petition and it [17 EST 05 06](#) # And the king said unto Esther at the banquet of wine, What [is] thy petition? and it shall be granted thee: and what [is] thy request? even to the half of the kingdom it shall be performed.

petition and it [17 EST 09 12](#) # And the king said unto Esther the queen, The Jews have slain and destroyed five hundred men in Shushan the palace, and the ten sons of Haman; what have they done in the rest of the king's provinces? now what [is] thy petition? and it shall be granted thee: or what [is] thy request further? and it shall be done.

petition and my [17 EST 05 07](#) # Then answered Esther, and said, My petition and my request [is];

petition and my [17 EST 07 03](#) # Then Esther the queen answered and said, If I have found favour in thy sight, O king, and if it please the king, let my life be given me at my petition, and my people at my request:

petition and to [17 EST 05 08](#) # If I have found favour in the sight of the king, and if it please the king to grant my petition, and to perform my request, let the king and Haman come to the banquet that I shall prepare for them, and I will do to morrow as the king hath said.

petition of any [27 DAN 06 07](#) # All the presidents of the kingdom, the governors, and the princes, the counsellors, and the captains, have consulted together to establish a royal statute, and to make a firm decree, that whosoever shall ask a petition of any God or man for thirty days, save of thee, O king, he shall be cast into the den of lions.

petition of any [27 DAN 06 12](#) # Then they came near, and spake before the king concerning the king's decree: Hast thou not signed a decree, that every man that shall ask [a petition] of any God or man within thirty days, save of thee, O king, shall be cast into the den of lions? The king answered and said, The thing [is] true, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

petition of thee [11 1KI 02 16](#) # And now I ask one petition of thee, deny me not. And she said unto him, Say on.

petition of thee [11 1KI 02 20](#) # Then she said, I desire one small petition of thee; [I pray thee], say me not nay. And the king said unto her, Ask on, my mother: for I will not say thee nay.

petition queen Esther [17 EST 07 02](#) # And the king said again unto Esther on the second day at the banquet of wine, What [is] thy petition, queen Esther? and it shall be granted thee: and what [is] thy request? and it shall be performed, [even] to the half of the kingdom.

petition that thou [09 ISA 01 17](#) # Then Eli answered and said, Go in peace: and the God of Israel grant [thee] thy petition that thou hast asked of him.

petition three times [27 DAN 06 13](#) # Then answered they and said before the king, That Daniel, which [is] of the children of the captivity of Judah, regardeth not thee, O king, nor the decree that thou hast signed, but maketh his petition three times a day.

petition which I [09 ISA 01 27](#) # For this child I prayed; and the LORD hath given me my petition which I asked of him:
