

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

queen also before <u>17\_EST\_07\_08</u> # Then the king returned out of the palace garden into the place of the banquet of wine; and Haman was fallen upon the bed whereon Esther [was]. Then said the king, Will he force the queen also before me in the house? As the word went out of the king's mouth, they covered Haman's face.

queen also sitting <u>16\_NEH\_02\_06</u> # And the king said unto me, [the queen also sitting by him,] For how long shall thy journey be? and when wilt thou return? So it pleased the king to send me; and I set him a time.

queen and am <u>66\_REV\_18\_07</u># How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.

queen and Esther <u>17\_EST\_02\_22</u># And the thing was known to Mordecai, who told [it] unto Esther the queen; and Esther certified the king [thereof] in Mordecai's name.

queen And Mordecai <u>17\_EST\_08\_01</u> # On that day did the king Ahasuerus give the house of Haman the Jews' enemy unto Esther the queen. And Mordecai came before the king; for Esther had told what he [was] unto her.

queen and the <u>24\_JER\_29\_02</u> # [After that Jeconiah the king, and the queen, and the eunuchs, the princes of Judah and Jerusalem, and the carpenters, and the smiths, were departed from Jerusalem;]

queen and to <u>17\_EST\_08\_07</u> # Then the king Ahasuerus said unto Esther the queen and to Mordecai the Jew, Behold, I have given Esther the house of Haman, and him they have hanged upon the gallows, because he laid his hand upon the Jews.

queen answered and <u>17\_EST\_07\_03</u># Then Esther the queen answered and said, If I have found favour in thy sight, O king, and if it please the king, let my life be given me at my petition, and my people at my request:

queen because she <u>11\_1KI\_15\_13</u># And also Maachah his mother, even her he removed from [being] queen, because she had made an idol in a grove; and Asa destroyed her idol, and burnt [it] by the brook Kidron.

queen because she <u>14\_2CH\_15\_16</u> # And also [concerning] Maachah the mother of Asa the king, he removed her from [being] queen, because she had made an idol in a grove: and Asa cut down her idol, and stamped [it], and burnt [it] at the brook Kidron.

queen before the <u>17\_EST\_01\_11</u># To bring Vashti the queen before the king with the crown royal, to show the people and the princes her beauty: for she [was] fair to look on.

queen by reason <u>27\_DAN\_05\_10</u> # [Now] the queen by reason of the words of the king and his lords came into the banquet house: [and] the queen spake and said, O king, live for ever: let not thy thoughts trouble thee, nor let thy countenance be changed:

queen did let <u>17\_EST\_05\_12</u> # Haman said moreover, Yea, Esther the queen did let no man come in with the king unto the banquet that she had prepared but myself; and to morrow am I invited unto her also with

the king.

queen Esther and <u>17\_EST\_05\_03</u># Then said the king unto her, What wilt thou, queen Esther? and what [is] thy request? it shall be even given thee to the half of the kingdom.

queen Esther and <u>17\_EST\_07\_02</u># And the king said again unto Esther on the second day at the banquet of wine, What [is] thy petition, queen Esther? and it shall be granted thee: and what [is] thy request? and it shall be performed, [even] to the half of the kingdom.

queen exceedingly grieved <u>17\_EST\_04\_04</u> # So Esther's maids and her chamberlains came and told [it] her. Then was the queen exceedingly grieved; and she sent raiment to clothe Mordecai, and to take away his sackcloth from him: but he received [it] not.

queen for he <u>17\_EST\_07\_07</u># And the king arising from the banquet of wine in his wrath [went] into the palace garden: and Haman stood up to make request for his life to Esther the queen; for he saw that there was evil determined against him by the king.

queen had enjoined <u>17\_EST\_09\_31</u> # To confirm these days of Purim in their times [appointed], according as Mordecai the Jew and Esther the queen had enjoined them, and as they had decreed for themselves and for their seed, the matters of the fastings and their cry.

queen hath not <u>17\_EST\_01\_16</u> # And Memucan answered before the king and the princes, Vashti the queen hath not done wrong to the king only, but also to all the princes, and to all the people that [are] in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

queen Humble yourselves 24\_JER\_13\_18 # Say unto the king and to the queen, Humble yourselves, sit down: for your principalities shall come down, [even] the crown of your glory.

queen in gold <u>19\_PSA\_45\_09</u># Kings' daughters [were] among thy honourable women: upon thy right hand did stand the queen in gold of Ophir.

queen instead of <u>17\_EST\_02\_04</u> # And let the maiden which pleaseth the king be queen instead of Vashti. And the thing pleased the king; and he did so.

queen instead of <u>17\_EST\_02\_17</u> # And the king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.

queen made a <u>17\_EST\_01\_09</u># Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women [in] the royal house which [belonged] to king Ahasuerus.

queen of heaven 24\_JER\_07\_18 # The children gather wood, and the fathers kindle the fire, and the women knead [their] dough, to make cakes to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto other gods, that they may provoke me to anger.

queen of heaven <u>24\_JER\_44\_17</u> # But we will certainly do whatsoever thing goeth forth out of our own mouth, to burn incense unto the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her, as we have done, we, and our fathers, our kings, and our princes, in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem: for [then] had we plenty of victuals, and were well, and saw no evil.

queen of heaven <u>24\_JER\_44\_18</u> # But since we left off to burn incense to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her, we have wanted all [things], and have been consumed by the sword and by the famine.

queen of heaven 24\_JER\_44\_19 # And when we burned incense to the queen of heaven, and poured out

drink offerings unto her, did we make her cakes to worship her, and pour out drink offerings unto her, without our men?

queen of heaven <u>24 JER\_44\_25</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saying; Ye and your wives have both spoken with your mouths, and fulfilled with your hand, saying, We will surely perform our vows that we have vowed, to burn incense to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto her: ye will surely accomplish your vows, and surely perform your vows.

queen of Sheba <u>11\_1KI\_10\_01</u># And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD, she came to prove him with hard questions.

queen of Sheba <u>11\_1KI\_10\_04</u># And when the queen of Sheba had seen all Solomon's wisdom, and the house that he had built,

queen of Sheba <u>11\_1KI\_10\_10</u># And she gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices very great store, and precious stones: there came no more such abundance of spices as these which the queen of Sheba gave to king Solomon.

queen of Sheba <u>11\_1KI\_10\_13</u># And king Solomon gave unto the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatsoever she asked, beside [that] which Solomon gave her of his royal bounty. So she turned and went to her own country, she and her servants.

queen of Sheba <u>14\_2CH\_09\_01</u> # And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon, she came to prove Solomon with hard questions at Jerusalem, with a very great company, and camels that bare spices, and gold in abundance, and precious stones: and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart.

queen of Sheba <u>14\_2CH\_09\_03</u># And when the queen of Sheba had seen the wisdom of Solomon, and the house that he had built,

queen of Sheba <u>14\_2CH\_09\_09</u># And she gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices great abundance, and precious stones: neither was there any such spice as the queen of Sheba gave king Solomon.

queen of Sheba <u>14\_2CH\_09\_12</u># And king Solomon gave to the queen of Sheba all her desire, whatsoever she asked, beside [that] which she had brought unto the king. So she turned, and went away to her own land, she and her servants.

queen of the <u>44\_ACT\_08\_27</u> # And he arose and went: and, behold, a man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure, and had come to Jerusalem for to worship,

queen of the <u>42\_LUK\_11\_31</u># The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation, and condemn them: for she came from the utmost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon [is] here.

queen of the <u>40\_MAT\_12\_42</u># The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for she came from the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon [is] here.

queen shall come <u>17\_EST\_01\_17</u> # For [this] deed of the queen shall come abroad unto all women, so that they shall despise their husbands in their eyes, when it shall be reported, The king Ahasuerus commanded Vashti the queen to be brought in before him, but she came not.

queen spake and <u>27\_DAN\_05\_10</u># [Now] the queen by reason of the words of the king and his lords came

into the banquet house: [and] the queen spake and said, O king, live for ever: let not thy thoughts trouble thee, nor let thy countenance be changed:

queen standing in <u>17\_EST\_05\_02</u># And it was so, when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, [that] she obtained favour in his sight: and the king held out to Esther the golden sceptre that [was] in his hand. So Esther drew near, and touched the top of the sceptre.

queen the daughter <u>17\_EST\_09\_29</u> # Then Esther the queen, the daughter of Abihail, and Mordecai the Jew, wrote with all authority, to confirm this second letter of Purim.

queen The Jews <u>17\_EST\_09\_12</u> # And the king said unto Esther the queen, The Jews have slain and destroyed five hundred men in Shushan the palace, and the ten sons of Haman; what have they done in the rest of the king's provinces? now what [is] thy petition? and it shall be granted thee: or what [is] thy request further? and it shall be done.

queen Thus shall <u>17\_EST\_01\_18</u># [Likewise] shall the ladies of Persia and Media say this day unto all the king's princes, which have heard of the deed of the queen. Thus [shall there arise] too much contempt and wrath.

queen to be <u>17\_EST\_01\_17</u># For [this] deed of the queen shall come abroad unto all women, so that they shall despise their husbands in their eyes, when it shall be reported, The king Ahasuerus commanded Vashti the queen to be brought in before him, but she came not.

queen Vashti according <u>17\_EST\_01\_15</u># What shall we do unto the queen Vashti according to law, because she hath not performed the commandment of the king Ahasuerus by the chamberlains?

queen Vashti refused <u>17\_EST\_01\_12</u># But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by [his] chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

queen Who is <u>17\_EST\_07\_05</u># Then the king Ahasuerus answered and said unto Esther the queen, Who is he, and where is he, that durst presume in his heart to do so?

queen <u>11\_1KI\_11\_19</u># And Hadad found great favour in the sight of Pharaoh, so that he gave him to wife the sister of his own wife, the sister of Tahpenes the queen.

queen <u>12\_2KI\_10\_13</u># Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who [are] ye? And they answered, We [are] the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

queen <u>**17\_EST\_07\_01</u>**# So the king and Haman came to banquet with Esther the queen.</u>

queen <u>17\_EST\_07\_06</u># And Esther said, The adversary and enemy [is] this wicked Haman. Then Haman was afraid before the king and the queen.

queens and fourscore <u>22\_SON\_06\_08</u># There are threescore queens, and fourscore concubines, and virgins without number.

queens and the <u>22\_SON\_06\_09</u> # My dove, my undefiled is [but] one; she [is] the [only] one of her mother, she [is] the choice [one] of her that bare her. The daughters saw her, and blessed her; [yea], the queens and the concubines, and they praised her.

queens thy nursing 23\_ISA\_49\_23 # And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with [their] face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I [am] the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.
