whither she will [05_DEU_21_14](#) # And it shall be, if thou have no delight in her, then thou shalt let her go whither she will; but thou shalt not sell her at all for money, thou shalt not make merchandise of her, because thou hast humbled her.

whither that thou [11_1KI_02_42](#) # And the king sent and called for Shimei, and said unto him, Did I not make thee to swear by the LORD, and protested unto thee, saying, Know for a certain, on the day thou goest out, and walkest abroad any whither, that thou shalt surely die? and thou saidst unto me, The word [that] I have heard [is] good.

Whither the forerunner [58_HEB_06_20](#) # Whither the forerunner is for us entered, [even] Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

whither the head [26_EZE_10_11](#) # When they went, they went upon their four sides; they turned not as they went, but to the place whither the head looked they followed it; they turned not as they went.

whither the Jews [43_JOH_18_20](#) # Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogue, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing.

whither the LORD [05_DEU_04_27](#) # And the LORD shall scatter you among the nations, and ye shall be left few in number among the heathen, whither the LORD shall lead you.

whither the LORD [05_DEU_28_37](#) # And thou shalt become an astonishment, a proverb, and a byword, among all nations whither the LORD shall lead thee.

whither the LORD [05_DEU_30_01](#) # And it shall come to pass, when all these things are come upon thee, the blessing and the curse, which I have set before thee, and thou shalt call [them] to mind among all the nations, whither the LORD thy God hath driven thee,

whither the LORD [05_DEU_30_03](#) # That then the LORD thy God will turn thy captivity, and have compassion upon thee, and will return and gather thee from all the nations, whither the LORD thy God hath scattered thee.

whither the LORD [24_JER_19_14](#) # Then came Jeremiah from Tophet, whither the LORD had sent him to

prophesy; and he stood in the court of the LORD'S house; and said to all the people,

whither the men [06 JOS 02 05](#) # And it came to pass [about the time] of shutting of the gate, when it was dark, that the men went out: whither the men went I wot not: pursue after them quickly; for ye shall overtake them.

whither they are [14 2CH 06 37](#) # Yet [if] they bethink themselves in the land whither they are carried captive, and turn and pray unto thee in the land of their captivity, saying, We have sinned, we have done amiss, and have dealt wickedly;

whither they be [26 EZE 37 21](#) # And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will take the children of Israel from among the heathen, whither they be gone, and will gather them on every side, and bring them into their own land:

whither they come [26 EZE 12 16](#) # But I will leave a few men of them from the sword, from the famine, and from the pestilence; that they may declare all their abominations among the heathen whither they come; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD.

whither they have [24 JER 22 12](#) # But he shall die in the place whither they have led him captive, and shall see this land no more.

whither they shall [26 EZE 06 09](#) # And they that escape of you shall remember me among the nations whither they shall be carried captives, because I am broken with their whorish heart, which hath departed from me, and with their eyes, which go a whoring after their idols: and they shall loathe themselves for the evils which they have committed in all their abominations.

whither they went [10 2SA 17 18](#) # Nevertheless a lad saw them, and told Absalom: but they went both of
