mean behold the [44 ACT 10 17](#) # Now while Peter doubted in himself what this vision which he had seen should mean, behold, the men which were sent from Cornelius had made inquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate,

mean city and [44 ACT 21 39](#) # But Paul said, I am a man [which am] a Jew of Tarsus, [a city] in Cilicia, a citizen of no mean city: and, I beseech thee, suffer me to speak unto the people.

mean man boweth [23 ISA 02 09](#) # And the mean man boweth down, and the great man humbleth himself: therefore forgive them not.

mean man shall [23 ISA 05 15](#) # And the mean man shall be brought down, and the mighty man shall be humbled, and the eyes of the lofty shall be humbled:

mean man shall [23 ISA 31 08](#) # Then shall the Assyrian fall with the sword, not of a mighty man; and the sword, not of a mean man, shall devour him: but he shall flee from the sword, and his young men shall be discomfited.

mean men [20 PRO 22 29](#) # Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean [men].

mean not that [47 2CO 08 13](#) # For [I mean] not that other men be eased, and ye burdened:

mean tell them [26 EZE 17 12](#) # Say now to the rebellious house, Know ye not what these [things mean]? tell [them], Behold, the king of Babylon is come to Jerusalem, and hath taken the king thereof, and the princes thereof, and led them with him to Babylon;

mean the testimonies [05 DEU 06 20](#) # [And] when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What [mean] the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD our God hath commanded you?

mean these seven [01 GEN 21 29](#) # And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What [mean] these seven ewe lambs which thou hast set by themselves?

mean these stones [06 JOS 04 21](#) # And he spake unto the children of Israel, saying, When your children shall ask their fathers in time to come, saying, What [mean] these stones?

mean time when [42 LUK 12 01](#) # In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.

mean while accusing [45 ROM 02 15](#) # Which show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and [their] thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;]

mean while his [43 JOH 04 31](#) # In the mean while his disciples prayed him, saying, Master, eat.

mean while that [11 1KI 18 45](#) # And it came to pass in the mean while, that the heaven was black with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain. And Ahab rode, and went to Jezreel.

mean ye by [02\\_EXO\\_12\\_26](#) # And it shall come to pass, when your children shall say unto you, What mean ye by this service?

mean ye by [06\\_JOS\\_04\\_06](#) # That this may be a sign among you, [that] when your children ask [their fathers] in time to come, saying, What [mean] ye by these stones?

mean ye that [26\\_EZE\\_18\\_02](#) # What mean ye, that ye use this proverb concerning the land of Israel, saying, The fathers have eaten sour grapes, and the children's teeth are set on edge?

mean ye that [23\\_ISA\\_03\\_15](#) # What mean ye [that] ye beat my people to pieces, and grind the faces of the poor? saith the Lord GOD of hosts.

mean ye to [44\\_ACT\\_21\\_13](#) # Then Paul answered, What mean ye to weep and to break mine heart? for I am ready not to be bound only, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus.

mean [44\\_ACT\\_17\\_20](#) # For thou bringest certain strange things to our ears: we would know therefore what these things mean.

mean [41\\_MAR\\_09\\_10](#) # And they kept that saying with themselves, questioning one with another what the rising from the dead should mean.

meanest by these [26\\_EZE\\_37\\_18](#) # And when the children of thy people shall speak unto thee, saying, Wilt thou not show us what thou [meanest] by these?

meanest thou by [10\\_2SA\\_16\\_02](#) # And the king said unto Ziba, What meanest thou by these? And Ziba said, The asses [be] for the king's household to ride on; and the bread and summer fruit for the young men to eat; and the wine, that such as be faint in the wilderness may drink.

meanest thou by [01\\_GEN\\_33\\_08](#) # And he said, What [meanest] thou by all this drove which I met? And he said, [These are] to find grace in the sight of my lord.

meanest thou O [32\\_JON\\_01\\_06](#) # So the shipmaster came to him, and said unto him, What meanest thou, O sleeper? arise, call upon thy God, if so be that God will think upon us, that we perish not.

meaneth I will [40\\_MAT\\_09\\_13](#) # But go ye and learn what [that] meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

meaneth I will [40\\_MAT\\_12\\_07](#) # But if ye had known what [this] meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.

meaneth not so [23\\_ISA\\_10\\_07](#) # Howbeit he meaneth not so, neither doth his heart think so; but [it is] in his heart to destroy and cut off nations not a few.

meaneth the heat [05\\_DEU\\_29\\_24](#) # Even all nations shall say, Wherefore hath the LORD done thus unto this land? what [meaneth] the heat of this great anger?

meaneth the noise [09\\_1SA\\_04\\_06](#) # And when the Philistines heard the noise of the shout, they said, What [meaneth] the noise of this great shout in the camp of the Hebrews? And they understood that the ark of the LORD was come into the camp.

meaneth the noise [09\\_1SA\\_04\\_14](#) # And when Eli heard the noise of the crying, he said, What [meaneth] the noise of this tumult? And the man came in hastily, and told Eli.

meaneth then this [09\\_1SA\\_15\\_14](#) # And Samuel said, What [meaneth] then this bleating of the sheep in mine ears, and the lowing of the oxen which I hear?

meaneth this [44\\_ACT\\_02\\_12](#) # And they were all amazed, and were in doubt, saying one to another, What meaneth this?

meaning of the [46\\_1CO\\_14\\_11](#) # Therefore if I know not the meaning of the voice, I shall be unto him that speaketh a barbarian, and he that speaketh [shall be] a barbarian unto me.

meaning then behold [27\\_DAN\\_08\\_15](#) # And it came to pass, when I, [even] I Daniel, had seen the vision, and sought for the meaning, then, behold, there stood before me as the appearance of a man.

meaning to sail [44\\_ACT\\_27\\_02](#) # And entering into a ship of Adramyttium, we launched, meaning to sail by the coasts of Asia; [one] Aristarchus, a Macedonian of Thessalonica, being with us.

means and my [24\\_JER\\_05\\_31](#) # The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests bear rule by their means; and my people love [to have it] so: and what will ye do in the end thereof?

means as the [47\\_2CO\\_11\\_03](#) # But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtlety, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

means clear the [02\\_EXO\\_34\\_07](#) # Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear [the guilty]; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth [generation].

means clearing the [04\\_NUM\\_14\\_18](#) # The LORD [is] longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing [the guilty], visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth [generation].

means come out [40\\_MAT\\_05\\_26](#) # Verily I say unto thee, Thou shalt by no means come out thence, till thou hast paid the uttermost farthing.

means for that [53\\_2TH\\_02\\_03](#) # Let no man deceive you by any means: for [that day shall not come], except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

means he be [11\\_1KI\\_20\\_39](#) # And as the king passed by, he cried unto the king: and he said, Thy servant went out into the midst of the battle; and, behold, a man turned aside, and brought a man unto me, and said, Keep this man: if by any means he be missing, then shall thy life be for his life, or else thou shalt pay a talent of silver.

means he is [44\\_ACT\\_04\\_09](#) # If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole;

means he now [43\\_JOH\\_09\\_21](#) # But by what means he now seeth, we know not; or who hath opened his eyes, we know not: he is of age; ask him: he shall speak for himself.

means he that [42\\_LUK\\_08\\_36](#) # They also which saw [it] told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils was healed.

means hurt you [42\\_LUK\\_10\\_19](#) # Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

means I may [45\\_ROM\\_11\\_14](#) # If by any means I may provoke to emulation [them which are] my flesh, and might save some of them.

means I might [50\\_PHP\\_03\\_11](#) # If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.

means I should [48 GAL 02 02](#) # And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.

means keep this [44 ACT 18 21](#) # But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

means now at [45 ROM 01 10](#) # Making request, if by any means now at length I might have a prosperous journey by the will of God to come unto you.

means of a [20 PRO 06 26](#) # For by means of a whorish woman [a man is brought] to a piece of bread: and the adulteress will hunt for the precious life.

means of death [58 HEB 09 15](#) # And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions [that were] under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

means of many [47 2CO 01 11](#) # Ye also helping together by prayer for us, that for the gift [bestowed] upon us by the means of many persons thanks may be given by many on our behalf.

means of the [07 JUD 05 22](#) # Then were the horsehoofs broken by the means of the prancings, the prancings of their mighty ones.

means of those [66 REV 13 14](#) # And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by [the means of] those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.

means redeem his [19 PSA 49 07](#) # None [of them] can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him:

means save some [46 1CO 09 22](#) # To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all [men], that I might by all means save some.

means that his [10 2SA 14 14](#) # For we must needs die, and [are] as water spilled on the ground, which cannot be gathered up again; neither doth God respect [any] person: yet doth he devise means, that his banished be not expelled from him.

means The Lord [53 2TH 03 16](#) # Now the Lord of peace himself give you peace always by all means. The Lord [be] with you all.

means the tempter [52 1TH 03 05](#) # For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in vain.

means they might [44 ACT 27 12](#) # And because the haven was not commodious to winter in, the more part advised to depart thence also, if by any means they might attain to Phenice, [and there] to winter; [which is] an haven of Crete, and lieth toward the south west and north west.

means this liberty [46 1CO 08 09](#) # But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock to them that are weak.

means thou shalt [15 EZR 04 16](#) # We certify the king that, if this city be builded [again], and the walls thereof set up, by this means thou shalt have no portion on this side the river.

means to bring [42 LUK 05 18](#) # And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought [means] to bring him in, and to lay [him] before him.

means we may [07 JUD 16 05](#) # And the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and said unto her, Entice him, and see wherein his great strength [lieth], and by what [means] we may prevail against him, that we may bind him to afflict him: and we will give thee every one of us eleven hundred [pieces] of silver.

means when I [46 1CO 09 27](#) # But I keep under my body, and bring [it] into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

means will he [39 MAL 01 09](#) # And now, I pray you, beseech God that he will be gracious unto us: this hath been by your means: will he regard your persons? saith the LORD of hosts.

means [11 1KI 10 29](#) # And a chariot came up and went out of Egypt for six hundred [shekels] of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: and so for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, did they bring [them] out by their means.

means [14 2CH 01 17](#) # And they fetched up, and brought forth out of Egypt a chariot for six hundred [shekels] of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: and so brought they out [horses] for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, by their means.

meant it unto [01 GEN 50 20](#) # But as for you, ye thought evil against me; [but] God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as [it is] this day, to save much people alive.

meant [42 LUK 15 26](#) # And he called one of the servants, and asked what these things meant.

meant [42 LUK 18 36](#) # And hearing the multitude pass by, he asked what it meant.
