sickle and gather [66 REV 14 18](#) # And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

sickle and reap [66 REV 14 15](#) # And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.

sickle because the [41 MAR 04 29](#) # But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come.

sickle for the [29 JOE 03 13](#) # Put ye in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe: come, get you down; for the press is full, the vats overflow; for their wickedness [is] great.
