makest me dwell [19 PSA 04 08](#) # I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety.

makest me to [18 JOB 13 26](#) # For thou writest bitter things against me, and makest me to possess the iniquities of my youth.

makest men as [35 HAB 01 14](#) # And makest men as the fishes of the sea, as the creeping things, [that have] no ruler over them?

makest the outgoings [19 PSA 65 08](#) # They also that dwell in the uttermost parts are afraid at thy tokens: thou makest the outgoings of the morning and evening to rejoice.

makest thine high [26 EZE 16 31](#) # In that thou buildest thine eminent place in the head of every way, and makest thine high place in every street; and hast not been as an harlot, in that thou scornest hire;

makest this people [24 JER 28 15](#) # Then said the prophet Jeremiah unto Hananiah the prophet, Hear now, Hananiah; The LORD hath not sent thee; but thou makest this people to trust in a lie.

makest thou in [07 JUD 18 03](#) # When they [were] by the house of Micah, they knew the voice of the young man the Levite: and they turned in thither, and said unto him, Who brought thee hither? and what makest thou in this [place]? and what hast thou here?

makest thou or [23 ISA 45 09](#) # Woe unto him that striveth with his Maker! [Let] the potsherd [strive] with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay say to him that fashioneth it, What makest thou? or thy work, He hath no hands?

makest thou thyself [43 JOH 08 53](#) # Art thou greater than our father Abraham, which is dead? and the prophets are dead: whom makest thou thyself?

makest thy boast [45 ROM 02 17](#) # Behold, thou art called a Jew, and retest in the law, and makest thy boast of God,

makest thy boast [45 ROM 02 23](#) # Thou that makest thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonourest thou God?

makest thy flock [22 SON 01 07](#) # Tell me, O thou whom my soul loveth, where thou feedest, where thou makest [thy flock] to rest at noon: for why should I be as one that turneth aside by the flocks of thy companions?

makest thy nest [24 JER 22 23](#) # O inhabitant of Lebanon, that makest thy nest in the cedars, how gracious shalt thou be when pangs come upon thee, the pain as of a woman in travail!

makest thy ways [18 JOB 22 03](#) # [Is it] any pleasure to the Almighty, that thou art righteous? or [is it] gain [to him], that thou makest thy ways perfect?

makest thyself God [43 JOH 10 33](#) # The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God.

makest us a [19 PSA 44 13](#) # Thou makest us a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and a derision to them that are round about us.

makest us a [19 PSA 44 14](#) # Thou makest us a byword among the heathen, a shaking of the head among the people.

makest us a [19 PSA 80 06](#) # Thou makest us a strife unto our neighbours: and our enemies laugh among themselves.

makest us to [19 PSA 44 10](#) # Thou makest us to turn back from the enemy: and they which hate us spoil for themselves.
