sup and gird 42_LUK_17_08 # And will not rather say unto him, Make ready wherewith I may sup, and gird thyself, and serve me, till I have eaten and drunken; and afterward thou shalt eat and drink?

sup up as <u>35_HAB_01_09</u> # They shall come all for violence: their faces shall sup up [as] the east wind, and they shall gather the captivity as the sand.

sup with him 66_REV_03_20 # Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

superfluity of naughtiness <u>59_JAM_01_21</u># Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

superfluous for me <u>47_2CO_09_01</u># For as touching the ministering to the saints, it is superfluous for me to write to you:

superfluous or lacking <u>03_LEV_22_23</u> # Either a bullock or a lamb that hath any thing superfluous or lacking in his parts, that mayest thou offer [for] a freewill offering; but for a vow it shall not be accepted.

superfluous <u>03_LEV_21_18</u> # For whatsoever man [he be] that hath a blemish, he shall not approach: a blind man, or a lame, or he that hath a flat nose, or any thing superfluous,

superscription also was <u>42_LUK_23_38</u># And a superscription also was written over him in letters of Greek, and Latin, and Hebrew, THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.

superscription And they <u>41_MAR_12_16</u># And they brought [it]. And he saith unto them, Whose [is] this image and superscription? And they said unto him, Caesar's.

superscription hath it <u>42_LUK_20_24</u> # Show me a penny. Whose image and superscription hath it? They answered and said, Caesar's.

superscription of his <u>41_MAR_15_26</u> # And the superscription of his accusation was written over, THE KING OF THE JEWS.

superscription 40_MAT_22_20# And he saith unto them, Whose [is] this image and superscription?

superstition and of <u>44_ACT_25_19</u># But had certain questions against him of their own superstition, and of one Jesus, which was dead, whom Paul affirmed to be alive.

superstitious <u>44_ACT_17_22</u> # Then Paul stood in the midst of Mars' hill, and said, [Ye] men of Athens, I perceive that in all things ye are too superstitious.

supper being ended <u>43_JOH_13_02</u> # And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's [son], to betray him;

supper call not <u>42_LUK_14_12</u># Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor [thy] rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompense be made thee.

supplication and maintain 14_2CH_06_35 # Then hear thou from the heavens their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause.

supplication be accepted 24 JER 42 02 # And said unto Jeremiah the prophet, Let, we beseech thee, our supplication be accepted before thee, and pray for us unto the LORD thy God, [even] for all this remnant; [for we are left [but] a few of many, as thine eyes do behold us:]

supplication for all <u>49_EPH_06_18</u> # Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

supplication I pray <u>24_JER_37_20</u> # Therefore hear now, I pray thee, O my lord the king: let my supplication, I pray thee, be accepted before thee; that thou cause me not to return to the house of Jonathan the scribe, lest I die there.

supplication in heaven <u>11_1KI_08_49</u> # Then hear thou their prayer and their supplication in heaven thy dwelling place, and maintain their cause,

supplication in the <u>49_EPH_06_18</u># Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

supplication O LORD <u>11_1KI_08_28</u># Yet have thou respect unto the prayer of thy servant, and to his supplication, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and to the prayer, which thy servant prayeth before thee to day:

supplication the LORD <u>19_PSA_06_09</u> # The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer.

supplication to my <u>18_JOB_09_15</u> # Whom, though I were righteous, [yet] would I not answer, [but] I would make supplication to my judge.

supplication to the <u>18_JOB_08_05</u># If thou wouldest seek unto God betimes, and make thy supplication to the Almighty;

supplication unto him <u>17_EST_04_08</u># Also he gave him the copy of the writing of the decree that was given at Shushan to destroy them, to show [it] unto Esther, and to declare [it] unto her, and to charge her that she should go in unto the king, to make supplication unto him, and to make request before him for her people.

supplication unto him <u>28_HOS_12_04</u> # Yea, he had power over the angel, and prevailed: he wept, and made supplication unto him: he found him [in] Bethel, and there he spake with us;

supplication 19_PSA_55_01 # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. Give ear to my prayer, O God; and hide not thyself from my supplication.

supplications and cause <u>27_DAN_09_17</u># Now therefore, O our God, hear the prayer of thy servant, and his supplications, and cause thy face to shine upon thy sanctuary that is desolate, for the Lord's sake.

supplications and maintain <u>14_2CH_06_39</u># Then hear thou from the heavens, [even] from thy dwelling place, their prayer and their supplications, and maintain their cause, and forgive thy people which have sinned against thee.

supplications before thee <u>27_DAN_09_18</u> # O my God, incline thine ear, and hear; open thine eyes, and behold our desolations, and the city which is called by thy name: for we do not present our supplications before thee for our righteousnesses, but for thy great mercies.

supplications in thy 19_PSA_143_01 # A Psalm of David. Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications: in thy faithfulness answer me, [and] in thy righteousness.

supplications O LORD 19_PSA_140_06 # I said unto the LORD, Thou [art] my God: hear the voice of my supplications, O LORD.

supplications of the <u>24_JER_03_21</u> # A voice was heard upon the high places, weeping [and] supplications of the children of Israel: for they have perverted their way, [and] they have forgotten the LORD their God.

supplications of thy <u>14_2CH_06_21</u># Hearken therefore unto the supplications of thy servant, and of thy people Israel, which they shall make toward this place: hear thou from thy dwelling place, [even] from heaven; and when thou hearest, forgive.

supplications when I <u>19 PSA 28 02</u> # Hear the voice of my supplications, when I cry unto thee, when I lift up my hands toward thy holy oracle.

supplications when I <u>19 PSA 31 22 #</u> For I said in my haste, I am cut off from before thine eyes: nevertheless thou heardest the voice of my supplications when I cried unto thee.

supplications will I <u>24 JER_31_09</u> # They shall come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim [is] my firstborn.

supplications with fasting <u>27_DAN_09_03</u># And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes:

supplications with strong <u>58_HEB_05_07</u># Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared;

supplications 19_PSA_116_01 # I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice [and] my supplications.

supplications 19_PSA_130_02 # Lord, hear my voice: let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications.

supplications 19 PSA 28 06 # Blessed [be] the LORD, because he hath heard the voice of my supplications.

supplications <u>19_PSA_86_06</u># Give ear, O LORD, unto my prayer; and attend to the voice of my supplications.

supplied and in <u>47_2CO_11_09</u># And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all [things] I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and [so] will I keep [myself].

supplied <u>46_1CO_16_17</u># I am glad of the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus: for that which was lacking on your part they have supplied.

supplieth according to 49_EPH_04_16 # From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted

by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

supplieth the want <u>47_2CO_09_12</u># For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God;

supply all your <u>50_PHP_04_19</u># But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

supply for their <u>47_2CO_08_14</u> # But by an equality, [that] now at this time your abundance [may be a supply] for their want, that their abundance also may be [a supply] for your want: that there may be equality:

suppose I have <u>60_1PE_05_12</u># By Silvanus, a faithful brother unto you, as I suppose, I have written briefly, exhorting, and testifying that this is the true grace of God wherein ye stand.

suppose I was 47_2CO_11_05 # For I suppose I was not a whit behind the very chiefest apostles.

suppose seeing it <u>44_ACT_02_15</u># For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is [but] the third hour of the day.

suppose that even <u>43_JOH_21_25</u># And there are also many other things which Jesus did, the which, if they should be written every one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written. Amen.

suppose that he <u>42_LUK_07_43</u> # Simon answered and said, I suppose that [he], to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou hast rightly judged.

suppose that they <u>10_2SA_13_32</u># And Jonadab, the son of Shimeah David's brother, answered and said, Let not my lord suppose [that] they have slain all the young men the king's sons; for Amnon only is dead: for by the appointment of Absalom this hath been determined from the day that he forced his sister Tamar.

suppose therefore that <u>46_1CO_07_26</u> # I suppose therefore that this is good for the present distress, [I say], that [it is] good for a man so to be.

suppose ye shall <u>58_HEB_10_29</u> # Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?

Suppose ye that 42 LUK 12 51 # Suppose ye that I am come to give peace on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division:

supposed that they <u>42_LUK_24_37</u># But they were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a spirit.

supposed that they <u>40_MAT_20_10</u># But when the first came, they supposed that they should have received more; and they likewise received every man a penny.

supposed the son 42 LUK 03 23 # And Jesus himself began to be about thirty years of age, being [as was supposed] the son of Joseph, which was [the son] of Heli,

supposed <u>44_ACT_25_18</u> # Against whom when the accusers stood up, they brought none accusation of such things as I supposed:

supposing he had <u>44_ACT_14_19</u> # And there came thither [certain] Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew [him] out of the city, supposing he had been dead.

supposing him to 43_JOH_20_15 # Jesus saith unto her, Woman, why weepest thou? whom seekest thou? She, supposing him to be the gardener, saith unto him, Sir, if thou have borne him hence, tell me where thou hast laid him, and I will take him away.

supposing him to <u>42_LUK_02_44</u> # But they, supposing him to have been in the company, went a day's journey; and they sought him among [their] kinsfolk and acquaintance.

supposing that gain <u>54_1TI_06_05</u> # Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.

supposing that the <u>44_ACT_16_27</u># And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.

supposing that they <u>44_ACT_27_13</u> # And when the south wind blew softly, supposing that they had obtained [their] purpose, loosing [thence], they sailed close by Crete.

supposing to add <u>50_PHP_01_16</u># The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds:
