sweep away the <u>23\_ISA\_28\_17</u># Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place.

sweep it with 23 ISA 14 23 # I will also make it a possession for the bittern, and pools of water: and I will sweep it with the besom of destruction, saith the LORD of hosts.

sweep the house <u>42\_LUK\_15\_08</u># Either what woman having ten pieces of silver, if she lose one piece, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house, and seek diligently till she find [it]?

sweeping rain which <u>20\_PRO\_28\_03</u> # A poor man that oppresseth the poor [is like] a sweeping rain which leaveth no food.

weep and a 21\_ECC\_03\_04 # A time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance;

weep and he <u>01\_GEN\_43\_30</u> # And Joseph made haste; for his bowels did yearn upon his brother: and he sought [where] to weep; and he entered into [his] chamber, and wept there.

weep and how 59\_JAM\_05\_01 # Go to now, [ye] rich men, weep and how for your miseries that shall come upon [you].

weep and howl <u>29\_JOE\_01\_05</u> # Awake, ye drunkards, and weep; and howl, all ye drinkers of wine, because of the new wine, for it is cut off from your mouth.

weep and lament <u>43\_JOH\_16\_20</u> # Verily, verily, I say unto you, That ye shall weep and lament, but the world shall rejoice: and ye shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy.

weep and mourn <u>66\_REV\_18\_11</u># And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their merchandise any more:

weep And they <u>09\_1SA\_11\_05</u># And, behold, Saul came after the herd out of the field; and Saul said, What [aileth] the people that they weep? And they told him the tidings of the men of Jabesh.

weep and to <u>44\_ACT\_21\_13</u> # Then Paul answered, What mean ye to weep and to break mine heart? for I am ready not to be bound only, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus.

weep as though <u>46\_1CO\_07\_30</u> # And they that weep, as though they wept not; and they that rejoice, as though they rejoiced not; and they that buy, as though they possessed not;

weep before me <u>14\_2CH\_34\_27</u> # Because thine heart was tender, and thou didst humble thyself before God, when thou heardest his words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and humbledst thyself before me, and didst rend thy clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard [thee] also, saith the LORD.

weep between the <u>29\_JOE\_02\_17</u> # Let the priests, the ministers of the LORD, weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say, Spare thy people, O LORD, and give not thine heritage to reproach, that the heathen should rule over them: wherefore should they say among the people, Where [is] their God?

weep bitterly labour 23\_ISA\_22\_04 # Therefore said I, Look away from me: I will weep bitterly, labour not

to comfort me, because of the spoiling of the daughter of my people.

weep bitterly <u>23\_ISA\_33\_07</u># Behold, their valiant ones shall cry without: the ambassadors of peace shall weep bitterly.

weep but ye <u>26\_EZE\_24\_23</u> # And your tires [shall be] upon your heads, and your shoes upon your feet: ye shall not mourn nor weep; but ye shall pine away for your iniquities, and mourn one toward another.

weep day and 24\_JER\_09\_01 # Oh that my head were waters, and mine eyes a fountain of tears, that I might weep day and night for the slain of the daughter of my people!

weep For all <u>16\_NEH\_08\_09</u> # And Nehemiah, which [is] the Tirshatha, and Ezra the priest the scribe, and the Levites that taught the people, said unto all the people, This day [is] holy unto the LORD your God; mourn not, nor weep. For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the law.

weep for her <u>01\_GEN\_23\_02</u> # And Sarah died in Kirjatharba; the same [is] Hebron in the land of Canaan: and Abraham came to mourn for Sarah, and to weep for her.

weep for him <u>18\_JOB\_30\_25</u> # Did not I weep for him that was in trouble? was [not] my soul grieved for the poor?

weep for the <u>10\_2SA\_12\_21</u># Then said his servants unto him, What thing [is] this that thou hast done? thou didst fast and weep for the child, [while it was] alive; but when the child was dead, thou didst rise and eat bread.

weep for thee <u>26\_EZE\_27\_31</u># And they shall make themselves utterly bald for thee, and gird them with sackcloth, and they shall weep for thee with bitterness of heart [and] bitter wailing.

weep for thee <u>24\_JER\_48\_32</u> # O vine of Sibmah, I will weep for thee with the weeping of Jazer: thy plants are gone over the sea, they reach [even] to the sea of Jazer: the spoiler is fallen upon thy summer fruits and upon thy vintage.

weep for yourselves <u>42\_LUK\_23\_28</u> # But Jesus turning unto them said, Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for me, but weep for yourselves, and for your children.

weep in secret 24\_JER\_13\_17 # But if ye will not hear it, my soul shall weep in secret places for [your] pride; and mine eye shall weep sore, and run down with tears, because the LORD's flock is carried away captive.

weep in the <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_03</u> # [And] to speak unto the priests which [were] in the house of the LORD of hosts, and to the prophets, saying, Should I weep in the fifth month, separating myself, as I have done these so many years?

weep let your <u>59\_JAM\_04\_09</u> # Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and [your] joy to heaviness.

weep mine eye <u>25\_LAM\_01\_16</u># For these [things] I weep; mine eye, mine eye runneth down with water, because the comforter that should relieve my soul is far from me: my children are desolate, because the enemy prevailed.

weep Moab shall <u>23\_ISA\_15\_02</u># He is gone up to Bajith, and to Dibon, the high places, to weep: Moab shall howl over Nebo, and over Medeba: on all their heads [shall be] baldness, [and] every beard cut off.

weep neither shall <u>26\_EZE\_24\_16</u># Son of man, behold, I take away from thee the desire of thine eyes with a stroke: yet neither shalt thou mourn nor weep, neither shall thy tears run down.

weep no more <u>23\_ISA\_30\_19</u> # For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem: thou shalt weep no more: he will be very gracious unto thee at the voice of thy cry; when he shall hear it, he will answer thee.

Weep not behold <u>66\_REV\_05\_05</u> # And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

weep not for <u>42\_LUK\_23\_28</u># But Jesus turning unto them said, Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for me, but weep for yourselves, and for your children.

Weep not she <u>42\_LUK\_08\_52</u># And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth.

Weep not <u>42\_LUK\_07\_13</u># And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not.

weep now for 42\_LUK\_06\_21 # Blessed [are ye] that hunger now: for ye shall be filled. Blessed [are ye] that weep now: for ye shall laugh.

weep over Saul <u>10\_2SA\_01\_24</u> # Ye daughters of Israel, weep over Saul, who clothed you in scarlet, with [other] delights, who put on ornaments of gold upon your apparel.

weep sore and 24\_JER\_13\_17 # But if ye will not hear it, my soul shall weep in secret places for [your] pride; and mine eye shall weep sore, and run down with tears, because the LORD's flock is carried away captive.

weep sore for 24\_JER\_22\_10 # Weep ye not for the dead, neither bemoan him: [but] weep sore for him that goeth away: for he shall return no more, nor see his native country.

weep the damsel <u>41\_MAR\_05\_39</u> # And when he was come in, he saith unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth.

weep there <u>43\_JOH\_11\_31</u># The Jews then which were with her in the house, and comforted her, when they saw Mary, that she rose up hastily and went out, followed her, saying, She goeth unto the grave to weep there.

weep throughout their <u>04\_NUM\_11\_10</u># Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased.

weep unto me <u>04\_NUM\_11\_13</u> # Whence should I have flesh to give unto all this people? for they weep unto me, saying, Give us flesh, that we may eat.

weep with them 45\_ROM\_12\_15 # Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.

Weep ye not 24\_JER\_22\_10 # Weep ye not for the dead, neither bemoan him: [but] weep sore for him that goeth away: for he shall return no more, nor see his native country.

weep ye not <u>33\_MIC\_01\_10</u> # Declare ye [it] not at Gath, weep ye not at all: in the house of Aphrah roll thyself in the dust.

weep <u>09\_1SA\_30\_04</u># Then David and the people that [were] with him lifted up their voice and wept, until they had no more power to weep.

weep 18\_JOB\_27\_15 # Those that remain of him shall be buried in death: and his widows shall not weep.

weep <u>18\_JOB\_30\_31</u># My harp also is [turned] to mourning, and my organ into the voice of them that weep.

weep <u>42\_LUK\_06\_25</u> # Woe unto you that are full! for ye shall hunger. Woe unto you that laugh now! for ye shall mourn and weep.

weep 45\_ROM\_12\_15 # Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.

weepest thou and <u>09\_1SA\_01\_08</u> # Then said Elkanah her husband to her, Hannah, why weepest thou? and why eatest thou not? and why is thy heart grieved? [am] not I better to thee than ten sons?

weepest thou She <u>43\_JOH\_20\_13</u># And they say unto her, Woman, why weepest thou? She saith unto them, Because they have taken away my Lord, and I know not where they have laid him.

weepest thou whom <u>43\_JOH\_20\_15</u># Jesus saith unto her, Woman, why weepest thou? whom seekest thou? She, supposing him to be the gardener, saith unto him, Sir, if thou have borne him hence, tell me where thou hast laid him, and I will take him away.

weepeth and mourneth 10\_2SA\_19\_01 # And it was told Joab, Behold, the king weepeth and mourneth for Absalom.

weepeth bearing precious <u>19 PSA\_126\_06</u># He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves [with him].

weepeth my lord 12\_2KI\_08\_12 # And Hazael said, Why weepeth my lord? And he answered, Because I know the evil that thou wilt do unto the children of Israel: their strong holds wilt thou set on fire, and their young men wilt thou slay with the sword, and wilt dash their children, and rip up their women with child.

weepeth sore in <u>25\_LAM\_01\_02</u># She weepeth sore in the night, and her tears [are] on her cheeks: among all her lovers she hath none to comfort [her]: all her friends have dealt treacherously with her, they are become her enemies.

weeping abundantly <u>23\_ISA\_15\_03</u> # In their streets they shall gird themselves with sackcloth: on the tops of their houses, and in their streets, every one shall howl, weeping abundantly.

weeping all along <u>24\_JER\_41\_06</u># And Ishmael the son of Nethaniah went forth from Mizpah to meet them, weeping all along as he went: and it came to pass, as he met them, he said unto them, Come to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam.

weeping and as <u>43\_JOH\_20\_11</u># But Mary stood without at the sepulchre weeping: and as she wept, she stooped down, [and looked] into the sepulchre,

weeping and began <u>42\_LUK\_07\_38</u># And stood at his feet behind [him] weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe [them] with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed [them] with the ointment.

weeping and casting <u>15\_EZR\_10\_01</u> # Now when Ezra had prayed, and when he had confessed, weeping and casting himself down before the house of God, there assembled unto him out of Israel a very great congregation of men and women and children: for the people wept very sore.

weeping and gnashing <u>42\_LUK\_13\_28</u># There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you [yourselves] thrust out.

weeping and gnashing 40 MAT 08 12 # But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

weeping and gnashing 40\_MAT\_22\_13# Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast [him] into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

weeping and gnashing 40 MAT 24 51 # And shall cut him asunder, and appoint [him] his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

weeping and gnashing 40\_MAT\_25\_30 # And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

weeping and great 40 MAT 02 18 # In Rama was there a voice heard, lamentation, and weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping [for] her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not.

weeping and mourning <u>05\_DEU\_34\_08</u># And the children of Israel wept for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days: so the days of weeping [and] mourning for Moses were ended.

weeping and on 18\_JOB\_16\_16 # My face is foul with weeping, and on my eyelids [is] the shadow of death;

weeping and showing 44\_ACT\_09\_39 # Then Peter arose and went with them. When he was come, they brought him into the upper chamber: and all the widows stood by him weeping, and showing the coats and garments which Dorcas made, while she was with them.

weeping and supplications <u>24\_JER\_03\_21</u># A voice was heard upon the high places, weeping [and] supplications of the children of Israel: for they have perverted their way, [and] they have forgotten the LORD their God.

weeping and the <u>43\_JOH\_11\_33</u># When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, he groaned in the spirit, and was troubled,

weeping and thine 24\_JER\_31\_16# Thus saith the LORD; Refrain thy voice from weeping, and thine eyes from tears: for thy work shall be rewarded, saith the LORD; and they shall come again from the land of the enemy.

weeping and to <u>23\_ISA\_22\_12</u> # And in that day did the Lord GOD of hosts call to weeping, and to mourning, and to baldness, and to girding with sackcloth:

weeping and wailing <u>17\_EST\_04\_03</u># And in every province, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, [there was] great mourning among the Jews, and fasting, and weeping, and wailing; and many lay in sackcloth and ashes.

weeping and wailing 24\_JER\_09\_10 # For the mountains will I take up a weeping and wailing, and for the habitations of the wilderness a lamentation, because they are burned up, so that none can pass through [them]; neither can [men] hear the voice of the cattle; both the fowl of the heavens and the beast are fled; they are gone.

weeping and wailing <u>66\_REV\_18\_15</u> # The merchants of these things, which were made rich by her, shall stand afar off for the fear of her torment, weeping and wailing,

weeping and wailing <u>66\_REV\_18\_19</u># And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying, Alas, alas, that great city, wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! for in one hour is she made desolate.

weeping and with 24\_JER\_31\_09 # They shall come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I

will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim [is] my firstborn.

weeping and with <u>29\_JOE\_02\_12</u> # Therefore also now, saith the LORD, turn ye [even] to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning:

weeping and with <u>39\_MAL\_02\_13</u># And this have ye done again, covering the altar of the LORD with tears, with weeping, and with crying out, insomuch that he regardeth not the offering any more, or receiveth [it] with good will at your hand.

weeping as they <u>10\_2SA\_15\_30</u> # And David went up by the ascent of [mount] Olivet, and wept as he went up, and had his head covered, and he went barefoot: and all the people that [was] with him covered every man his head, and they went up, weeping as they went up.

weeping before the <u>04\_NUM\_25\_06</u># And, behold, one of the children of Israel came and brought unto his brethren a Midianitish woman in the sight of Moses, and in the sight of all the congregation of the children of Israel, who [were] weeping [before] the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

weeping behind her <u>10\_2SA\_03\_16</u># And her husband went with her along weeping behind her to Bahurim. Then said Abner unto him, Go, return. And he returned.

weeping for her 24 JER 31 15 # Thus saith the LORD; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, [and] bitter weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they [were] not.

weeping for her <u>40\_MAT\_02\_18</u># In Rama was there a voice heard, lamentation, and weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping [for] her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not.

weeping for Tammuz <u>26\_EZE\_08\_14</u> # Then he brought me to the door of the gate of the LORD'S house which [was] toward the north; and, behold, there sat women weeping for Tammuz.

weeping may endure 19\_PSA\_30\_05 # For his anger [endureth but] a moment; in his favour [is] life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy [cometh] in the morning.

weeping of Jazer <u>23\_ISA\_16\_09</u> # Therefore I will bewail with the weeping of Jazer the vine of Sibmah: I will water thee with my tears, O Heshbon, and Elealeh: for the shouting for thy summer fruits and for thy harvest is fallen.

weeping of Jazer <u>24\_JER\_48\_32</u> # O vine of Sibmah, I will weep for thee with the weeping of Jazer: thy plants are gone over the sea, they reach [even] to the sea of Jazer: the spoiler is fallen upon thy summer fruits and upon thy vintage.

weeping of the <u>15\_EZR\_03\_13</u># So that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of joy from the noise of the weeping of the people: for the people shouted with a loud shout, and the noise was heard afar off.

weeping Rahel weeping 24\_JER\_31\_15 # Thus saith the LORD; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, [and] bitter weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they [were] not.

weeping shall be 23\_ISA\_65\_19 # And I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and joy in my people: and the voice of weeping shall be no more heard in her, nor the voice of crying.

weeping shall go <u>24\_JER\_48\_05</u># For in the going up of Luhith continual weeping shall go up; for in the going down of Horonaim the enemies have heard a cry of destruction.

weeping shall they <u>23\_ISA\_15\_05</u># My heart shall cry out for Moab; his fugitives [shall flee] unto Zoar, an heifer of three years old: for by the mounting up of Luhith with weeping shall they go it up; for in the way of Horonaim they shall raise up a cry of destruction.

weeping that they <u>50\_PHP\_03\_18</u> # [For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, [that they are] the enemies of the cross of Christ:

weeping they shall <u>24\_JER\_50\_04</u># In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the children of Israel shall come, they and the children of Judah together, going and weeping: they shall go, and seek the LORD their God.

weeping which came <u>43\_JOH\_11\_33</u># When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, he groaned in the spirit, and was troubled,

weeping 19\_PSA\_06\_08 # Depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity; for the LORD hath heard the voice of my weeping.

weeping 19\_PSA\_102\_09 # For I have eaten ashes like bread, and mingled my drink with weeping,
