

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

robe and a <u>02_EXO_28_04</u> # And these [are] the garments which they shall make; a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a broidered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: and they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

robe and a <u>18_JOB_29_14</u> # I put on righteousness, and it clothed me: my judgment [was] as a robe and a diadem.

robe and killed <u>09_1SA_24_11</u> # Moreover, my father, see, yea, see the skirt of thy robe in my hand: for in that I cut off the skirt of thy robe, and killed thee not, know thou and see that [there is] neither evil nor transgression in mine hand, and I have not sinned against thee; yet thou huntest my soul to take it.

robe And Pilate <u>43_JOH_19_05</u> # Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And [Pilate] saith unto them, Behold the man!

robe and put <u>03_LEV_08_07</u># And he put upon him the coat, and girded him with the girdle, and clothed him with the robe, and put the ephod upon him, and he girded him with the curious girdle of the ephod, and bound [it] unto him therewith.

robe and put <u>42_LUK_15_22</u># But the father said to his servants, Bring forth the best robe, and put [it] on him; and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on [his] feet:

robe and sent <u>42_LUK_23_11</u># And Herod with his men of war set him at nought, and mocked [him], and arrayed him in a gorgeous robe, and sent him again to Pilate.

robe and strengthen <u>23_ISA_22_21</u># And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah.

robe as the <u>02_EXO_39_23</u> # And [there was] an hole in the midst of the robe, as the hole of an habergeon, [with] a band round about the hole, that it should not rend.

robe from him <u>32_JON_03_06</u> # For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered [him] with sackcloth, and sat in ashes.

robe in my <u>09_1SA_24_11</u> # Moreover, my father, see, yea, see the skirt of thy robe in my hand: for in that I cut off the skirt of thy robe, and killed thee not, know thou and see that [there is] neither evil nor transgression in mine hand, and I have not sinned against thee; yet thou huntest my soul to take it.

robe of fine 13_1CH_15_27 # And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.

robe of righteousness <u>23_ISA_61_10</u> # I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh [himself] with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth [herself] with her jewels.

robe of the 02_EXO_28_31 # And thou shalt make the robe of the ephod all [of] blue.

robe of the <u>02_EXO_29_05</u># And thou shalt take the garments, and put upon Aaron the coat, and the robe of the ephod, and the ephod, and the breastplate, and gird him with the curious girdle of the ephod:

robe of the 02_EXO_39_22 # And he made the robe of the ephod [of] woven work, all [of] blue.

robe off from 40_MAT_27_31 # And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify [him].

robe pomegranates of <u>02_EXO_39_24</u> # And they made upon the hems of the robe pomegranates [of] blue, and purple, and scarlet, [and] twined [linen].

robe privily <u>09_1SA_24_04</u># And the men of David said unto him, Behold the day of which the LORD said unto thee, Behold, I will deliver thine enemy into thine hand, that thou mayest do to him as it shall seem good unto thee. Then David arose, and cut off the skirt of Saul's robe privily.

robe round about <u>02_EXO_28_34</u> # A golden bell and a pomegranate, a golden bell and a pomegranate, upon the hem of the robe round about.

robe round about <u>02_EXO_39_25</u> # And they made bells [of] pure gold, and put the bells between the pomegranates upon the hem of the robe, round about between the pomegranates;

robe that was <u>09_1SA_18_04</u> # And Jonathan stripped himself of the robe that [was] upon him, and gave it to David, and his garments, even to his sword, and to his bow, and to his girdle.

robe to minister <u>02_EXO_39_26</u> # A bell and a pomegranate, a bell and a pomegranate, round about the hem of the robe to minister [in]; as the LORD commanded Moses.

robe with the <u>33_MIC_02_08</u># Even of late my people is risen up as an enemy: ye pull off the robe with the garment from them that pass by securely as men averse from war.

robe <u>43_JOH_19_02</u> # And the soldiers platted a crown of thorns, and put [it] on his head, and they put on him a purple robe,

robe 40_MAT_27_28# And they stripped him, and put on him a scarlet robe.

robes and love <u>42_LUK_20_46</u># Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts;

robes and made <u>66_REV_07_14</u># And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

robes and palms <u>66_REV_07_09</u> # After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

robes and put <u>26_EZE_26_16</u> # Then all the princes of the sea shall come down from their thrones, and lay away their robes, and put off their broidered garments: they shall clothe themselves with trembling; they shall sit upon the ground, and shall tremble at [every] moment, and be astonished at thee.

robes in a 11_1KI_22_10# And the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat the king of Judah sat each on his throne, having put on their robes, in a void place in the entrance of the gate of Samaria; and all the prophets prophesied before them.

robes So the <u>14_2CH_18_29</u># And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, I will disguise myself, and will go to the battle; but put thou on thy robes. So the king of Israel disguised himself; and they went to the battle.

robes were given <u>66_REV_06_11</u> # And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they [were], should be fulfilled.

wardrobe now she <u>12_2KI_22_14</u># So Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;] and they communed with her.
