sailed away from 44_ACT_20_06 # And we sailed away from Philippi after the days of unleavened bread, and came unto them to Troas in five days; where we abode seven days.

sailed close by <u>44_ACT_27_13</u># And when the south wind blew softly, supposing that they had obtained [their] purpose, loosing [thence], they sailed close by Crete.

sailed from Ephesus <u>44_ACT_18_21</u># But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

sailed he fell <u>42_LUK_08_23</u> # But as they sailed he fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled [with water], and were in jeopardy.

sailed into Syria <u>44_ACT_21_03</u># Now when we had discovered Cyprus, we left it on the left hand, and sailed into Syria, and landed at Tyre: for there the ship was to unlade her burden.

sailed over the 44_ACT_27_05 # And when we had sailed over the sea of Cilicia and Pamphylia, we came to Myra, [a city] of Lycia.

sailed slowly many <u>44_ACT_27_07</u># And when we had sailed slowly many days, and scarce were come over against Cnidus, the wind not suffering us, we sailed under Crete, over against Salmone;

sailed thence and 44_ACT_20_15 # And we sailed thence, and came the next [day] over against Chios; and the next [day] we arrived at Samos, and tarried at Trogyllium; and the next [day] we came to Miletus.

sailed thence into 44_ACT_18_18 # And Paul [after this] tarried [there] yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn [his] head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow.

sailed to Antioch <u>44_ACT_14_26</u># And thence sailed to Antioch, from whence they had been recommended to the grace of God for the work which they fulfilled.

sailed to Cyprus <u>44_ACT_13_04</u> # So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus.

sailed under Crete <u>44_ACT_27_07</u> # And when we had sailed slowly many days, and scarce were come over against Cnidus, the wind not suffering us, we sailed under Crete, over against Salmone;

sailed under Cyprus <u>44_ACT_27_04</u> # And when we had launched from thence, we sailed under Cyprus, because the winds were contrary.

sailed unto Assos <u>44_ACT_20_13</u># And we went before to ship, and sailed unto Assos, there intending to take in Paul: for so had he appointed, minding himself to go afoot.

sailed unto Cyprus <u>44_ACT_15_39</u># And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;
