

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

estranged from me <u>26\_EZE\_14\_05</u># That I may take the house of Israel in their own heart, because they are all estranged from me through their idols.

estranged from me <u>18\_JOB\_19\_13</u># He hath put my brethren far from me, and mine acquaintance are verily estranged from me.

estranged from the 19 PSA 58 03 # The wicked are estranged from the womb: they go astray as soon as they be born, speaking lies.

estranged from their 19\_PSA\_78\_30 # They were not estranged from their lust. But while their meat [was] yet in their mouths,

estranged this place <u>24\_JER\_19\_04</u># Because they have forsaken me, and have estranged this place, and have burned incense in it unto other gods, whom neither they nor their fathers have known, nor the kings of Judah, and have filled this place with the blood of innocents;

strange act 23 ISA 28 21 # For the LORD shall rise up as [in] mount Perazim, he shall be wroth as [in] the valley of Gibeon, that he may do his work, his strange work; and bring to pass his act, his strange act.

strange apparel <u>36\_ZEP\_01\_08</u> # And it shall come to pass in the day of the LORD'S sacrifice, that I will punish the princes, and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with strange apparel.

strange but as <u>20\_PRO\_21\_08</u> # The way of man [is] froward and strange: but [as for] the pure, his work [is] right.

strange children now <u>28\_HOS\_05\_07</u> # They have dealt treacherously against the LORD: for they have begotten strange children: now shall a month devour them with their portions.

strange children whose 19\_PSA\_144\_11 # Rid me, and deliver me from the hand of strange children, whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand [is] a right hand of falsehood:

strange children 19\_PSA\_144\_07 # Send thine hand from above; rid me, and deliver me out of great waters, from the hand of strange children;

strange cities <u>44\_ACT\_26\_11</u># And I punished them oft in every synagogue, and compelled [them] to blaspheme; and being exceedingly mad against them, I persecuted [them] even unto strange cities.

strange concerning the <u>60\_1PE\_04\_12</u> # Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:

strange country dwelling <u>58\_HEB\_11\_09</u># By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as [in] a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:

strange doctrines For <u>58\_HEB\_13\_09</u># Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For [it is] a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein.

strange fire before 03\_LEV\_10\_01 # And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his

censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which he commanded them not.

strange fire before <u>04\_NUM\_03\_04</u># And Nadab and Abihu died before the LORD, when they offered strange fire before the LORD, in the wilderness of Sinai, and they had no children: and Eleazar and Ithamar ministered in the priest's office in the sight of Aaron their father.

strange fire before <u>04\_NUM\_26\_61</u># And Nadab and Abihu died, when they offered strange fire before the LORD.

strange flesh are <u>65\_JDE\_01\_07</u># Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

strange god among 23\_ISA\_43\_12 # I have declared, and have saved, and I have showed, when [there was] no strange [god] among you: therefore ye [are] my witnesses, saith the LORD, that I [am] God.

strange god be 19\_PSA\_81\_09 # There shall no strange god be in thee; neither shalt thou worship any strange god.

strange god whom <u>27\_DAN\_11\_39</u># Thus shall he do in the most strong holds with a strange god, whom he shall acknowledge [and] increase with glory: and he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for gain.

strange god with <u>05\_DEU\_32\_12</u> # [So] the LORD alone did lead him, and [there was] no strange god with him.

strange god <u>39\_MAL\_02\_11</u># Judah hath dealt treacherously, and an abomination is committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah hath profaned the holiness of the LORD which he loved, and hath married the daughter of a strange god.

strange god 19\_PSA\_44\_20 # If we have forgotten the name of our God, or stretched out our hands to a strange god;

strange god 19 PSA 81 09 # There shall no strange god be in thee; neither shalt thou worship any strange god.

strange gods and <u>09\_1SA\_07\_03</u> # And Samuel spake unto all the house of Israel, saying, If ye do return unto the LORD with all your hearts, [then] put away the strange gods and Ashtaroth from among you, and prepare your hearts unto the LORD, and serve him only: and he will deliver you out of the hand of the Philistines.

strange gods and <u>14\_2CH\_14\_03</u># For he took away the altars of the strange [gods], and the high places, and brake down the images, and cut down the groves:

strange gods and 14\_2CH\_33\_15 # And he took away the strange gods, and the idol out of the house of the LORD, and all the altars that he had built in the mount of the house of the LORD, and in Jerusalem, and cast [them] out of the city.

strange gods because <u>44\_ACT\_17\_18</u># Then certain philosophers of the Epicureans, and of the Stoicks, encountered him. And some said, What will this babbler say? other some, He seemeth to be a setter forth of strange gods: because he preached unto them Jesus, and the resurrection.

strange gods from <u>07\_JUD\_10\_16</u># And they put away the strange gods from among them, and served the LORD: and his soul was grieved for the misery of Israel.

strange gods in 24 JER\_05 19 # And it shall come to pass, when ye shall say, Wherefore doeth the LORD our God all these [things] unto us? then shalt thou answer them, Like as ye have forsaken me, and served strange gods in your land, so shall ye serve strangers in a land [that is] not yours.

strange gods that <u>01\_GEN\_35\_02</u># Then Jacob said unto his household, and to all that [were] with him, Put away the strange gods that [are] among you, and be clean, and change your garments:

strange gods then <u>06\_JOS\_24\_20</u> # If ye forsake the LORD, and serve strange gods, then he will turn and do you hurt, and consume you, after that he hath done you good.

strange gods which <u>01\_GEN\_35\_04</u># And they gave unto Jacob all the strange gods which [were] in their hand, and [all their] earrings which [were] in their ears; and Jacob hid them under the oak which [was] by Shechem.

strange gods which <u>06\_JOS\_24\_23</u> # Now therefore put away, [said he], the strange gods which [are] among you, and incline your heart unto the LORD God of Israel.

strange gods with <u>05\_DEU\_32\_16</u># They provoked him to jealousy with strange [gods], with abominations provoked they him to anger.

strange incense thereon <u>02\_EXO\_30\_09</u> # Ye shall offer no strange incense thereon, nor burnt sacrifice, nor meat offering; neither shall ye pour drink offering thereon.

strange land and <u>44\_ACT\_07\_06</u># And God spake on this wise, That his seed should sojourn in a strange land; and that they should bring them into bondage, and entreat [them] evil four hundred years.

strange land <u>02\_EXO\_02\_22</u> # And she bare [him] a son, and he called his name Gershom: for he said, I have been a stranger in a strange land.

strange land <u>02\_EXO\_18\_03</u> # And her two sons; of which the name of the one [was] Gershom; for he said, I have been an alien in a strange land:

strange land 19\_PSA\_137\_04 # How shall we sing the LORD's song in a strange land?

strange language 19\_PSA\_114\_01# When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language;

strange nation he <u>02\_EXO\_21\_08</u># If she please not her master, who hath betrothed her to himself, then shall he let her be redeemed: to sell her unto a strange nation he shall have no power, seeing he hath dealt deceitfully with her.

strange punishment to <u>18\_JOB\_31\_03</u> # [Is] not destruction to the wicked? and a strange [punishment] to the workers of iniquity?

strange slips <u>23\_ISA\_17\_10</u># Because thou hast forgotten the God of thy salvation, and hast not been mindful of the rock of thy strength, therefore shalt thou plant pleasant plants, and shalt set it with strange slips:

strange speech and <u>26\_EZE\_03\_05</u> # For thou [art] not sent to a people of a strange speech and of an hard language, [but] to the house of Israel;

strange speech and <u>26\_EZE\_03\_06</u># Not to many people of a strange speech and of an hard language, whose words thou canst not understand. Surely, had I sent thee to them, they would have hearkened unto thee.

strange that ye 60\_1PE\_04\_04 # Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with [them] to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of [you]:

strange thing happened 60\_1PE\_04\_12 # Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:

strange thing <u>28\_HOS\_08\_12</u> # I have written to him the great things of my law, [but] they were counted as a strange thing.

strange things to <u>44\_ACT\_17\_20</u> # For thou bringest certain strange things to our ears: we would know therefore what these things mean.

strange things to <u>42\_LUK\_05\_26</u># And they were all amazed, and they glorified God, and were filled with fear, saying, We have seen strange things to day.

strange to me <u>18\_JOB\_19\_03</u> # These ten times have ye reproached me: ye are not ashamed [that] ye make yourselves strange to me.

strange to my <u>18\_JOB\_19\_17</u> # My breath is strange to my wife, though I entreated for the children's [sake] of mine own body.

strange unto them <u>01\_GEN\_42\_07</u># And Joseph saw his brethren, and he knew them, but made himself strange unto them, and spake roughly unto them; and he said unto them, Whence come ye? And they said, From the land of Canaan to buy food.

strange vanities <u>24\_JER\_08\_19</u> # Behold the voice of the cry of the daughter of my people because of them that dwell in a far country: [Is] not the LORD in Zion? [is] not her king in her? Why have they provoked me to anger with their graven images, [and] with strange vanities?

strange vine unto <u>24\_JER\_02\_21</u># Yet I had planted thee a noble vine, wholly a right seed: how then art thou turned into the degenerate plant of a strange vine unto me?

strange waters and 12\_2KI\_19\_24 # I have digged and drunk strange waters, and with the sole of my feet have I dried up all the rivers of besieged places.

strange wives and 15\_EZR\_10\_44 # All these had taken strange wives: and [some] of them had wives by whom they had children.

strange wives by <u>15\_EZR\_10\_17</u># And they made an end with all the men that had taken strange wives by the first day of the first month.

strange wives in <u>15\_EZR\_10\_14</u># Let now our rulers of all the congregation stand, and let all them which have taken strange wives in our cities come at appointed times, and with them the elders of every city, and the judges thereof, until the fierce wrath of our God for this matter be turned from us.

strange wives namely <u>15\_EZR\_10\_18</u># And among the sons of the priests there were found that had taken strange wives: [namely], of the sons of Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and his brethren; Maaseiah, and Eliezer, and Jarib, and Gedaliah.

strange wives of <u>15\_EZR\_10\_02</u># And Shechaniah the son of Jehiel, [one] of the sons of Elam, answered and said unto Ezra, We have trespassed against our God, and have taken strange wives of the people of the land: yet now there is hope in Israel concerning this thing.

strange wives <u>15\_EZR\_10\_11</u># Now therefore make confession unto the LORD God of your fathers, and do his pleasure: and separate yourselves from the people of the land, and from the strange wives.

strange wives <u>16\_NEH\_13\_27</u> # Shall we then hearken unto you to do all this great evil, to transgress against our God in marrying strange wives?

strange woman is 20\_PRO\_23\_27 # For a whore [is] a deep ditch; and a strange woman [is] a narrow pit.

strange woman <u>07\_JUD\_11\_02</u># And Gilead's wife bare him sons; and his wife's sons grew up, and they thrust out Jephthah, and said unto him, Thou shalt not inherit in our father's house; for thou [art] the son of a strange woman.

strange woman <u>20\_PRO\_06\_24</u># To keep thee from the evil woman, from the flattery of the tongue of a strange woman.

strange woman <u>20\_PRO\_20\_16</u># Take his garment that is surety [for] a stranger: and take a pledge of him for a strange woman.

strange woman <u>20\_PRO\_27\_13</u># Take his garment that is surety for a stranger, and take a pledge of him for a strange woman.

strange women and <u>20\_PRO\_23\_33</u># Thine eyes shall behold strange women, and thine heart shall utter perverse things.

strange women is <u>20\_PRO\_22\_14</u># The mouth of strange women [is] a deep pit: he that is abhorred of the LORD shall fall therein.

strange women together <u>11\_1KI\_11\_01</u># But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, [and] Hittites;

strange work and <u>23\_ISA\_28\_21</u># For the LORD shall rise up as [in] mount Perazim, he shall be wroth as [in] the valley of Gibeon, that he may do his work, his strange work; and bring to pass his act, his strange act.

strangely and lest <u>05\_DEU\_32\_27</u># Were it not that I feared the wrath of the enemy, lest their adversaries should behave themselves strangely, [and] lest they should say, Our hand [is] high, and the LORD hath not done all this.

stranger all the <u>01\_GEN\_17\_08</u> # And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.

stranger an Amalekite <u>10\_2SA\_01\_13</u> # And David said unto the young man that told him, Whence [art] thou? And he answered, I [am] the son of a stranger, an Amalekite.

stranger and a <u>01\_GEN\_23\_04</u> # I [am] a stranger and a sojourner with you: give me a possession of a buryingplace with you, that I may bury my dead out of my sight.

stranger and also <u>10\_2SA\_15\_19</u># Then said the king to Ittai the Gittite, Wherefore goest thou also with us? return to thy place, and abide with the king: for thou [art] a stranger, and also an exile.

stranger and for <a href="Mailto:04\_NUM\_09\_14">04\_NUM\_09\_14</a> # And if a stranger shall sojourn among you, and will keep the passover unto the LORD; according to the ordinance of the passover, and according to the manner thereof, so shall he do: ye shall have one ordinance, both for the stranger, and for him that was born in the land.

stranger and for <u>04\_NUM\_35\_15</u># These six cities shall be a refuge, [both] for the children of Israel, and for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them: that every one that killeth any person unawares may flee thither.

stranger and murder 19\_PSA\_94\_06 # They slay the widow and the stranger, and murder the fatherless.

stranger and not 20\_PRO\_27\_02 # Let another man praise thee, and not thine own mouth; a stranger, and not thine own lips.

stranger and take <u>20\_PRO\_20\_16</u># Take his garment that is surety [for] a stranger: and take a pledge of him for a strange woman.

stranger and take <u>20\_PRO\_27\_13</u># Take his garment that is surety for a stranger, and take a pledge of him for a strange woman.

stranger and the <u>05\_DEU\_14\_29</u> # And the Levite, [because he hath no part nor inheritance with thee,] and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, which [are] within thy gates, shall come, and shall eat and be satisfied; that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hand which thou doest.

stranger and the <u>05\_DEU\_16\_11</u># And thou shalt rejoice before the LORD thy God, thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levite that [is] within thy gates, and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that [are] among you, in the place which the LORD thy God hath chosen to place his name there.

stranger and the <u>05\_DEU\_16\_14</u># And thou shalt rejoice in thy feast, thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levite, the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that [are] within thy gates.

stranger and took <u>40\_MAT\_25\_38</u># When saw we thee a stranger, and took [thee] in? or naked, and clothed [thee]?

stranger and ye <u>40\_MAT\_25\_35</u># For I was an hungered, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in:

stranger and ye <u>40\_MAT\_25\_43</u># I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not.

stranger as for <u>03\_LEV\_24\_22</u> # Ye shall have one manner of law, as well for the stranger, as for one of your own country: for I [am] the LORD your God.

stranger as he <u>06\_JOS\_08\_33</u># And all Israel, and their elders, and officers, and their judges, stood on this side the ark and on that side before the priests the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, as well the stranger, as he that was born among them; half of them over against mount Gerizim, and half of them over against mount Ebal; as Moses the servant of the LORD had commanded before, that they should bless the people of Israel.

stranger as he <u>03\_LEV\_24\_16</u># And he that blasphemeth the name of the LORD, he shall surely be put to death, [and] all the congregation shall certainly stone him: as well the stranger, as he that is born in the land, when he blasphemeth the name [of the LORD], shall be put to death.

stranger be before <u>04\_NUM\_15\_15</u># One ordinance [shall be both] for you of the congregation, and also for the stranger that sojourneth [with you], an ordinance for ever in your generations: as ye [are], so shall the stranger be before the LORD.

stranger calleth to <a href="#">14\_2CH\_06\_33</a> # Then hear thou from the heavens, [even] from thy dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calleth to thee for; that all people of the earth may know thy name, and fear thee, as [doth] thy people Israel, and may know that this house which I have built is called by thy name.

stranger did not <u>18\_JOB\_31\_32</u># The stranger did not lodge in the street: [but] I opened my doors to the traveller.

stranger doth not 20\_PRO\_14\_10 # The heart knoweth his own bitterness; and a stranger doth not intermeddle with his joy.

stranger eat of <u>03\_LEV\_22\_10</u># There shall no stranger eat [of] the holy thing: a sojourner of the priest, or an hired servant, shall not eat [of] the holy thing.

stranger eat thereof <u>02\_EXO\_12\_43</u># And the LORD said unto Moses and Aaron, This [is] the ordinance of the passover: There shall no stranger eat thereof:

stranger eat thereof <u>03\_LEV\_22\_13</u># But if the priest's daughter be a widow, or divorced, and have no child, and is returned unto her father's house, as in her youth, she shall eat of her father's meat: but there shall no stranger eat thereof.

stranger eateth it <u>21\_ECC\_06\_02</u> # A man to whom God hath given riches, wealth, and honour, so that he wanteth nothing for his soul of all that he desireth, yet God giveth him not power to eat thereof, but a stranger eateth it: this [is] vanity, and it [is] an evil disease.

stranger fatherless and <u>05\_DEU\_27\_19</u># Cursed [be] he that perverteth the judgment of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. And all the people shall say, Amen.

stranger fatherless and <u>05\_DEU\_27\_19</u># Cursed [be] he that perverteth the judgment of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. And all the people shall say, Amen.

stranger for the <u>05\_DEU\_24\_19</u> # When thou cuttest down thine harvest in thy field, and hast forgot a sheaf in the field, thou shalt not go again to fetch it: it shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow: that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hands.

stranger for the 05\_DEU\_24\_20 # When thou beatest thine olive tree, thou shalt not go over the boughs

again: it shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow.

stranger for the <u>05\_DEU\_24\_21</u># When thou gatherest the grapes of thy vineyard, thou shalt not glean [it] afterward: it shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow.

stranger for ye <u>05\_DEU\_10\_19</u> # Love ye therefore the stranger: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

stranger for ye <u>02\_EXO\_23\_09</u> # Also thou shalt not oppress a stranger: for ye know the heart of a stranger, seeing ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

stranger from his <u>39\_MAL\_03\_05</u> # And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in [his] wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger [from his right], and fear not me, saith the LORD of hosts.

stranger he shall <u>03\_LEV\_17\_15</u># And every soul that eateth that which died [of itself], or that which was torn [with beasts, whether it be] one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even: then shall he be clean.

stranger her husband's <u>05\_DEU\_25\_05</u># If brethren dwell together, and one of them die, and have no child, the wife of the dead shall not marry without unto a stranger: her husband's brother shall go in unto her, and take her to him to wife, and perform the duty of an husband's brother unto her.

stranger I am <u>18\_JOB\_19\_15</u># They that dwell in mine house, and my maids, count me for a stranger: I am an alien in their sight.

stranger I am <u>03\_LEV\_19\_10</u> # And thou shalt not glean thy vineyard, neither shalt thou gather [every] grape of thy vineyard; thou shalt leave them for the poor and stranger: I [am] the LORD your God.

stranger I am <u>03\_LEV\_23\_22</u># And when ye reap the harvest of your land, thou shalt not make clean riddance of the corners of thy field when thou reapest, neither shalt thou gather any gleaning of thy harvest: thou shalt leave them unto the poor, and to the stranger: I [am] the LORD your God.

stranger in a <u>02\_EXO\_02\_22</u> # And she bare [him] a son, and he called his name Gershom: for he said, I have been a stranger in a strange land.

stranger in a <u>01\_GEN\_15\_13</u> # And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land [that is] not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years;

stranger in giving <u>05\_DEU\_10\_18</u># He doth execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and loveth the stranger, in giving him food and raiment.

stranger in his <u>05\_DEU\_23\_07</u># Thou shalt not abhor an Edomite; for he [is] thy brother: thou shalt not abhor an Egyptian; because thou wast a stranger in his land.

stranger in Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_24\_18</u> # And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?

stranger in the <u>44\_ACT\_07\_29</u> # Then fled Moses at this saying, and was a stranger in the land of Madian, where he begat two sons.

stranger in the <u>01\_GEN\_37\_01</u># And Jacob dwelt in the land wherein his father was a stranger, in the land of Canaan.

stranger in the <u>24\_JER\_14\_08</u> # O the hope of Israel, the saviour thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man [that] turneth aside to tarry for a night?

stranger in the 19 PSA 119 19 # I [am] a stranger in the earth: hide not thy commandments from me.

stranger in thee <u>26\_EZE\_22\_07</u># In thee have they set light by father and mother: in the midst of thee have they dealt by oppression with the stranger: in thee have they vexed the fatherless and the widow.

stranger may be <u>02\_EXO\_23\_12</u> # Six days thou shalt do thy work, and on the seventh day thou shalt rest: that thine ox and thine ass may rest, and the son of thy handmaid, and the stranger, may be refreshed.

stranger neither shouldest <u>31\_OBA\_01\_12</u># But thou shouldest not have looked on the day of thy brother in the day that he became a stranger; neither shouldest thou have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction; neither shouldest thou have spoken proudly in the day of distress.

stranger which is <u>01\_GEN\_17\_12</u># And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which [is] not of thy seed.

stranger which is <u>04\_NUM\_16\_40</u> # [To be] a memorial unto the children of Israel, that no stranger, which [is] not of the seed of Aaron, come near to offer incense before the LORD; that he be not as Korah, and as his company: as the LORD said to him by the hand of Moses.

stranger will they <u>43\_JOH\_10\_05</u># And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.

stranger with thee 19\_PSA\_39\_12 # Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not thy peace at my tears: for I [am] a stranger with thee, [and] a sojourner, as all my fathers [were].

stranger with us <u>11\_1KI\_03\_18</u># And it came to pass the third day after that I was delivered, that this woman was delivered also: and we [were] together; [there was] no stranger with us in the house, save we two in the house.

strangers shall no <u>24\_JER\_30\_08</u># For it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, [that] I will break his yoke from off thy neck, and will burst thy bonds, and strangers shall no more serve themselves of him:

strangers shall stand <u>23\_ISA\_61\_05</u># And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien [shall be] your plowmen and your vinedressers.

Strangers shall submit <u>10\_28A\_22\_45</u># Strangers shall submit themselves unto me: as soon as they hear, they shall be obedient unto me.

strangers shall submit 19\_PSA\_18\_44 # As soon as they hear of me, they shall obey me: the strangers shall submit themselves unto me.

strangers shall swallow <u>28\_HOS\_08\_07</u># For they have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind: it hath no stalk: the bud shall yield no meal: if so be it yield, the strangers shall swallow it up.

strangers spoil his <u>19\_PSA\_109\_11</u># Let the extortioner catch all that he hath; and let the strangers spoil his labour.

strangers that are <u>05\_DEU\_24\_14</u> # Thou shalt not oppress an hired servant [that is] poor and needy, [whether he be] of thy brethren, or of thy strangers that [are] in thy land within thy gates:

strangers that came <u>14\_2CH\_30\_25</u> # And all the congregation of Judah, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of Israel, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in Judah, rejoiced.

strangers that do <u>03\_LEV\_25\_45</u> # Moreover of the children of the strangers that do sojourn among you, of them shall ye buy, and of their families that [are] with you, which they begat in your land: and they shall be your possession.

strangers under every <u>24\_JER\_03\_13</u># Only acknowledge thine iniquity, that thou hast transgressed against the LORD thy God, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and ye have not obeyed my voice, saith the LORD.

strangers upon thee <u>26\_EZE\_28\_07</u># Behold, therefore I will bring strangers upon thee, the terrible of the nations: and they shall draw their swords against the beauty of thy wisdom, and they shall defile thy brightness.
