refresh himself [44 ACT 27 03](#) # And the next [day] we touched at Sidon. And Julius courteously entreated Paul, and gave [him] liberty to go unto his friends to refresh himself.

refresh my bowels [57 PHM 01 20](#) # Yea, brother, let me have joy of thee in the Lord: refresh my bowels in the Lord.

refresh thyself and [11 1KI 13 07](#) # And the king said unto the man of God, Come home with me, and refresh thyself, and I will give thee a reward.

refreshed and was [09 ISA 16 23](#) # And it came to pass, when the [evil] spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.
