sceptre from Ashkelon [30 AMO 01 08](#) # And I will cut off the inhabitant from Ashdod, and him that holdeth the sceptre from Ashkelon, and I will turn mine hand against Ekron: and the remnant of the Philistines shall perish, saith the Lord GOD.

sceptre from the [30 AMO 01 05](#) # I will break also the bar of Damascus, and cut off the inhabitant from the plain of Aven, and him that holdeth the sceptre from the house of Eden: and the people of Syria shall go into captivity unto Kir, saith the LORD.

sceptre of Egypt [38 ZEC 10 11](#) # And he shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the sceptre of Egypt shall depart away.

sceptre of righteousness [58 HEB 01 08](#) # But unto the Son [he saith], Thy throne, O God, [is] for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness [is] the sceptre of thy kingdom.

sceptre of the [23 ISA 14 05](#) # The LORD hath broken the staff of the wicked, [and] the sceptre of the rulers.

sceptre of thy [58 HEB 01 08](#) # But unto the Son [he saith], Thy throne, O God, [is] for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness [is] the sceptre of thy kingdom.

sceptre of thy [19 PSA 45 06](#) # Thy throne, O God, [is] for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom [is] a right sceptre.

sceptre that he [17 EST 04 11](#) # All the king's servants, and the people of the king's provinces, do know, that whosoever, whether man or woman, shall come unto the king into the inner court, who is not called, [there is] one law of his to put [him] to death, except such to whom the king shall hold out the golden sceptre, that he may live: but I have not been called to come in unto the king these thirty days.
