avoid foolish questions [56 TIT 03 09](#) # But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.

avoid fornication let [46 1CO 07 02](#) # Nevertheless, [to avoid] fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband.

Avoid it pass [20 PRO 04 15](#) # Avoid it, pass not by it, turn from it, and pass away.

avoid knowing that [55 2TI 02 23](#) # But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.

avoid them [45 ROM 16 17](#) # Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them.

avoided out of [09 ISA 18 11](#) # And Saul cast the javelin; for he said, I will smite David even to the wall [with it]. And David avoided out of his presence twice.

avoiding profane and [54 1TI 06 20](#) # O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane [and] vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:

void after that [04 NUM 30 15](#) # But if he shall any ways make them void after that he hath heard [them]; then he shall bear her iniquity.

void and darkness [01 GEN 01 02](#) # And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness [was] upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

void and the [24 JER 04 23](#) # I beheld the earth, and, lo, [it was] without form, and void; and the heavens, and they [had] no light.

void and the [04 NUM 30 12](#) # But if her husband hath utterly made them void on the day he heard [them; then] whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul, shall not stand: her husband hath made them void; and the LORD shall forgive her.

void and the [45 ROM 04 14](#) # For if they which are of the law [be] heirs, faith is made void, and the promise made of none effect:

void and waste [34 NAH 02 10](#) # She is empty, and void, and waste: and the heart melteth, and the knees smite together, and much pain [is] in all loins, and the faces of them all gather blackness.

void but it [23 ISA 55 11](#) # So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper [in the thing] whereto I sent it.

void of counsel [05 DEU 32 28](#) # For they [are] a nation void of counsel, neither [is there any] understanding in them.

void of offence [44 ACT 24 16](#) # And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and [toward] men.

void of understanding [20 PRO 07 07](#) # And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding,

void of understanding [20 PRO 10 13](#) # In the lips of him that hath understanding wisdom is found: but a rod [is] for the back of him that is void of understanding.

void of understanding [20 PRO 12 11](#) # He that tilleth his land shall be satisfied with bread: but he that followeth vain [persons is] void of understanding.

void of understanding [20 PRO 17 18](#) # A man void of understanding striketh hands, [and] becometh surety in the presence of his friend.

void of understanding [20 PRO 24 30](#) # I went by the field of the slothful, and by the vineyard of the man void of understanding;

void of wisdom [20 PRO 11 12](#) # He that is void of wisdom despiseth his neighbour: but a man of understanding holdeth his peace.

void on the [04 NUM 30 12](#) # But if her husband hath utterly made them void on the day he heard [them; then] whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul, shall not stand: her husband hath made them void; and the LORD shall forgive her.

void the counsel [24 JER 19 07](#) # And I will make void the counsel of Judah and Jerusalem in this place; and I will cause them to fall by the sword before their enemies, and by the hands of them that seek their lives: and their carcasses will I give to be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.

void the covenant [19 PSA 89 39](#) # Thou hast made void the covenant of thy servant: thou hast profaned his crown [by casting it] to the ground.

void the law [45 ROM 03 31](#) # Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.

void thy law [19 PSA 119 126](#) # [It is] time for [thee], LORD, to work: [for] they have made void thy law.

void [46 1CO 09 15](#) # But I have used none of these things: neither have I written these things, that it should be so done unto me: for [it were] better for me to die, than that any man should make my glorying void.
