refrain for thee 23 ISA 48 09 # For my name's sake will I defer mine anger, and for my praise will I refrain for thee, that I cut thee not off.

refrain from embracing 21 ECC 03 05 # A time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;

Refrain from these 44 ACT 05 38 # And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought:

refrain himself before 01 GEN 45 01 # Then Joseph could not refrain himself before all them that stood by him; and he cried, Cause every man to go out from me. And there stood no man with him, while Joseph made himself known unto his brethren.

refrain his tongue 60 1PE 03 10 # For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile:

refrain my mouth 18 JOB 07 11# Therefore I will not refrain my mouth; I will speak in the anguish of my spirit; I will complain in the bitterness of my soul.

refrain thy foot 20 PRO 01 15 # My son, walk not thou in the way with them; refrain thy foot from their path:

Refrain thy voice 24 JER 31 16 # Thus saith the LORD; Refrain thy voice from weeping, and thine eyes from tears: for thy work shall be rewarded, saith the LORD; and they shall come again from the land of the enemy.

refrain thyself for 23 ISA 64 12 # Wilt thou refrain thyself for these [things], O LORD? wilt thou hold thy peace, and afflict us very sore?

refrained himself and 17 EST 05 10 # Nevertheless Haman refrained himself: and when he came home, he sent and called for his friends, and Zeresh his wife.

refrained himself and 01 GEN 43 31# And he washed his face, and went out, and refrained himself, and said, Set on bread.

refrained my feet 19 PSA 119 101# I have refrained my feet from every evil way, that I might keep thy word.

refrained my lips 19 PSA 40 09 # I have preached righteousness in the great congregation: lo, I have not refrained my lips, O LORD, thou knowest.

refrained myself now 23 ISA 42 14# I have long time holden my peace; I have been still, [and] refrained myself: [now] will I cry like a travailing woman; I will destroy and devour at once.

refrained talking and $\underline{18\ \text{JOB}\ 29\ 09}$. The princes refrained talking, and laid [their] hand on their mouth.

refrained their feet 24 JER 14 10 # Thus saith the LORD unto this people, Thus have they loved to wander, they have not refrained their feet, therefore the LORD doth not accept them; he will now remember their iniquity, and visit their sins.

refraineth his lips 20 PRO 10 19 # In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refraineth his lips [is] wise.
