prevail against him [09 ISA 17 09](#) # If he be able to fight with me, and to kill me, then will we be your servants: but if I prevail against him, and kill him, then shall ye be our servants, and serve us.

prevail against him [21 ECC 04 12](#) # And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

prevail against him [17 EST 06 13](#) # And Haman told Zeresh his wife and all his friends every [thing] that had befallen him. Then said his wise men and Zeresh his wife unto him, If Mordecai [be] of the seed of the Jews, before whom thou hast begun to fall, thou shalt not prevail against him, but shalt surely fall before him.

prevail against him [24 JER 20 10](#) # For I heard the defaming of many, fear on every side. Report, [say they], and we will report it. All my familiars watched for my halting, [saying], Peradventure he will be enticed, and we shall prevail against him, and we shall take our revenge on him.

prevail against him [18 JOB 15 24](#) # Trouble and anguish shall make him afraid; they shall prevail against him, as a king ready to the battle.

prevail against him [18 JOB 18 09](#) # The gin shall take [him] by the heel, [and] the robber shall prevail against him.

prevail against him [07 JUD 16 05](#) # And the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and said unto her, Entice him, and see wherein his great strength [lieth], and by what [means] we may prevail against him, that we may bind him to afflict him: and we will give thee every one of us eleven hundred [pieces] of silver.

prevail against his [23 ISA 42 13](#) # The LORD shall go forth as a mighty man, he shall stir up jealousy like a man of war: he shall cry, yea, roar; he shall prevail against his enemies.

prevail against it [23 ISA 07 01](#) # And it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, [that] Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up toward Jerusalem to war against it, but could not prevail against it.

prevail against it [40 MAT 16 18](#) # And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

prevail against me [19 PSA 65 03](#) # Iniquities prevail against me: [as for] our transgressions, thou shalt purge them away.

prevail against thee [14 2CH 14 11](#) # And Asa cried unto the LORD his God, and said, LORD, [it is] nothing with thee to help, whether with many, or with them that have no power: help us, O LORD our God; for we rest on thee, and in thy name we go against this multitude. O LORD, thou [art] our God; let not man prevail against thee.

prevail against thee [24 JER 01 19](#) # And they shall fight against thee; but they shall not prevail against thee; for I [am] with thee, saith the LORD, to deliver thee.

prevail against thee [24 JER 15 20](#) # And I will make thee unto this people a fenced brazen wall: and they shall fight against thee, but they shall not prevail against thee: for I [am] with thee to save thee and to

deliver thee, saith the LORD.

prevail also go [11 1KI 22 22](#) # And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade [him], and prevail also: go forth, and do so.

prevail and the [01 GEN 07 20](#) # Fifteen cubits upward did the waters prevail; and the mountains were covered.

prevail go out [14 2CH 18 21](#) # And he said, I will go out, and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And [the LORD] said, Thou shalt entice [him], and thou shalt also prevail: go out, and do [even] so.

prevail let the [19 PSA 09 19](#) # Arise, O LORD; let not man prevail: let the heathen be judged in thy sight.

prevail nothing behold [43 JOH 12 19](#) # The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him.

prevail nothing but [40 MAT 27 24](#) # When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but [that] rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed [his] hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye [to it].

prevail our lips [19 PSA 12 04](#) # Who have said, With our tongue will we prevail; our lips [are] our own: who [is] lord over us?

prevail So David [09 1SA 26 25](#) # Then Saul said to David, Blessed [be] thou, my son David: thou shalt both do great [things], and also shalt still prevail. So David went on his way, and Saul returned to his place.

prevail that we [04 NUM 22 06](#) # Come now therefore, I pray thee, curse me this people; for they [are] too mighty for me: peradventure I shall prevail, [that] we may smite them, and [that] I may drive them out of the land: for I wot that he whom thou blessest [is] blessed, and he whom thou cursest is cursed.

prevail they shall [24 JER 20 11](#) # But the LORD [is] with me as a mighty terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not prosper: [their] everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten.

prevail though they [24 JER 05 22](#) # Fear ye not me? saith the LORD: will ye not tremble at my presence, which have placed the sand [for] the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it: and though the waves thereof toss themselves, yet can they not prevail; though they roar, yet can they not pass over it?

prevail [09 1SA 02 09](#) # He will keep the feet of his saints, and the wicked shall be silent in darkness; for by strength shall no man prevail.

prevail [27 DAN 11 07](#) # But out of a branch of her roots shall [one] stand up in his estate, which shall come with an army, and shall enter into the fortress of the king of the north, and shall deal against them, and shall prevail:

prevail [23 ISA 16 12](#) # And it shall come to pass, when it is seen that Moab is weary on the high place, that he shall come to his sanctuary to pray; but he shall not prevail.

prevail [23 ISA 47 12](#) # Stand now with thine enchantments, and with the multitude of thy sorceries, wherein thou hast laboured from thy youth; if so be thou shalt be able to profit, if so be thou mayest prevail.

prevailed above his [13_1CH_05_02](#) # For Judah prevailed above his brethren, and of him [came] the chief ruler; but the birthright [was] Joseph's:

prevailed above the [01_GEN_49_26](#) # The blessings of thy father have prevailed above the blessings of my progenitors unto the utmost bound of the everlasting hills: they shall be on the head of Joseph, and on the crown of the head of him that was separate from his brethren.

prevailed against Chushanrishathaim [07_JUD_03_10](#) # And the spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he judged Israel, and went out to war: and the LORD delivered Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand; and his hand prevailed against Chushanrishathaim.

prevailed against him [19_PSA_13_04](#) # Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; [and] those that trouble me rejoice when I am moved.

prevailed against Israel [07_JUD_06_02](#) # And the hand of Midian prevailed against Israel: [and] because of the Midianites the children of Israel made them the dens which [are] in the mountains, and caves, and strong holds.

prevailed against it [14_2CH_08_03](#) # And Solomon went to Hamathzobah, and prevailed against it.

prevailed against Jabin [07_JUD_04_24](#) # And the hand of the children of Israel prospered, and prevailed against Jabin the king of Canaan, until they had destroyed Jabin king of Canaan.

prevailed against Joab [13_1CH_21_04](#) # Nevertheless the king's word prevailed against Joab. Wherefore Joab departed, and went throughout all Israel, and came to Jerusalem.

prevailed against Joab [10_2SA_24_04](#) # Notwithstanding the king's word prevailed against Joab, and against the captains of the host. And Joab and the captains of the host went out from the presence of the king, to number the people of Israel.

prevailed against me [19_PSA_129_02](#) # Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth: yet they have not prevailed against me.

prevailed against the [11_1KI_16_22](#) # But the people that followed Omri prevailed against the people that followed Tibni the son of Ginath: so Tibni died, and Omri reigned.

prevailed against thee [24_JER_38_22](#) # And, behold, all the women that are left in the king of Judah's house [shall be] brought forth to the king of Babylon's princes, and those [women] shall say, Thy friends have set thee on, and have prevailed against thee: thy feet are sunk in the mire, [and] they are turned away back.

prevailed against thee [31_OBA_01_07](#) # All the men of thy confederacy have brought thee [even] to the border: the men that were at peace with thee have deceived thee, [and] prevailed against thee; [they that eat] thy bread have laid a wound under thee: [there is] none understanding in him.

prevailed against them [14_2CH_27_05](#) # He fought also with the king of the Ammonites, and prevailed against them. And the children of Ammon gave him the same year an hundred talents of silver, and ten thousand measures of wheat, and ten thousand of barley. So much did the children of Ammon pay unto him, both the second year, and the third.

prevailed against them [44_ACT_19_16](#) # And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

prevailed against them [27_DAN_07_21](#) # I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them;

prevailed against us [10 2SA 11 23](#) # And the messenger said unto David, Surely the men prevailed against us, and came out unto us into the field, and we were upon them even unto the entering of the gate.

prevailed and she [01 GEN 30 08](#) # And Rachel said, With great wrestlings have I wrestled with my sister, and I have prevailed: and she called his name Naphtali.

prevailed and were [01 GEN 07 18](#) # And the waters prevailed, and were increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters.

prevailed and when [02 EXO 17 11](#) # And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

prevailed because they [14 2CH 13 18](#) # Thus the children of Israel were brought under at that time, and the children of Judah prevailed, because they relied upon the LORD God of their fathers.

prevailed exceedingly upon [01 GEN 07 19](#) # And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth; and all the high hills, that [were] under the whole heaven, were covered.

prevailed he wept [28 HOS 12 04](#) # Yea, he had power over the angel, and prevailed: he wept, and made supplication unto him: he found him [in] Bethel, and there he spake with us;

prevailed I am [24 JER 20 07](#) # O LORD, thou hast deceived me, and I was deceived: thou art stronger than I, and hast prevailed: I am in derision daily, every one mocketh me.

prevailed in the [12 2KI 25 03](#) # And on the ninth [day] of the [fourth] month the famine prevailed in the city, and there was no bread for the people of the land.

prevailed not against [01 GEN 32 25](#) # And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh; and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him.

prevailed not neither [66 REV 12 08](#) # And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven.

prevailed over the [09 1SA 17 50](#) # So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and with a stone, and smote the Philistine, and slew him; but [there was] no sword in the hand of David.

prevailed over them [01 GEN 47 20](#) # And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

prevailed so that [07 JUD 01 35](#) # But the Amorites would dwell in mount Heres in Aijalon, and in Shaalvim: yet the hand of the house of Joseph prevailed, so that they became tributaries.

prevailed to open [66 REV 05 05](#) # And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

prevailed upon the [01 GEN 07 24](#) # And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days.

prevailed [44 ACT 19 20](#) # So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed.

prevailed [02 EXO 17 11](#) # And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

prevailed [01 GEN 32 28](#) # And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed.

prevailed [25 LAM 01 16](#) # For these [things] I weep; mine eye, mine eye runneth down with water, because the comforter that should relieve my soul is far from me: my children are desolate, because the enemy prevailed.

prevailed [42 LUK 23 23](#) # And they were instant with loud voices, requiring that he might be crucified. And the voices of them and of the chief priests prevailed.

prevailed for ever [18 JOB 14 20](#) # Thou prevailedst for ever against him, and he passeth: thou changest his countenance, and sendest him away.

prevaileth against them [25 LAM 01 13](#) # From above hath he sent fire into my bones, and it prevaileth against them: he hath spread a net for my feet, he hath turned me back: he hath made me desolate [and] faint all the day.
