complain a man <u>25_LAM_03_39</u># Wherefore doth a living man complain, a man for the punishment of his sins?

complain in the <u>18_JOB_07_11</u># Therefore I will not refrain my mouth; I will speak in the anguish of my spirit; I will complain in the bitterness of my soul.

complain that we <u>07_JUD_21_22</u> # And it shall be, when their fathers or their brethren come unto us to complain, that we will say unto them, Be favourable unto them for our sakes: because we reserved not to each man his wife in the war: for ye did not give unto them at this time, [that] ye should be guilty.

complain 18_JOB_31_38 # If my land cry against me, or that the furrows likewise thereof complain;

complained and my 19_PSA_77_03 # I remembered God, and was troubled: I complained, and my spirit was overwhelmed. Selah.

complained it displeased <u>04_NUM_11_01</u># And [when] the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the LORD heard [it]; and his anger was kindled; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed [them that were] in the uttermost parts of the camp.

complainers walking after <u>65_JDE_01_16</u># These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling [words], having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.

complaining in our <u>19 PSA_144_14</u> # [That] our oxen [may be] strong to labour; [that there be] no breaking in, nor going out; that [there be] no complaining in our streets.

complaint and grief <u>09_1SA_01_16</u> # Count not thine handmaid for a daughter of Belial: for out of the abundance of my complaint and grief have I spoken hitherto.

complaint and make 19_PSA_55_02 # Attend unto me, and hear me: I mourn in my complaint, and make a noise;

complaint before him 19_PSA_142_02 # I poured out my complaint before him; I showed before him my trouble.

complaint before the <u>19_PSA_102_01</u> # A Prayer of the afflicted, when he is overwhelmed, and poureth out his complaint before the LORD. Hear my prayer, O LORD, and let my cry come unto thee.

complaint bitter my <u>18_JOB_23_02</u> # Even to day [is] my complaint bitter: my stroke is heavier than my groaning.

complaint I will <u>18_JOB_09_27</u> # If I say, I will forget my complaint, I will leave off my heaviness, and comfort [myself]:

complaint to man <u>18_JOB_21_04</u> # As for me, [is] my complaint to man? and if [it were so], why should not my spirit be troubled?

complaint upon myself 18_JOB_10_01 # My soul is weary of my life; I will leave my complaint upon

myself; I will speak in the bitterness of my soul.

complaint 18_JOB_07_13 # When I say, My bed shall comfort me, my couch shall ease my complaint;

complaints against Paul <u>44_ACT_25_07</u># And when he was come, the Jews which came down from Jerusalem stood round about, and laid many and grievous complaints against Paul, which they could not prove.

plain according to 12 2KI 14 25 # He restored the coast of Israel from the entering of Hamath unto the sea of the plain, according to the word of the LORD God of Israel, which he spake by the hand of his servant Jonah, the son of Amittai, the prophet, which [was] of Gathhepher.

plain all night <u>10_2SA_04_07</u> # For when they came into the house, he lay on his bed in his bedchamber, and they smote him, and slew him, and beheaded him, and took his head, and gat them away through the plain all night.

plain also and <u>05_DEU_03_17</u># The plain also, and Jordan, and the coast [thereof], from Chinnereth even unto the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea, under Ashdothpisgah eastward.

plain and all <u>05_DEU_03_10</u># All the cities of the plain, and all Gilead, and all Bashan, unto Salchah and Edrei, cities of the kingdom of Og in Bashan.

plain and all <u>01_GEN_19_25</u># And he overthrew those cities, and all the plain, and all the inhabitants of the cities, and that which grew upon the ground.

plain and all <u>06_JOS_13_21</u> # And all the cities of the plain, and all the kingdom of Sihon king of the Amorites, which reigned in Heshbon, whom Moses smote with the princes of Midian, Evi, and Rekem, and Zur, and Hur, and Reba, [which were] dukes of Sihon, dwelling in the country.

plain and beheld <u>01_GEN_19_28</u># And he looked toward Sodom and Gomorrah, and toward all the land of the plain, and beheld, and, lo, the smoke of the country went up as the smoke of a furnace.

plain and behold <u>26_EZE_03_23</u># Then I arose, and went forth into the plain: and, behold, the glory of the LORD stood there, as the glory which I saw by the river of Chebar: and I fell on my face.

plain and from 24_JER_17_26 # And they shall come from the cities of Judah, and from the places about Jerusalem, and from the land of Benjamin, and from the plain, and from the mountains, and from the south, bringing burnt offerings, and sacrifices, and meat offerings, and incense, and bringing sacrifices of praise, unto the house of the LORD.

plain and he <u>38_ZEC_04_07</u> # Who [art] thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel [thou shalt become] a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone [thereof with] shoutings, [crying], Grace, grace unto it.

plain and I <u>26_EZE_03_22</u># And the hand of the LORD was there upon me; and he said unto me, Arise, go forth into the plain, and I will there talk with thee.

plain and overran 10_2SA_18_23 # But howsoever, [said he], let me run. And he said unto him, Run. Then Ahimaaz ran by the way of the plain, and overran Cushi.

plain and passed <u>10_2SA_02_29</u> # And Abner and his men walked all that night through the plain, and passed over Jordan, and went through all Bithron, and they came to Mahanaim.

plain and pitched <u>01_GEN_13_12</u> # Abram dwelled in the land of Canaan, and Lot dwelled in the cities of the plain, and pitched [his] tent toward Sodom.

plain and surely <u>11_1KI_20_23</u># And the servants of the king of Syria said unto him, Their gods [are] gods of the hills; therefore they were stronger than we; but let us fight against them in the plain, and surely we shall be stronger than they.

plain and surely <u>11_1KI_20_25</u># And number thee an army, like the army that thou hast lost, horse for horse, and chariot for chariot: and we will fight against them in the plain, [and] surely we shall be stronger than they. And he hearkened unto their voice, and did so.

plain and the <u>06_JOS_11_16</u># So Joshua took all that land, the hills, and all the south country, and all the land of Goshen, and the valley, and the plain, and the mountain of Israel, and the valley of the same;

plain and the <u>42_LUK_06_17</u># And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed of their diseases;

plain country of <u>05_DEU_04_43</u> # [Namely], Bezer in the wilderness, in the plain country, of the Reubenites; and Ramoth in Gilead, of the Gadites; and Golan in Bashan, of the Manassites.

plain country round <u>16_NEH_12_28</u># And the sons of the singers gathered themselves together, both out of the plain country round about Jerusalem, and from the villages of Netophathi;

plain country upon <u>24_JER_48_21</u># And judgment is come upon the plain country; upon Holon, and upon Jahazah, and upon Mephaath,

plain Dibon and <u>06_JOS_13_17</u> # Heshbon, and all her cities that [are] in the plain; Dibon, and Bamothbaal, and Bethbaalmeon,

plain escape to <u>01_GEN_19_17</u># And it came to pass, when they had brought them forth abroad, that he said, Escape for thy life; look not behind thee, neither stay thou in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed.

plain even the <u>05_DEU_03_17</u># The plain also, and Jordan, and the coast [thereof], from Chinnereth even unto the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea, under Ashdothpisgah eastward.

plain even the <u>06_JOS_03_16</u># That the waters which came down from above stood [and] rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that [is] beside Zaretan: and those that came down toward the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea, failed, [and] were cut off: and the people passed over right against Jericho.

plain even the <u>06_JOS_12_03</u># And from the plain to the sea of Chinneroth on the east, and unto the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea on the east, the way to Bethjeshimoth; and from the south, under Ashdothpisgah:

plain from Elath <u>05_DEU_02_08</u># And when we passed by from our brethren the children of Esau, which dwelt in Seir, through the way of the plain from Elath, and from Eziongaber, we turned and passed by the way of the wilderness of Moab.

plain from Geba 38_ZEC_14_10 # All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the

first gate, unto the corner gate, and [from] the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.

plain in the <u>05_DEU_01_07</u># Turn you, and take your journey, and go to the mount of the Amorites, and unto all [the places] nigh thereunto, in the plain, in the hills, and in the vale, and in the south, and by the sea side, to the land of the Canaanites, and unto Lebanon, unto the great river, the river Euphrates.

plain in the <u>01_GEN_11_02</u># And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there.

plain man dwelling <u>01_GEN_25_27</u># And the boys grew: and Esau was a cunning hunter, a man of the field; and Jacob [was] a plain man, dwelling in tents.

plain of Aven 30 AMO 01 05 # I will break also the bar of Damascus, and cut off the inhabitant from the plain of Aven, and him that holdeth the sceptre from the house of Eden: and the people of Syria shall go into captivity unto Kir, saith the LORD.

plain of Dura <u>27_DAN_03_01</u># Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height [was] threescore cubits, [and] the breadth thereof six cubits: he set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon.

plain of Jordan <u>11_1KI_07_46</u># In the plain of Jordan did the king cast them, in the clay ground between Succoth and Zarthan.

plain of Jordan <u>14_2CH_04_17</u># In the plain of Jordan did the king cast them, in the clay ground between Succoth and Zeredathah.

plain of Jordan <u>01_GEN_13_10</u># And Lot lifted up his eyes, and beheld all the plain of Jordan, that it [was] well watered every where, before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah, [even] as the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt, as thou comest unto Zoar.

plain of Jordan <u>01_GEN_13_11</u># Then Lot chose him all the plain of Jordan; and Lot journeyed east: and they separated themselves the one from the other.

plain of Mamre <u>01_GEN_13_18</u> # Then Abram removed [his] tent, and came and dwelt in the plain of Mamre, which [is] in Hebron, and built there an altar unto the LORD.

plain of Mamre <u>01_GEN_14_13</u># And there came one that had escaped, and told Abram the Hebrew; for he dwelt in the plain of Mamre the Amorite, brother of Eshcol, and brother of Aner: and these [were] confederate with Abram.

plain of Medeba <u>06_JOS_13_09</u> # From Aroer, that [is] upon the bank of the river Arnon, and the city that [is] in the midst of the river, and all the plain of Medeba unto Dibon;

plain of Meonenim <u>07_JUD_09_37</u># And Gaal spake again and said, See there come people down by the middle of the land, and another company come along by the plain of Meonenim.

plain of Moreh <u>01_GEN_12_06</u> # And Abram passed through the land unto the place of Sichem, unto the plain of Moreh. And the Canaanite [was] then in the land.

plain of Ono <u>16_NEH_06_02</u> # That Sanballat and Geshem sent unto me, saying, Come, let us meet together in [some one of] the villages in the plain of Ono. But they thought to do me mischief.

plain of Tabor <u>09_1SA_10_03</u># Then shalt thou go on forward from thence, and thou shalt come to the plain of Tabor, and there shall meet thee three men going up to God to Bethel, one carrying three kids, and another carrying three loaves of bread, and another carrying a bottle of wine:

plain of the <u>10_2SA_15_28</u># See, I will tarry in the plain of the wilderness, until there come word from you to certify me.

plain of the <u>05_DEU_34_03</u># And the south, and the plain of the valley of Jericho, the city of palm trees, unto Zoar.

plain of the <u>07_JUD_09_06</u># And all the men of Shechem gathered together, and all the house of Millo, and went, and made Abimelech king, by the plain of the pillar that [was] in Shechem.

plain of the <u>07_JUD_11_33</u># And he smote them from Aroer, even till thou come to Minnith, [even] twenty cities, and unto the plain of the vineyards, with a very great slaughter. Thus the children of Ammon were subdued before the children of Israel.

plain of Zaanaim <u>07_JUD_04_11</u># Now Heber the Kenite, [which was] of the children of Hobab the father in law of Moses, had severed himself from the Kenites, and pitched his tent unto the plain of Zaanaim, which [is] by Kedesh.

plain on the <u>09_1SA_23_24</u> # And they arose, and went to Ziph before Saul: but David and his men [were] in the wilderness of Maon, in the plain on the south of Jeshimon.

plain on the <u>06_JOS_12_01</u> # Now these [are] the kings of the land, which the children of Israel smote, and possessed their land on the other side Jordan toward the rising of the sun, from the river Arnon unto mount Hermon, and all the plain on the east:

plain on this <u>05_DEU_04_49</u># And all the plain on this side Jordan eastward, even unto the sea of the plain, under the springs of Pisgah.

plain out of <u>06_JOS_20_08</u># And on the other side Jordan by Jericho eastward, they assigned Bezer in the wilderness upon the plain out of the tribe of Reuben, and Ramoth in Gilead out of the tribe of Gad, and Golan in Bashan out of the tribe of Manasseh.

plain path because 19_PSA_27_11 # Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.

plain saith the <u>24_JER_21_13</u># Behold, I [am] against thee, O inhabitant of the valley, [and] rock of the plain, saith the LORD; which say, Who shall come down against us? or who shall enter into our habitations?

plain shall be <u>24_JER_48_08</u># And the spoiler shall come upon every city, and no city shall escape: the valley also shall perish, and the plain shall be destroyed, as the LORD hath spoken.

plain that God <u>01_GEN_19_29</u># And it came to pass, when God destroyed the cities of the plain, that God remembered Abraham, and sent Lot out of the midst of the overthrow, when he overthrew the cities in the which Lot dwelt.

plain the face <u>23_ISA_28_25</u> # When he hath made plain the face thereof, doth he not cast abroad the fitches, and scatter the cummin, and cast in the principal wheat and the appointed barley and the rie in their place?

plain the Philistines 31_OBA_01_19 # And [they of] the south shall possess the mount of Esau; and [they of]

the plain the Philistines: and they shall possess the fields of Ephraim, and the fields of Samaria: and Benjamin [shall possess] Gilead.

plain to him <u>20_PRO_08_09</u> # They [are] all plain to him that understandeth, and right to them that find knowledge.

plain to the <u>06_JOS_12_03</u># And from the plain to the sea of Chinneroth on the east, and unto the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea on the east, the way to Bethjeshimoth; and from the south, under Ashdothpisgah:

plain under the <u>05_DEU_04_49</u># And all the plain on this side Jordan eastward, even unto the sea of the plain, under the springs of Pisgah.

plain upon tables <u>35_HAB_02_02</u> # And the LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make [it] plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.

plain 12 2KI 25 04 # And the city was broken up, and all the men of war [fled] by night by the way of the gate between two walls, which [is] by the king's garden: [now the Chaldees [were] against the city round about:] and [the king] went the way toward the plain.

plain <u>26_EZE_08_04</u># And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel [was] there, according to the vision that I saw in the plain.

plain <u>23_ISA_40_04</u> # Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low: and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain:

plain 24_JER_39_04 # And it came to pass, [that] when Zedekiah the king of Judah saw them, and all the men of war, then they fled, and went forth out of the city by night, by the way of the king's garden, by the gate betwixt the two walls: and he went out the way of the plain.

plain 24 JER 52 07 # Then the city was broken up, and all the men of war fled, and went forth out of the city by night by the way of the gate between the two walls, which [was] by the king's garden; [now the Chaldeans [were] by the city round about:] and they went by the way of the plain.

plain <u>41_MAR_07_35</u> # And straightway his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain.

plain 16_NEH_03_22 # And after him repaired the priests, the men of the plain.

plain 20_PRO_15_19 # The way of the slothful [man is] as an hedge of thorns: but the way of the righteous [is] made plain.

plain <u>38_ZEC_07_07</u> # [Should ye] not [hear] the words which the LORD hath cried by the former prophets, when Jerusalem was inhabited and in prosperity, and the cities thereof round about her, when [men] inhabited the south and the plain?

plainly and speakest <u>43_JOH_16_29</u> # His disciples said unto him, Lo, now speakest thou plainly, and speakest no proverb.

plainly appear unto <u>09_1SA_02_27</u> # And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?

plainly Lazarus is 43_JOH_11_14 # Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead.

plainly of the 43_JOH_16_25 # These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh,

when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall show you plainly of the Father.

plainly read before 15_EZR_04_18 # The letter which ye sent unto us hath been plainly read before me.

plainly say I <u>02_EXO_21_05</u># And if the servant shall plainly say, I love my master, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free:

plainly that the <u>09_1SA_10_16</u># And Saul said unto his uncle, He told us plainly that the asses were found. But of the matter of the kingdom, whereof Samuel spake, he told him not.

plainly that they 58_HEB_11_14# For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country.

plainly 05_DEU_27_08 # And thou shalt write upon the stones all the words of this law very plainly.

plainly 23 ISA 32 04 # The heart also of the rash shall understand knowledge, and the tongue of the stammerers shall be ready to speak plainly.

plainly <u>43_JOH_10_24</u> # Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly.

plainness of speech 47_2CO_03_12 # Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech:

plains and in <u>06_JOS_12_08</u># In the mountains, and in the valleys, and in the plains, and in the springs, and in the wilderness, and in the south country; the Hittites, the Amorites, and the Canaanites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites:

plains husbandmen also <u>14_2CH_26_10</u># Also he built towers in the desert, and digged many wells: for he had much cattle, both in the low country, and in the plains: husbandmen [also], and vine dressers in the mountains, and in Carmel: for he loved husbandry.

plains in abundance 14_2CH_09_27 # And the king made silver in Jerusalem as stones, and cedar trees made he as the sycamore trees that [are] in the low plains in abundance.

plains of Jericho <u>12_2KI_25_05</u># And the army of the Chaldees pursued after the king, and overtook him in the plains of Jericho: and all his army were scattered from him.

plains of Jericho <u>24_JER_39_05</u> # But the Chaldeans' army pursued after them, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho: and when they had taken him, they brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath, where he gave judgment upon him.

plains of Jericho <u>24_JER_52_08</u># But the army of the Chaldeans pursued after the king, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho; and all his army was scattered from him.

plains of Jericho <u>06_JOS_04_13</u># About forty thousand prepared for war passed over before the LORD unto battle, to the plains of Jericho.

plains of Jericho <u>06_JOS_05_10</u> # And the children of Israel encamped in Gilgal, and kept the passover on the fourteenth day of the month at even in the plains of Jericho.

plains of Mamre <u>01_GEN_18_01</u> # And the LORD appeared unto him in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day;

plains of Moab <u>06_JOS_13_32</u> # These [are the countries] which Moses did distribute for inheritance in the plains of Moab, on the other side Jordan, by Jericho, eastward.

plains of Moab <u>04_NUM_22_01</u># And the children of Israel set forward, and pitched in the plains of Moab on this side Jordan [by] Jericho.

plains of Moab <u>04_NUM_26_03</u> # And Moses and Eleazar the priest spake with them in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho, saying,

plains of Moab <u>04_NUM_26_63</u> # These [are] they that were numbered by Moses and Eleazar the priest, who numbered the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho.

plains of Moab <u>04_NUM_31_12</u># And they brought the captives, and the prey, and the spoil, unto Moses, and Eleazar the priest, and unto the congregation of the children of Israel, unto the camp at the plains of Moab, which [are] by Jordan [near] Jericho.

plains of Moab <u>04_NUM_33_48</u> # And they departed from the mountains of Abarim, and pitched in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho.

plains of Moab <u>04_NUM_33_49</u># And they pitched by Jordan, from Bethjesimoth [even] unto Abelshittim in the plains of Moab.

plains of Moab <u>04_NUM_33_50</u> # And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho, saying,

plains of Moab <u>04_NUM_35_01</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho, saying,

plains of Moab <u>04_NUM_36_13</u># These [are] the commandments and the judgments, which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses unto the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho.

plains of Moreh <u>05 DEU_11_30</u># [Are] they not on the other side Jordan, by the way where the sun goeth down, in the land of the Canaanites, which dwell in the champaign over against Gilgal, beside the plains of Moreh?

plains of the <u>10_2SA_17_16</u># Now therefore send quickly, and tell David, saying, Lodge not this night in the plains of the wilderness, but speedily pass over; lest the king be swallowed up, and all the people that [are] with him.

plains south of <u>06_JOS_11_02</u># And to the kings that [were] on the north of the mountains, and of the plains south of Chinneroth, and in the valley, and in the borders of Dor on the west,

plains was Baalhanan <u>13_1CH_27_28</u> # And over the olive trees and the sycamore trees that [were] in the low plains [was] Baalhanan the Gederite: and over the cellars of oil [was] Joash:
