Carshena Shethar Admatha 17 EST 01 14 # And the next unto him [was] Carshena, Shethar, Admatha, Tarshish, Meres, Marsena, [and] Memucan, the seven princes of Persia and Media, which saw the king's face, [and] which sat the first in the kingdom;

Goshen and Holon <u>06 JOS 15 51</u># And Goshen, and Holon, and Giloh; eleven cities with their villages:

Goshen and presented 01 GEN 46 29 # And Joseph made ready his chariot, and went up to meet Israel his father, to Goshen, and presented himself unto him; and he fell on his neck, and wept on his neck a good while.

Goshen and the 06 JOS 11 16# So Joshua took all that land, the hills, and all the south country, and all the land of Goshen, and the valley, and the plain, and the mountain of Israel, and the valley of the same;

Goshen let them 01 GEN 47 06 # The land of Egypt [is] before thee; in the best of the land make thy father and brethren to dwell; in the land of Goshen let them dwell: and if thou knowest [any] men of activity among them, then make them rulers over my cattle.

Goshen where the 02 EXO 09 26 # Only in the land of Goshen, where the children of Israel [were], was there no hail.

Goshen 01 GEN 46 28 # And he sent Judah before him unto Joseph, to direct his face unto Goshen; and they came into the land of Goshen.

Goshen 01 GEN 50 08 # And all the house of Joseph, and his brethren, and his father's house: only their little ones, and their flocks, and their herds, they left in the land of Goshen.

Jashen Jonathan 10 2SA 23 32 # Eliahba the Shaalbonite, of the sons of Jashen, Jonathan.

unwashen hands they 41 MAR 07 02 # And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault.
