

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Philip and Bartholomew <u>42\_LUK\_06\_14</u> # Simon, [whom he also named Peter,] and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,

Philip and Bartholomew 41\_MAR\_03\_18 # And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,

Philip and Bartholomew <u>40 MAT 10 03</u># Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;

Philip and Prochorus <u>44\_ACT\_06\_05</u># And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch:

Philip and said <u>44\_ACT\_08\_34</u> # And the eunuch answered Philip, and said, I pray thee, of whom speaketh the prophet this? of himself, or of some other man?

Philip and saith <u>43\_JOH\_01\_43</u># The day following Jesus would go forth into Galilee, and findeth Philip, and saith unto him, Follow me.

Philip and the <u>44\_ACT\_08\_38</u> # And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him.

Philip and Thomas <u>44\_ACT\_01\_13</u> # And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas [the brother] of James.

Philip and wondered <u>44\_ACT\_08\_13</u> # Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done.

Philip answered him <u>43\_JOH\_06\_07</u> # Philip answered him, Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little.

Philip called thee <u>43\_JOH\_01\_48</u> # Nathanael saith unto him, Whence knowest thou me? Jesus answered and said unto him, Before that Philip called thee, when thou wast under the fig tree, I saw thee.

Philip cometh and 43\_JOH\_12\_22 # Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.

Philip findeth Nathanael <u>43\_JOH\_01\_45</u> # Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

Philip Go near 44\_ACT\_08\_29 # Then the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot.

Philip he that <u>43\_JOH\_14\_09</u> # Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou [then], Show us the Father?

Philip opened his 44\_ACT\_08\_35 # Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and

preached unto him Jesus.

Philip preaching the <u>44\_ACT\_08\_12</u> # But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.

Philip ran thither 44\_ACT\_08\_30 # And Philip ran thither to [him], and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest?

Philip said If 44\_ACT\_08\_37 # And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

Philip saith unto 43\_JOH\_01\_46 # And Nathanael said unto him, Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see.

Philip saith unto 43\_JOH\_14\_08 # Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

Philip saying Arise 44\_ACT\_08\_26 # And the angel of the Lord spake unto Philip, saying, Arise, and go toward the south unto the way that goeth down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert.

Philip spake hearing 44\_ACT\_08\_06 # And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.

Philip tell Jesus 43\_JOH\_12\_22# Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.

Philip tetrarch of <u>42\_LUK\_03\_01</u># Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

Philip that he 44\_ACT\_08\_31 # And he said, How can I, except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him.

Philip that the <u>44\_ACT\_08\_39</u> # And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.

Philip the evangelist <u>44\_ACT\_21\_08</u># And the next [day] we that were of Paul's company departed, and came unto Caesarea: and we entered into the house of Philip the evangelist, which was [one] of the seven; and abode with him.

Philip was found <u>44\_ACT\_08\_40</u> # But Philip was found at Azotus: and passing through he preached in all the cities, till he came to Caesarea.

Philip was of 43\_JOH\_01\_44 # Now Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.

Philip went down 44\_ACT\_08\_05 # Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them.

Philip Whence shall 43\_JOH\_06\_05 # When Jesus then lifted up [his] eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?

Philip which was 43\_JOH\_12\_21 # The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus.

Philip's wife and <u>42\_LUK\_03\_19</u># But Herod the tetrarch, being reproved by him for Herodias his brother Philip's wife, and for all the evils which Herod had done,

Philip's wife for 41 MAR 06 17 # For Herod himself had sent forth and laid hold upon John, and bound him in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife: for he had married her.

Philip's wife <u>40\_MAT\_14\_03</u># For Herod had laid hold on John, and bound him, and put [him] in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife.

Philippi after the <u>44\_ACT\_20\_06</u># And we sailed away from Philippi after the days of unleavened bread, and came unto them to Troas in five days; where we abode seven days.

Philippi and by 41\_MAR\_08\_27 # And Jesus went out, and his disciples, into the towns of Caesarea Philippi: and by the way he asked his disciples, saying unto them, Whom do men say that I am?

Philippi he asked 40\_MAT\_16\_13# When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son of man am?

Philippi we were <u>52\_1TH\_02\_02</u># But even after that we had suffered before, and were shamefully entreated, as ye know, at Philippi, we were bold in our God to speak unto you the gospel of God with much contention.

Philippi which is 44\_ACT\_16\_12 # And from thence to Philippi, which is the chief city of that part of Macedonia, [and] a colony: and we were in that city abiding certain days.

Philippi with the <u>50\_PHP\_01\_01</u> # Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons:

Philippians know also <u>50\_PHP\_04\_15</u># Now ye Philippians know also, that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church communicated with me as concerning giving and receiving, but ye only.
