privily for me [19 PSA 31 04](#) # Pull me out of the net that they have laid privily for me: for thou [art] my strength.

privily for the [20 PRO 01 11](#) # If they say, Come with us, let us lay wait for blood, let us lurk privily for the innocent without cause:

privily for their [20 PRO 01 18](#) # And they lay wait for their [own] blood; they lurk privily for their [own] lives.

privily laid a [19 PSA 142 03](#) # When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then thou knewest my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a snare for me.

privily nay verily [44 ACT 16 37](#) # But Paul said unto them, They have beaten us openly uncondemned, being Romans, and have cast [us] into prison; and now do they thrust us out privily? nay verily; but let them come themselves and fetch us out.

privily saying Behold [07 JUD 09 31](#) # And he sent messengers unto Abimelech privily, saying, Behold, Gaal the son of Ebed and his brethren be come to Shechem; and, behold, they fortify the city against thee.

privily set against [19 PSA 10 08](#) # He sitteth in the lurking places of the villages: in the secret places doth he murder the innocent: his eyes are privily set against the poor.

privily shall bring [61 2PE 02 01](#) # But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

privily shoot at [19 PSA 11 02](#) # For, lo, the wicked bend [their] bow, they make ready their arrow upon the string, that they may privily shoot at the upright in heart.

privily slandereth his [19 PSA 101 05](#) # Whoso privily slandereth his neighbour, him will I cut off: him that hath an high look and a proud heart will not I suffer.

privily they say [19 PSA 64 05](#) # They encourage themselves [in] an evil matter: they commune of laying snares privily; they say, Who shall see them?

privily to spy [48 GAL 02 04](#) # And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:

privily [09 ISA 24 04](#) # And the men of David said unto him, Behold the day of which the LORD said unto thee, Behold, I will deliver thine enemy into thine hand, that thou mayest do to him as it shall seem good unto thee. Then David arose, and cut off the skirt of Saul's robe privily.

privily [40 MAT 01 19](#) # Then Joseph her husband, being a just [man], and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her away privily.
