

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

sojourn among you <u>26\_EZE\_47\_22</u> # And it shall come to pass, [that] ye shall divide it by lot for an inheritance unto you, and to the strangers that sojourn among you, which shall beget children among you: and they shall be unto you as born in the country among the children of Israel; they shall have inheritance with you among the tribes of Israel.

sojourn among you <u>03\_LEV\_17\_08</u># And thou shalt say unto them, Whatsoever man [there be] of the house of Israel, or of the strangers which sojourn among you, that offereth a burnt offering or sacrifice,

sojourn among you <u>03\_LEV\_17\_10</u># And whatsoever man [there be] of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, that eateth any manner of blood; I will even set my face against that soul that eateth blood, and will cut him off from among his people.

sojourn among you <u>03\_LEV\_17\_13</u> # And whatsoever man [there be] of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, which hunteth and catcheth any beast or fowl that may be eaten; he shall even pour out the blood thereof, and cover it with dust.

sojourn among you <u>03\_LEV\_25\_45</u># Moreover of the children of the strangers that do sojourn among you, of them shall ye buy, and of their families that [are] with you, which they begat in your land: and they shall be your possession.

sojourn among you <u>04\_NUM\_09\_14</u> # And if a stranger shall sojourn among you, and will keep the passover unto the LORD; according to the ordinance of the passover, and according to the manner thereof, so shall he do: ye shall have one ordinance, both for the stranger, and for him that was born in the land.

sojourn and he <u>01\_GEN\_19\_09</u># And they said, Stand back. And they said [again], This one [fellow] came in to sojourn, and he will needs be a judge: now will we deal worse with thee, than with them. And they pressed sore upon the man, [even] Lot, and came near to break the door.

sojourn and they <u>26\_EZE\_20\_38</u># And I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.

sojourn by slaying 11\_1KI\_17\_20# And he cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, hast thou also brought evil upon the widow with whom I sojourn, by slaying her son?

sojourn for the <u>12\_2KI\_08\_01</u> # Then spake Elisha unto the woman, whose son he had restored to life, saying, Arise, and go thou and thine household, and sojourn wheresoever thou canst sojourn: for the LORD hath called for a famine; and it shall also come upon the land seven years.

sojourn in a <u>44\_ACT\_07\_06</u># And God spake on this wise, That his seed should sojourn in a strange land; and that they should bring them into bondage, and entreat [them] evil four hundred years.

sojourn in Israel <u>03\_LEV\_20\_02</u> # Again, thou shalt say to the children of Israel, Whosoever [he be] of the children of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn in Israel, that giveth [any] of his seed unto Molech; he shall surely be put to death: the people of the land shall stone him with stones.

sojourn in Mesech <u>19\_PSA\_120\_05</u> # Woe is me, that I sojourn in Mesech, [that] I dwell in the tents of Kedar!

sojourn in the <u>01 GEN 47 04</u> # They said moreover unto Pharaoh, For to sojourn in the land are we come; for thy servants have no pasture for their flocks; for the famine [is] sore in the land of Canaan: now therefore, we pray thee, let thy servants dwell in the land of Goshen.

sojourn in the <u>08\_RUT\_01\_01</u> # Now it came to pass in the days when the judges ruled, that there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab, he, and his wife, and his two sons.

Sojourn in this <u>01\_GEN\_26\_03</u> # Sojourn in this land, and I will be with thee, and will bless thee; for unto thee, and unto thy seed, I will give all these countries, and I will perform the oath which I sware unto Abraham thy father;

sojourn there and <u>23\_ISA\_52\_04</u># For thus saith the Lord GOD, My people went down aforetime into Egypt to sojourn there; and the Assyrian oppressed them without cause.

sojourn there and 24\_JER\_44\_12 # And I will take the remnant of Judah, that have set their faces to go into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, and they shall all be consumed, [and] fall in the land of Egypt; they shall [even] be consumed by the sword [and] by the famine: they shall die, from the least even unto the greatest, by the sword and by the famine: and they shall be an execration, [and] an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach.

sojourn there for <u>01\_GEN\_12\_10</u> # And there was a famine in the land: and Abram went down into Egypt to sojourn there; for the famine [was] grievous in the land.

sojourn there shall <u>24\_JER\_44\_14</u> # So that none of the remnant of Judah, which are gone into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, shall escape or remain, that they should return into the land of Judah, to the which they have a desire to return to dwell there: for none shall return but such as shall escape.

sojourn there shall <u>24\_JER\_44\_28</u># Yet a small number that escape the sword shall return out of the land of Egypt into the land of Judah, and all the remnant of Judah, that are gone into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, shall know whose words shall stand, mine, or theirs.

sojourn there they <u>24\_JER\_42\_17</u> # So shall it be with all the men that set their faces to go into Egypt to sojourn there; they shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence: and none of them shall remain or escape from the evil that I will bring upon them.

sojourn there <u>24\_JER\_42\_15</u> # And now therefore hear the word of the LORD, ye remnant of Judah; Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; If ye wholly set your faces to enter into Egypt, and go to sojourn there;

sojourn there <u>24\_JER\_43\_02</u> # Then spake Azariah the son of Hoshaiah, and Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the proud men, saying unto Jeremiah, Thou speakest falsely: the LORD our God hath not sent thee to say, Go not into Egypt to sojourn there:

sojourn there <u>25\_LAM\_04\_15</u> # They cried unto them, Depart ye; [it is] unclean; depart, depart, touch not: when they fled away and wandered, they said among the heathen, They shall no more sojourn [there].

sojourn where he <u>07\_JUD\_17\_08</u># And the man departed out of the city from Bethlehemjudah to sojourn where he could find [a place]: and he came to mount Ephraim to the house of Micah, as he journeyed.

sojourn where I <u>07\_JUD\_17\_09</u># And Micah said unto him, Whence comest thou? And he said unto him, I [am] a Levite of Bethlehemjudah, and I go to sojourn where I may find [a place].

sojourn wheresoever thou 12\_2KI\_08\_01 # Then spake Elisha unto the woman, whose son he had restored

to life, saying, Arise, and go thou and thine household, and sojourn wheresoever thou canst sojourn: for the LORD hath called for a famine; and it shall also come upon the land seven years.

sojourn with thee <u>02\_EXO\_12\_48</u># And when a stranger shall sojourn with thee, and will keep the passover to the LORD, let all his males be circumcised, and then let him come near and keep it; and he shall be as one that is born in the land: for no uncircumcised person shall eat thereof.

sojourn with thee 03\_LEV\_19\_33 # And if a stranger sojourn with thee in your land, ye shall not vex him.

sojourn with you <u>04\_NUM\_15\_14</u># And if a stranger sojourn with you, or whosoever [be] among you in your generations, and will offer an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD; as ye do, so he shall do.

sojourn <u>23\_ISA\_23\_07</u> # [Is] this your joyous [city], whose antiquity [is] of ancient days? her own feet shall carry her afar off to sojourn.

sojourn <u>24\_JER\_42\_22</u> # Now therefore know certainly that ye shall die by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, in the place whither ye desire to go [and] to sojourn.

sojourned and come <u>05\_DEU\_18\_06</u># And if a Levite come from any of thy gates out of all Israel, where he sojourned, and come with all the desire of his mind unto the place which the LORD shall choose;

sojourned in Gerar <u>01\_GEN\_20\_01</u> # And Abraham journeyed from thence toward the south country, and dwelled between Kadesh and Shur, and sojourned in Gerar.

sojourned in Gibeah <u>07\_JUD\_19\_16</u># And, behold, there came an old man from his work out of the field at even, which [was] also of mount Ephraim; and he sojourned in Gibeah: but the men of the place [were] Benjamites.

sojourned in the <u>12\_2KI\_08\_02</u> # And the woman arose, and did after the saying of the man of God: and she went with her household, and sojourned in the land of the Philistines seven years.

sojourned in the 01\_GEN\_21\_34 # And Abraham sojourned in the Philistines' land many days.

sojourned in the <u>58\_HEB\_11\_09</u># By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as [in] a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:

sojourned in the 19\_PSA\_105\_23 # Israel also came into Egypt; and Jacob sojourned in the land of Ham.

sojourned there with <u>05\_DEU\_26\_05</u># And thou shalt speak and say before the LORD thy God, A Syrian ready to perish [was] my father, and he went down into Egypt, and sojourned there with a few, and became there a nation, great, mighty, and populous:

sojourned there <u>07\_JUD\_17\_07</u># And there was a young man out of Bethlehemjudah of the family of Judah, who [was] a Levite, and he sojourned there.

sojourned with Laban <u>01\_GEN\_32\_04</u># And he commanded them, saying, Thus shall ye speak unto my lord Esau; Thy servant Jacob saith thus, I have sojourned with Laban, and stayed there until now:

sojourned <u>01\_GEN\_21\_23</u> # Now therefore swear unto me here by God that thou wilt not deal falsely with me, nor with my son, nor with my son's son: [but] according to the kindness that I have done unto thee, thou shalt do unto me, and to the land wherein thou hast sojourned.

sojourned <u>01\_GEN\_35\_27</u># And Jacob came unto Isaac his father unto Mamre, unto the city of Arbah, which [is] Hebron, where Abraham and Isaac sojourned.

sojourner among them <u>04\_NUM\_35\_15</u># These six cities shall be a refuge, [both] for the children of Israel, and for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them: that every one that killeth any person unawares may flee thither.

sojourner as all 19\_PSA\_39\_12 # Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not thy peace at my tears: for I [am] a stranger with thee, [and] a sojourner, as all my fathers [were].

sojourner by thee <u>03\_LEV\_25\_47</u># And if a sojourner or stranger wax rich by thee, and thy brother [that dwelleth] by him wax poor, and sell himself unto the stranger [or] sojourner by thee, or to the stock of the stranger's family:

sojourner he shall <u>03\_LEV\_25\_40</u> # [But] as an hired servant, [and] as a sojourner, he shall be with thee, [and] shall serve thee unto the year of jubilee:

sojourner of the <u>03\_LEV\_22\_10</u> # There shall no stranger eat [of] the holy thing: a sojourner of the priest, or an hired servant, shall not eat [of] the holy thing.

sojourner or stranger <u>03\_LEV\_25\_47</u># And if a sojourner or stranger wax rich by thee, and thy brother [that dwelleth] by him wax poor, and sell himself unto the stranger [or] sojourner by thee, or to the stock of the stranger's family:

sojourner that he <u>03\_LEV\_25\_35</u> # And if thy brother be waxen poor, and fallen in decay with thee; then thou shalt relieve him: [yea, though he be] a stranger, or a sojourner; that he may live with thee.

sojourner with you <u>01\_GEN\_23\_04</u> # I [am] a stranger and a sojourner with you: give me a possession of a buryingplace with you, that I may bury my dead out of my sight.

sojourners as were 13\_1CH\_29\_15 # For we [are] strangers before thee, and sojourners, as [were] all our fathers: our days on the earth [are] as a shadow, and [there is] none abiding.

sojourners there until 10\_2SA\_04\_03 # And the Beerothites fled to Gittaim, and were sojourners there until this day.]

sojourners with me <u>03\_LEV\_25\_23</u> # The land shall not be sold for ever: for the land [is] mine; for ye [are] strangers and sojourners with me.

sojourneth among them <u>06\_JOS\_20\_09</u># These were the cities appointed for all the children of Israel, and for the stranger that sojourneth among them, that whosoever killeth [any] person at unawares might flee thither, and not die by the hand of the avenger of blood, until he stood before the congregation.

sojourneth among them <u>04\_NUM\_15\_26</u># And it shall be forgiven all the congregation of the children of Israel, and the stranger that sojourneth among them; seeing all the people [were] in ignorance.

sojourneth among them <u>04\_NUM\_15\_29</u> # Ye shall have one law for him that sinneth through ignorance, [both for] him that is born among the children of Israel, and for the stranger that sojourneth among them.

sojourneth among them <u>04\_NUM\_19\_10</u># And he that gathereth the ashes of the heifer shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even: and it shall be unto the children of Israel, and unto the stranger that sojourneth among them, for a statute for ever.

sojourneth among you <u>02\_EXO\_12\_49</u> # One law shall be to him that is homeborn, and unto the stranger that sojourneth among you.

sojourneth among you 03\_LEV\_16\_29 # And [this] shall be a statute for ever unto you: [that] in the seventh

month, on the tenth [day] of the month, ye shall afflict your souls, and do no work at all, [whether it be] one of your own country, or a stranger that sojourneth among you:

sojourneth among you <u>03\_LEV\_17\_12</u># Therefore I said unto the children of Israel, No soul of you shall eat blood, neither shall any stranger that sojourneth among you eat blood.

sojourneth among you <u>03\_LEV\_18\_26</u> # Ye shall therefore keep my statutes and my judgments, and shall not commit [any] of these abominations; [neither] any of your own nation, nor any stranger that sojourneth among you:

sojourneth in her <u>02\_EXO\_03\_22</u> # But every woman shall borrow of her neighbour, and of her that sojourneth in her house, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment: and ye shall put [them] upon your sons, and upon your daughters; and ye shall spoil the Egyptians.

sojourneth in Israel <u>26\_EZE\_14\_07</u># For every one of the house of Israel, or of the stranger that sojourneth in Israel, which separateth himself from me, and setteth up his idols in his heart, and putteth the stumblingblock of his iniquity before his face, and cometh to a prophet to inquire of him concerning me; I the LORD will answer him by myself:

sojourneth let the <u>15\_EZR\_01\_04</u># And whosoever remaineth in any place where he sojourneth, let the men of his place help him with silver, and with gold, and with goods, and with beasts, beside the freewill offering for the house of God that [is] in Jerusalem.

sojourneth there shall <u>26\_EZE\_47\_23</u># And it shall come to pass, [that] in what tribe the stranger sojourneth, there shall ye give [him] his inheritance, saith the Lord GOD.

sojourneth with thee <u>03\_LEV\_25\_06</u># And the sabbath of the land shall be meat for you; for thee, and for thy servant, and for thy maid, and for thy hired servant, and for thy stranger that sojourneth with thee,

sojourneth with you <u>04\_NUM\_15\_15</u> # One ordinance [shall be both] for you of the congregation, and also for the stranger that sojourneth [with you], an ordinance for ever in your generations: as ye [are], so shall the stranger be before the LORD.

sojourneth with you <u>04\_NUM\_15\_16</u># One law and one manner shall be for you, and for the stranger that sojourneth with you.

sojourning here in <u>60\_1PE\_01\_17</u># And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning [here] in fear:

sojourning of the <u>02\_EXO\_12\_40</u># Now the sojourning of the children of Israel, who dwelt in Egypt, [was] four hundred and thirty years.

sojourning on the <u>07\_JUD\_19\_01</u># And it came to pass in those days, when [there was] no king in Israel, that there was a certain Levite sojourning on the side of mount Ephraim, who took to him a concubine out of Bethlehemjudah.
