robbed all that <u>07\_JUD\_09\_25</u># And the men of Shechem set liers in wait for him in the top of the mountains, and they robbed all that came along that way by them: and it was told Abimelech.

robbed and spoiled <u>23\_ISA\_42\_22</u> # But this [is] a people robbed and spoiled; [they are] all of them snared in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivereth; for a spoil, and none saith, Restore.

robbed me But 39\_MAL\_03\_08 # Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

robbed me but 19\_PSA\_119\_61 # The bands of the wicked have robbed me: [but] I have not forgotten thy law.

robbed me even <u>39\_MAL\_03\_09</u> # Ye [are] cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, [even] this whole nation.

robbed of her 10\_2SA\_17\_08 # For, said Hushai, thou knowest thy father and his men, that they [be] mighty men, and they [be] chafed in their minds, as a bear robbed of her whelps in the field: and thy father [is] a man of war, and will not lodge with the people.

robbed of her 20\_PRO\_17\_12 # Let a bear robbed of her whelps meet a man, rather than a fool in his folly.

robbed other churches 47\_2CO\_11\_08 # I robbed other churches, taking wages [of them], to do you service.

robbed thee In <u>39\_MAL\_03\_08</u># Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

robbed their treasures 23 ISA 10 13 # For he saith, By the strength of my hand I have done [it], and by my wisdom; for I am prudent: and I have removed the bounds of the people, and have robbed their treasures, and I have put down the inhabitants like a valiant [man]:

robbed them saith <u>26\_EZE\_39\_10</u> # So that they shall take no wood out of the field, neither cut down [any] out of the forests; for they shall burn the weapons with fire: and they shall spoil those that spoiled them, and rob those that robbed them, saith the Lord GOD.

robbed walk in <u>26\_EZE\_33\_15</u> # [If] the wicked restore the pledge, give again that he had robbed, walk in the statutes of life, without committing iniquity; he shall surely live, he shall not die.

robbed 24\_JER\_50\_37 # A sword [is] upon their horses, and upon their chariots, and upon all the mingled people that [are] in the midst of her; and they shall become as women: a sword [is] upon her treasures; and they shall be robbed.
