forsake her and 24\_JER\_51\_09 # We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: forsake her, and let us go every one into his own country: for her judgment reacheth unto heaven, and is lifted up [even] to the skies.

Forsake her not <u>20\_PRO\_04\_06</u># Forsake her not, and she shall preserve thee: love her, and she shall keep thee.

forsake him for <u>05\_DEU\_14\_27</u># And the Levite that [is] within thy gates; thou shalt not forsake him; for he hath no part nor inheritance with thee.

forsake him he 13\_1CH\_28\_09 # And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.

forsake him he 14\_2CH\_15\_02 # And he went out to meet Asa, and said unto him, Hear ye me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin; The LORD [is] with you, while ye be with him; and if ye seek him, he will be found of you; but if ye forsake him, he will forsake you.

forsake him 15 EZR 08 22 # For I was ashamed to require of the king a band of soldiers and horsemen to help us against the enemy in the way: because we had spoken unto the king, saying, The hand of our God [is] upon all them for good that seek him; but his power and his wrath [is] against all them that forsake him.

forsake his inheritance 19\_PSA\_94\_14 # For the LORD will not cast off his people, neither will he forsake his inheritance.

forsake his people <u>09\_1SA\_12\_22</u># For the LORD will not forsake his people for his great name's sake: because it hath pleased the LORD to make you his people.

forsake his way <u>23\_ISA\_55\_07</u> # Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

forsake it not 18\_JOB\_20\_13 # [Though] he spare it, and forsake it not; but keep it still within his mouth:

forsake me and <u>05\_DEU\_31\_16</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Behold, thou shalt sleep with thy fathers; and this people will rise up, and go a whoring after the gods of the strangers of the land, whither they go [to be] among them, and will forsake me, and break my covenant which I have made with them.

forsake me not 19\_PSA\_119\_08 # I will keep thy statutes: O forsake me not utterly.

Forsake me not 19\_PSA\_38\_21 # Forsake me not, O LORD: O my God, be not far from me.

forsake me not 19\_PSA\_71\_09 # Cast me not off in the time of old age; forsake me not when my strength faileth.

forsake me not 19\_PSA\_71\_18 # Now also when I am old and greyheaded, O God, forsake me not; until I

have showed thy strength unto [this] generation, [and] thy power to every one [that] is to come.

forsake me O <u>19\_PSA\_27\_09</u># Hide not thy face [far] from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

forsake me then 19 PSA 27 10 # When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.

forsake Moses saying <u>44\_ACT\_21\_21</u># And they are informed of thee, that thou teachest all the Jews which are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, saying that they ought not to circumcise [their] children, neither to walk after the customs.

forsake my law 19\_PSA\_89\_30 # If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments;

forsake my people <u>11\_1KI\_06\_13</u># And I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will not forsake my people Israel.

forsake my statutes <u>14\_2CH\_07\_19</u> # But if ye turn away, and forsake my statutes and my commandments, which I have set before you, and shall go and serve other gods, and worship them;

forsake my sweetness <u>07\_JUD\_09\_11</u># But the fig tree said unto them, Should I forsake my sweetness, and my good fruit, and go to be promoted over the trees?

forsake not neither <u>20\_PRO\_27\_10</u># Thine own friend, and thy father's friend, forsake not; neither go into thy brother's house in the day of thy calamity: [for] better [is] a neighbour [that is] near than a brother far off.

forsake not the <u>05\_DEU\_12\_19</u># Take heed to thyself that thou forsake not the Levite as long as thou livest upon the earth.

forsake not the <u>20\_PRO\_01\_08</u> # My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

forsake not the <u>20\_PRO\_06\_20</u># My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

forsake not the <u>19\_PSA\_138\_08</u> # The LORD will perfect [that which] concerneth me: thy mercy, O LORD, [endureth] for ever: forsake not the works of thine own hands.

Forsake the foolish 20\_PRO\_09\_06 # Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding.

forsake the holy <u>27\_DAN\_11\_30</u># For the ships of Chittim shall come against him: therefore he shall be grieved, and return, and have indignation against the holy covenant: so shall he do; he shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the holy covenant.

forsake the house 16\_NEH\_10\_39 # For the children of Israel and the children of Levi shall bring the offering of the corn, of the new wine, and the oil, unto the chambers, where [are] the vessels of the sanctuary, and the priests that minister, and the porters, and the singers: and we will not forsake the house of our God.

forsake the idols 26\_EZE\_20\_08 # But they rebelled against me, and would not hearken unto me: they did not every man cast away the abominations of their eyes, neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt: then I said, I will pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.

forsake the law <u>20\_PRO\_28\_04</u> # They that forsake the law praise the wicked: but such as keep the law contend with them.

forsake the LORD <u>23\_ISA\_01\_28</u> # And the destruction of the transgressors and of the sinners [shall be] together, and they that forsake the LORD shall be consumed.

forsake the LORD <u>23\_ISA\_65\_11</u># But ye [are] they that forsake the LORD, that forget my holy mountain, that prepare a table for that troop, and that furnish the drink offering unto that number.

forsake the LORD <u>06\_JOS\_24\_16</u> # And the people answered and said, God forbid that we should forsake the LORD, to serve other gods;

forsake the LORD <u>06\_JOS\_24\_20</u># If ye forsake the LORD, and serve strange gods, then he will turn and do you hurt, and consume you, after that he hath done you good.

forsake thee neither <u>05\_DEU\_04\_31</u> # [For the LORD thy God [is] a merciful God;] he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them.

forsake thee shall <u>24\_JER\_17\_13</u># O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, [and] they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters.

forsake thee until 13\_1CH\_28\_20 # And David said to Solomon his son, Be strong and of good courage, and do [it]: fear not, nor be dismayed: for the LORD God, [even] my God, [will be] with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

forsake thee <u>05\_DEU\_31\_06</u># Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he [it is] that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

forsake thee <u>58\_HEB\_13\_05</u># [Let your] conversation [be] without covetousness; [and be] content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

forsake thee <u>06\_JOS\_01\_05</u># There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, [so] I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

forsake their own 32\_JON\_02\_08 # They that observe lying vanities forsake their own mercy.

forsake them and <u>05\_DEU\_31\_17</u># Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them; so that they will say in that day, Are not these evils come upon us, because our God [is] not among us?

forsake them for <u>16\_NEH\_09\_31</u># Nevertheless for thy great mercies' sake thou didst not utterly consume them, nor forsake them; for thou [art] a gracious and merciful God.

forsake them 23\_ISA\_41\_17 # [When] the poor and needy seek water, and [there is] none, [and] their

tongue faileth for thirst, I the LORD will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them.

forsake them 23 ISA 42 16 # And I will bring the blind by a way [that] they knew not; I will lead them in paths [that] they have not known: I will make darkness light before them, and crooked things straight. These things will I do unto them, and not forsake them.

forsake thy law 19\_PSA\_119\_53# Horror hath taken hold upon me because of the wicked that forsake thy law.

forsake us so 25\_LAM\_05\_20 # Wherefore dost thou forget us for ever, [and] forsake us so long time?

forsake us <u>11\_1KI\_08\_57</u># The LORD our God be with us, as he was with our fathers: let him not leave us, nor forsake us:

forsake wrath fret 19\_PSA\_37\_08 # Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil.

forsake ye not 20\_PRO\_04\_02 # For I give you good doctrine, forsake ye not my law.

forsake you and <u>24\_JER\_23\_39</u> # Therefore, behold, I, even I, will utterly forget you, and I will forsake you, and the city that I gave you and your fathers, [and cast you] out of my presence:

forsake you saith 24\_JER\_23\_33 # And when this people, or the prophet, or a priest, shall ask thee, saying, What [is] the burden of the LORD? thou shalt then say unto them, What burden? I will even forsake you, saith the LORD.

forsake you 14 2CH 15 02 # And he went out to meet Asa, and said unto him, Hear ye me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin; The LORD [is] with you, while ye be with him; and if ye seek him, he will be found of you; but if ye forsake him, he will forsake you.

forsaken all and <u>40\_MAT\_19\_27</u># Then answered Peter and said unto him, Behold, we have forsaken all, and followed thee; what shall we have therefore?

forsaken and Ashkelon <u>36\_ZEP\_02\_04</u> # For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up.

forsaken and grieved <u>23\_ISA\_54\_06</u> # For the LORD hath called thee as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when thou wast refused, saith thy God.

forsaken and hated <u>23\_ISA\_60\_15</u> # Whereas thou hast been forsaken and hated, so that no man went through [thee], I will make thee an eternal excellency, a joy of many generations.

forsaken And I <u>16\_NEH\_13\_11</u># Then contended I with the rulers, and said, Why is the house of God forsaken? And I gathered them together, and set them in their place.

forsaken and left <u>23\_ISA\_27\_10</u> # Yet the defenced city [shall be] desolate, [and] the habitation forsaken, and left like a wilderness: there shall the calf feed, and there shall he lie down, and consume the branches thereof.

forsaken and not 24 JER\_04\_29 # The whole city shall flee for the noise of the horsemen and bowmen; they shall go into thickets, and climb up upon the rocks: every city [shall be] forsaken, and not a man dwell therein.

forsaken bough and 23\_ISA\_17\_09 # In that day shall his strong cities be as a forsaken bough, and an uppermost branch, which they left because of the children of Israel: and there shall be desolation.

forsaken cast down 47\_2CO\_04\_09 # Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed;

forsaken for thee <u>18\_JOB\_18\_04</u># He teareth himself in his anger: shall the earth be forsaken for thee? and shall the rock be removed out of his place?

forsaken him and 14 2CH 13 10 # But as for us, the LORD [is] our God, and we have not forsaken him; and the priests, which minister unto the LORD, [are] the sons of Aaron, and the Levites [wait] upon [their] business:

forsaken him and 14\_2CH\_29\_06 # For our fathers have trespassed, and done [that which was] evil in the eyes of the LORD our God, and have forsaken him, and have turned away their faces from the habitation of the LORD, and turned [their] backs.

forsaken him persecute 19\_PSA\_71\_11 # Saying, God hath forsaken him: persecute and take him; for [there is] none to deliver [him].

forsaken him 14\_2CH\_13\_11# And they burn unto the LORD every morning and every evening burnt sacrifices and sweet incense: the showbread also [set they in order] upon the pure table; and the candlestick of gold with the lamps thereof, to burn every evening: for we keep the charge of the LORD our God; but ye have forsaken him.

forsaken his covert <u>24\_JER\_25\_38</u># He hath forsaken his covert, as the lion: for their land is desolate because of the fierceness of the oppressor, and because of his fierce anger.

forsaken houses or <u>40\_MAT\_19\_29</u># And every one that hath forsaken houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my name's sake, shall receive an hundredfold, and shall inherit everlasting life.

forsaken me and <a href="mailto:11\_1KI\_11\_33">11\_1KI\_11\_33</a># Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do [that which is] right in mine eyes, and [to keep] my statutes and my judgments, as [did] David his father.

forsaken me and <u>09\_1SA\_08\_08</u> # According to all the works which they have done since the day that I brought them up out of Egypt even unto this day, wherewith they have forsaken me, and served other gods, so do they also unto thee.

forsaken me and 14\_2CH\_12\_05 # Then came Shemaiah the prophet to Rehoboam, and [to] the princes of Judah, that were gathered together to Jerusalem because of Shishak, and said unto them, Thus saith the LORD, Ye have forsaken me, and therefore have I also left you in the hand of Shishak.

forsaken me and <u>14\_2CH\_34\_25</u># Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be poured out upon this place, and shall not be quenched.

forsaken me and 12 2KI 22 17 # Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched.

forsaken me and 23\_ISA\_49\_14 # But Zion said, The LORD hath forsaken me, and my Lord hath forgotten me.

forsaken me and 24\_JER\_01\_16 # And I will utter my judgments against them touching all their wickedness, who have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, and worshipped the works of

their own hands.

forsaken me and <u>24\_JER\_05\_07</u> # How shall I pardon thee for this? thy children have forsaken me, and sworn by [them that are] no gods: when I had fed them to the full, they then committed adultery, and assembled themselves by troops in the harlots' houses.

forsaken me and <u>24\_JER\_05\_19</u> # And it shall come to pass, when ye shall say, Wherefore doeth the LORD our God all these [things] unto us? then shalt thou answer them, Like as ye have forsaken me, and served strange gods in your land, so shall ye serve strangers in a land [that is] not yours.

forsaken me and <u>24\_JER\_16\_11</u># Then shalt thou say unto them, Because your fathers have forsaken me, saith the LORD, and have walked after other gods, and have served them, and have worshipped them, and have forsaken me, and have not kept my law;

forsaken me and 24 JER 19 04 # Because they have forsaken me, and have estranged this place, and have burned incense in it unto other gods, whom neither they nor their fathers have known, nor the kings of Judah, and have filled this place with the blood of innocents;

forsaken me and <u>07\_JUD\_10\_13</u># Yet ye have forsaken me, and served other gods: wherefore I will deliver you no more.

forsaken me having <u>55\_2TI\_04\_10</u># For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia.

forsaken me saith <u>24\_JER\_15\_06</u># Thou hast forsaken me, saith the LORD, thou art gone backward: therefore will I stretch out my hand against thee, and destroy thee; I am weary with repenting.

forsaken me saith <u>24\_JER\_16\_11</u># Then shalt thou say unto them, Because your fathers have forsaken me, saith the LORD, and have walked after other gods, and have served them, and have worshipped them, and have forsaken me, and have not kept my law;

forsaken me the <u>24\_JER\_02\_13</u># For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, [and] hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.

forsaken me why 19\_PSA\_22\_01 # To the chief Musician upon Aijeleth Shahar, A Psalm of David. My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? [why art thou so] far from helping me, [and from] the words of my roaring?

forsaken me <u>05\_DEU\_28\_20</u> # The LORD shall send upon thee cursing, vexation, and rebuke, in all that thou settest thine hand unto for to do, until thou be destroyed, and until thou perish quickly; because of the wickedness of thy doings, whereby thou hast forsaken me.

forsaken me <u>41\_MAR\_15\_34</u># And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani? which is, being interpreted, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

forsaken me <u>40\_MAT\_27\_46</u># And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

forsaken mine house 24\_JER\_12\_07 # I have forsaken mine house, I have left mine heritage; I have given the dearly beloved of my soul into the hand of her enemies.

forsaken my law 24\_JER\_09\_13 # And the LORD saith, Because they have forsaken my law which I set before them, and have not obeyed my voice, neither walked therein;

Forsaken neither shall 23\_ISA\_62\_04 # Thou shalt no more be termed Forsaken; neither shall thy land any

more be termed Desolate: but thou shalt be called Hephzibah, and thy land Beulah: for the LORD delighteth in thee, and thy land shall be married.

forsaken nor his 19\_PSA\_37\_25 # I have been young, and [now] am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

forsaken nor Judah <u>24\_JER\_51\_05</u># For Israel [hath] not [been] forsaken, nor Judah of his God, of the LORD of hosts; though their land was filled with sin against the Holy One of Israel.

forsaken of both <u>23\_ISA\_07\_16</u># For before the child shall know to refuse the evil, and choose the good, the land that thou abhorrest shall be forsaken of both her kings.

forsaken our God <u>07\_JUD\_10\_10</u> # And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, saying, We have sinned against thee, both because we have forsaken our God, and also served Baalim.

forsaken the commandments <u>11\_1KI\_18\_18</u># And he answered, I have not troubled Israel; but thou, and thy father's house, in that ye have forsaken the commandments of the LORD, and thou hast followed Baalim.

forsaken the covenant <u>05\_DEU\_29\_25</u># Then men shall say, Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD God of their fathers, which he made with them when he brought them forth out of the land of Egypt:

forsaken the covenant <u>24\_JER\_22\_09</u># Then they shall answer, Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD their God, and worshipped other gods, and served them.

forsaken the earth <u>26\_EZE\_08\_12</u># Then said he unto me, Son of man, hast thou seen what the ancients of the house of Israel do in the dark, every man in the chambers of his imagery? for they say, The LORD seeth us not; the LORD hath forsaken the earth.

forsaken the earth <u>26\_EZE\_09\_09</u># Then said he unto me, The iniquity of the house of Israel and Judah [is] exceeding great, and the land is full of blood, and the city full of perverseness: for they say, The LORD hath forsaken the earth, and the LORD seeth not.

forsaken the generation 24\_JER\_07\_29 # Cut off thine hair, [O Jerusalem], and cast [it] away, and take up a lamentation on high places; for the LORD hath rejected and forsaken the generation of his wrath.

forsaken the land 24\_JER\_09\_19 # For a voice of wailing is heard out of Zion, How are we spoiled! we are greatly confounded, because we have forsaken the land, because our dwellings have cast [us] out.

forsaken the LORD <u>09\_1SA\_12\_10</u># And they cried unto the LORD, and said, We have sinned, because we have forsaken the LORD, and have served Baalim and Ashtaroth: but now deliver us out of the hand of our enemies, and we will serve thee.

forsaken the LORD 14\_2CH\_21\_10# So the Edomites revolted from under the hand of Judah unto this day. The same time [also] did Libnah revolt from under his hand; because he had forsaken the LORD God of his fathers.

forsaken the LORD <u>14\_2CH\_28\_06</u># For Pekah the son of Remaliah slew in Judah an hundred and twenty thousand in one day, [which were] all valiant men; because they had forsaken the LORD God of their fathers.

forsaken the LORD <u>23\_ISA\_01\_04</u># Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.

forsaken the LORD <u>24\_JER\_02\_17</u># Hast thou not procured this unto thyself, in that thou hast forsaken the LORD thy God, when he led thee by the way?

forsaken the LORD <u>24\_JER\_02\_19</u> # Thine own wickedness shall correct thee, and thy backslidings shall reprove thee: know therefore and see that [it is] an evil [thing] and bitter, that thou hast forsaken the LORD thy God, and that my fear [is] not in thee, saith the Lord GOD of hosts.

forsaken the multitude 23\_ISA\_32\_14 # Because the palaces shall be forsaken; the multitude of the city shall be left; the forts and towers shall be for dens for ever, a joy of wild asses, a pasture of flocks;

forsaken the poor <u>18\_JOB\_20\_19</u> # Because he hath oppressed [and] hath forsaken the poor; [because] he hath violently taken away an house which he builded not;

forsaken the right <u>61\_2PE\_02\_15</u> # Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam [the son] of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;

forsaken thee but <u>23\_ISA\_54\_07</u># For a small moment have I forsaken thee; but with great mercies will I gather thee.

forsaken them that 19\_PSA\_09\_10 # And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.

forsaken they shall <u>23\_ISA\_17\_02</u> # The cities of Aroer [are] forsaken: they shall be for flocks, which shall lie down, and none shall make [them] afraid.

forsaken thy commandments <u>15\_EZR\_09\_10</u> # And now, O our God, what shall we say after this? for we have forsaken thy commandments,

forsaken upon her 30\_AMO\_05\_02 # The virgin of Israel is fallen; she shall no more rise: she is forsaken

upon her land; [there is] none to raise her up.
