poverty abounded unto [47_2CO_08_02](#) # How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality.

poverty and drowsiness [20_PRO_23_21](#) # For the drunkard and the glutton shall come to poverty: and drowsiness shall clothe [a man] with rags.

poverty and remember [20_PRO_31_07](#) # Let him drink, and forget his poverty, and remember his misery no more.

Poverty and shame [20_PRO_13_18](#) # Poverty and shame [shall be to] him that refuseth instruction: but he that regardeth reproof shall be honoured.

poverty but thou [66_REV_02_09](#) # I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, [but thou art rich] and [I know] the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but [are] the synagogue of Satan.

poverty come as [20_PRO_06_11](#) # So shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth, and thy want as an armed man.

poverty come as [20_PRO_24_34](#) # So shall thy poverty come [as] one that travelleth; and thy want as an armed man.

poverty enough [20_PRO_28_19](#) # He that tilleth his land shall have plenty of bread: but he that followeth after vain [persons] shall have poverty enough.

poverty might be [47_2CO_08_09](#) # For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

poverty nor riches [20_PRO_30_08](#) # Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me:

poverty open thine [20_PRO_20_13](#) # Love not sleep, lest thou come to poverty; open thine eyes, [and] thou shalt be satisfied with bread.

poverty shall come [20_PRO_28_22](#) # He that hasteth to be rich [hath] an evil eye, and considereth not that poverty shall come upon him.

poverty [01_GEN_45_11](#) # And there will I nourish thee; for yet [there are] five years of famine; lest thou, and thy household, and all that thou hast, come to poverty.

poverty [20_PRO_10_15](#) # The rich man's wealth [is] his strong city: the destruction of the poor [is] their poverty.
