unweighed because they [11 1KI 07 47](#) # And Solomon left all the vessels [unweighed], because they were exceeding many: neither was the weight of the brass found out.

weighed and my [18 JOB 06 02](#) # Oh that my grief were thoroughly weighed, and my calamity laid in the balances together!

weighed for my [38 ZEC 11 12](#) # And I said unto them, If ye think good, give [me] my price; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my price thirty [pieces] of silver.

weighed for the [18 JOB 28 15](#) # It cannot be gotten for gold, neither shall silver be weighed [for] the price thereof.

weighed him the [24 JER 32 09](#) # And I bought the field of Hanameel my uncle's son, that [was] in Anathoth, and weighed him the money, [even] seventeen shekels of silver.

weighed him the [24 JER 32 10](#) # And I subscribed the evidence, and sealed [it], and took witnesses, and weighed [him] the money in the balances.

weighed in an [18 JOB 31 06](#) # Let me be weighed in an even balance that God may know mine integrity.

weighed in the [27 DAN 05 27](#) # TEKEL; Thou art weighed in the balances, and art found wanting.

weighed in the [15 EZR 08 33](#) # Now on the fourth day was the silver and the gold and the vessels weighed in the house of our God by the hand of Meremoth the son of Uriah the priest; and with him [was] Eleazar the son of Phinehas; and with them [was] Jozabad the son of Jeshua, and Noadiah the son of Binnui, Levites;

weighed six hundred [09 ISA 17 07](#) # And the staff of his spear [was] like a weaver's beam; and his spear's head [weighed] six hundred shekels of iron: and one bearing a shield went before him.

weighed the hair [10 2SA 14 26](#) # And when he polled his head, [for it was at every year's end that he polled [it]: because [the hair] was heavy on him, therefore he polled it:] he weighed the hair of his head at two hundred shekels after the king's weight.

weighed the mountains [23 ISA 40 12](#) # Who hath measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, and meted out heaven with the span, and comprehended the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales, and the hills in a balance?

weighed three hundred [10 2SA 21 16](#) # And Ishbibenob, which [was] of the sons of the giant, the weight of whose spear [weighed] three hundred [shekels] of brass in weight, he being girded with a new [sword], thought to have slain David.

weighed to Ephron [01 GEN 23 16](#) # And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current [money] with the merchant.

weighed two thousand [04 NUM 07 85](#) # Each charger of silver [weighing] an hundred and thirty [shekels], each bowl seventy: all the silver vessels [weighed] two thousand and four hundred [shekels], after the shekel of the sanctuary:

weighed unto their [15 EZR 08 26](#) # I even weighed unto their hand six hundred and fifty talents of silver, and silver vessels an hundred talents, [and] of gold an hundred talents;

weighed unto them [15 EZR 08 25](#) # And weighed unto them the silver, and the gold, and the vessels, [even] the offering of the house of our God, which the king, and his counsellors, and his lords, and all Israel [there] present, had offered:

weighed [09 ISA 02 03](#) # Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let [not] arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD [is] a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed.
