plenty and be [29 JOE 02 26](#) # And ye shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the LORD your God, that hath dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed.

plenty and thy [20 PRO 03 10](#) # So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

plenty for the [14 2CH 31 10](#) # And Azariah the chief priest of the house of Zadok answered him, and said, Since [the people] began to bring the offerings into the house of the LORD, we have had enough to eat, and have left plenty: for the LORD hath blessed his people; and that which is left [is] this great store.

plenty of almug [11 1KI 10 11](#) # And the navy also of Hiram, that brought gold from Ophir, brought in from Ophir great plenty of almug trees, and precious stones.

plenty of bread [20 PRO 28 19](#) # He that tilleth his land shall have plenty of bread: but he that followeth after vain [persons] shall have poverty enough.

plenty of corn [01 GEN 27 28](#) # Therefore God give thee of the dew of heaven, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine:

plenty of justice [18 JOB 37 23](#) # [Touching] the Almighty, we cannot find him out: [he is] excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice: he will not afflict.

plenty of silver [18 JOB 22 25](#) # Yea, the Almighty shall be thy defence, and thou shalt have plenty of silver.

plenty of victuals [24 JER 44 17](#) # But we will certainly do whatsoever thing goeth forth out of our own mouth, to burn incense unto the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her, as we have done, we, and our fathers, our kings, and our princes, in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem: for [then] had we plenty of victuals, and were well, and saw no evil.

plenty of water [03 LEV 11 36](#) # Nevertheless a fountain or pit, [wherein there is] plenty of water, shall be clean: but that which toucheth their carcase shall be unclean.

plenty shall be [01 GEN 41 30](#) # And there shall arise after them seven years of famine; and all the plenty shall be forgotten in the land of Egypt; and the famine shall consume the land;

plenty shall not [01 GEN 41 31](#) # And the plenty shall not be known in the land by reason of that famine following; for it [shall be] very grievous.
