stead 13\_1CH\_01\_47 # And when Hadad was dead, Samlah of Masrekah reigned in his stead.

stead 13\_1CH\_01\_48 # And when Samlah was dead, Shaul of Rehoboth by the river reigned in his stead.

stead 13\_1CH\_01\_49 # And when Shaul was dead, Baalhanan the son of Achbor reigned in his stead.

stead <u>13\_1CH\_19\_01</u># Now it came to pass after this, that Nahash the king of the children of Ammon died, and his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>13\_1CH\_29\_28</u># And he died in a good old age, full of days, riches, and honour: and Solomon his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>11\_1KI\_11\_43</u># And Solomon slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David his father: and Rehoboam his son reigned in his stead.

stead 11\_1KI\_14\_20# And the days which Jeroboam reigned [were] two and twenty years: and he slept with his fathers, and Nadab his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_09\_31</u> # And Solomon slept with his fathers, and he was buried in the city of David his father: and Rehoboam his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_12\_16</u> # And Rehoboam slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David: and Abijah his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_21\_01</u> # Now Jehoshaphat slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David. And Jehoram his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_24\_27</u> # Now [concerning] his sons, and the greatness of the burdens [laid] upon him, and the repairing of the house of God, behold, they [are] written in the story of the book of the kings. And Amaziah his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_26\_23</u> # So Uzziah slept with his fathers, and they buried him with his fathers in the field of the burial which [belonged] to the kings; for they said, He [is] a leper: and Jotham his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_27\_09</u># And Jotham slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and Ahaz his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_28\_27</u># And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city, [even] in Jerusalem: but they brought him not into the sepulchres of the kings of Israel: and Hezekiah his son

reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_32\_33</u># And Hezekiah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the chiefest of the sepulchres of the sons of David: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem did him honour at his death. And Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_33\_20</u> # So Manasseh slept with his fathers, and they buried him in his own house: and Amon his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_33\_25</u> # But the people of the land slew all them that had conspired against king Amon; and the people of the land made Josiah his son king in his stead.

stead <u>14\_2CH\_36\_08</u># Now the rest of the acts of Jehoiakim, and his abominations which he did, and that which was found in him, behold, they [are] written in the book of the kings of Israel and Judah: and Jehoiachin his son reigned in his stead.

stead 12\_2KI\_14\_29 # And Jeroboam slept with his fathers, [even] with the kings of Israel; and Zachariah his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>12\_2KI\_15\_07</u># So Azariah slept with his fathers; and they buried him with his fathers in the city of David: and Jotham his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>12\_2KI\_15\_10</u># And Shallum the son of Jabesh conspired against him, and smote him before the people, and slew him, and reigned in his stead.

stead <u>12\_2KI\_15\_14</u># For Menahem the son of Gadi went up from Tirzah, and came to Samaria, and smote Shallum the son of Jabesh in Samaria, and slew him, and reigned in his stead.

stead 12\_2KI\_15\_22 # And Menahem slept with his fathers; and Pekahiah his son reigned in his stead.

stead 12\_2KI\_15\_38 # And Jotham slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Ahaz his son reigned in his stead.

stead 12\_2KI\_16\_20 # And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David:

and Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.

stead <u>12\_2KI\_19\_37</u># And it came to pass, as he was worshipping in the house of Nisroch his god, that Adrammelech and Sharezer his sons smote him with the sword: and they escaped into the land of Armenia. And Esarhaddon his son reigned in his stead.
