Assyrian and sent <u>28_HOS_05_13</u># When Ephraim saw his sickness, and Judah [saw] his wound, then went Ephraim to the Assyrian, and sent to king Jareb: yet could he not heal you, nor cure you of your wound.

Assyrian be beaten 23 ISA 30 31 # For through the voice of the LORD shall the Assyrian be beaten down, [which] smote with a rod.

Assyrian fall with <u>23_ISA_31_08</u> # Then shall the Assyrian fall with the sword, not of a mighty man; and the sword, not of a mean man, shall devour him: but he shall flee from the sword, and his young men shall be discomfited.
