Pilate and begged [42\\_LUK\\_23\\_52](#) # This [man] went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus.

Pilate and begged [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_58](#) # He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered.

Pilate and craved [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_43](#) # Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counsellor, which also waited for the kingdom of God, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus.

Pilate and Herod [42\\_LUK\\_23\\_12](#) # And the same day Pilate and Herod were made friends together: for before they were at enmity between themselves.

Pilate answered Am [43\\_JOH\\_18\\_35](#) # Pilate answered, Am I a Jew? Thine own nation and the chief priests have delivered thee unto me: what hast thou done?

Pilate answered and [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_12](#) # And Pilate answered and said again unto them, What will ye then that I shall do [unto him] whom ye call the King of the Jews?

Pilate answered them [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_09](#) # But Pilate answered them, saying, Will ye that I release unto you the King of the Jews?

Pilate answered What [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_22](#) # Pilate answered, What I have written I have written.

Pilate asked him [42\\_LUK\\_23\\_03](#) # And Pilate asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And he answered him and said, Thou sayest [it].

Pilate asked him [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_02](#) # And Pilate asked him, Art thou the King of the Jews? And he answering said unto him, Thou sayest [it].

Pilate asked him [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_04](#) # And Pilate asked him again, saying, Answerest thou nothing? behold how many things they witness against thee.

Pilate being governor [42\\_LUK\\_03\\_01](#) # Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

Pilate commanded the [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_58](#) # He went to Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered.

Pilate entered into [43\\_JOH\\_18\\_33](#) # Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews?

Pilate gave him [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_38](#) # And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave [him] leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

Pilate gave sentence [42\\_LUK\\_23\\_24](#) # And Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they required.

Pilate had mingled [42\\_LUK\\_13\\_01](#) # There were present at that season some that told him of the

Galilaeans, whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices.

Pilate heard of [42\\_LUK\\_23\\_06](#) # When Pilate heard of Galilee, he asked whether the man were a Galilaean.

Pilate marvelled if [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_44](#) # And Pilate marvelled if he were already dead: and calling [unto him] the centurion, he asked him whether he had been any while dead.

Pilate marvelled [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_05](#) # But Jesus yet answered nothing; so that Pilate marvelled.

Pilate said unto [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_14](#) # Then Pilate said unto them, Why, what evil hath he done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, Crucify him.

Pilate said unto [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_17](#) # Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them, Whom will ye that I release unto you? Barabbas, or Jesus which is called Christ?

Pilate said unto [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_65](#) # Pilate said unto them, Ye have a watch: go your way, make [it] as sure as ye can.

Pilate saith unto [43\\_JOH\\_18\\_38](#) # Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault [at all].

Pilate saith unto [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_05](#) # Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And [Pilate] saith unto them, Behold the man!

Pilate saith unto [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_06](#) # When the chief priests therefore and officers saw him, they cried out, saying, Crucify [him], crucify [him]. Pilate saith unto them, Take ye him, and crucify [him]: for I find no fault in him.

Pilate saith unto [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_15](#) # But they cried out, Away with [him], away with [him], crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.

Pilate saith unto [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_22](#) # Pilate saith unto them, What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ? [They] all say unto him, Let him be crucified.

Pilate saw that [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_24](#) # When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but [that] rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed [his] hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye [to it].

Pilate sought to [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_12](#) # And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: but the Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's friend: whosoever maketh himself a king speaketh against Caesar.

Pilate that he [44\\_ACT\\_13\\_28](#) # And though they found no cause of death [in him], yet desired they Pilate that he should be slain.

Pilate that he [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_38](#) # And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave [him] leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

Pilate that their [43\\_JOH\\_19\\_31](#) # The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the sabbath day, [for that sabbath day was an high day,] besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and [that] they might be taken away.

Pilate the governor [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_02](#) # And when they had bound him, they led [him] away, and delivered him to Pontius Pilate the governor.

Pilate then went [43 JOH 18 29](#) # Pilate then went out unto them, and said, What accusation bring ye against this man?

Pilate therefore heard [43 JOH 19 08](#) # When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he was the more afraid;

Pilate therefore heard [43 JOH 19 13](#) # When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he brought Jesus forth, and sat down in the judgment seat in a place that is called the Pavement, but in the Hebrew, Gabbatha.

Pilate therefore said [43 JOH 18 37](#) # Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

Pilate therefore took [43 JOH 19 01](#) # Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged [him].

Pilate therefore went [43 JOH 19 04](#) # Pilate therefore went forth again, and saith unto them, Behold, I bring him forth to you, that ye may know that I find no fault in him.

Pilate therefore willing [42 LUK 23 20](#) # Pilate therefore, willing to release Jesus, spake again to them.

Pilate to the [42 LUK 23 04](#) # Then said Pilate to the chief priests and [to] the people, I find no fault in this man.

Pilate unto him [43 JOH 19 10](#) # Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee?

Pilate unto him [40 MAT 27 13](#) # Then said Pilate unto him, Hearest thou not how many things they witness against thee?

Pilate unto them [43 JOH 18 31](#) # Then said Pilate unto them, Take ye him, and judge him according to your law. The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to death:

Pilate when he [44 ACT 03 13](#) # The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let [him] go.

Pilate when he [42 LUK 23 13](#) # And Pilate, when he had called together the chief priests and the rulers and the people,

Pilate willing to [41 MAR 15 15](#) # And [so] Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged [him], to be crucified.

Pilate with the [44 ACT 04 27](#) # For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together,

Pilate witnessed a [54 1TI 06 13](#) # I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and [before] Christ Jesus, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;

Pilate Write not [43 JOH 19 21](#) # Then said the chief priests of the Jews to Pilate, Write not, The King of the Jews; but that he said, I am King of the Jews.

Pilate wrote a [43 JOH 19 19](#) # And Pilate wrote a title, and put [it] on the cross. And the writing was, JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.

Pilate [42 LUK 23 01](#) # And the whole multitude of them arose, and led him unto Pilate.

**Pilate [42 LUK 23 11](#) # And Herod with his men of war set him at nought, and mocked [him], and arrayed him in a gorgeous robe, and sent him again to Pilate.**

**Pilate [41 MAR 15 01](#) # And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried [him] away, and delivered [him] to Pilate.**

**Pilate [40 MAT 27 62](#) # Now the next day, that followed the day of the preparation, the chief priests and Pharisees came together unto Pilate,**
