willing and obedient [23 ISA 01 19](#) # If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land:

willing and they [02 EXO 35 21](#) # And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, [and] they brought the LORD'S offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments.

willing but the [40 MAT 26 41](#) # Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed [is] willing, but the flesh [is] weak.

willing for a [43 JOH 05 35](#) # He was a burning and a shining light: and ye were willing for a season to rejoice in his light.

willing heart let [02 EXO 35 05](#) # Take ye from among you an offering unto the LORD: whosoever [is] of a willing heart, let him bring it, an offering of the LORD; gold, and silver, and brass,

willing hearted and [02 EXO 35 22](#) # And they came, both men and women, as many as were willing hearted, [and] brought bracelets, and earrings, and rings, and tablets, all jewels of gold: and every man that offered [offered] an offering of gold unto the LORD.

willing in the [19 PSA 110 03](#) # Thy people [shall be] willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning: thou hast the dew of thy youth.

willing mind for [13 1CH 28 09](#) # And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.

willing mind it [47 2CO 08 12](#) # For if there be first a willing mind, [it is] accepted according to that a man hath, [and] not according to that he hath not.

willing more abundantly [58 HEB 06 17](#) # Wherein God, willing more abundantly to show unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed [it] by an oath:

willing of themselves [47 2CO 08 03](#) # For to [their] power, I bear record, yea, and beyond [their] power [they were] willing of themselves;

willing offering unto [02 EXO 35 29](#) # The children of Israel brought a willing offering unto the LORD, every man and woman, whose heart made them willing to bring for all manner of work, which the LORD had commanded to be made by the hand of Moses.

willing rather to [47 2CO 05 08](#) # We are confident, [I say], and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

willing remove this [42 LUK 22 42](#) # Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.

willing skilful man [13 1CH 28 21](#) # And, behold, the courses of the priests and the Levites, [even they shall be with thee] for all the service of the house of God: and [there shall be] with thee for all manner of

workmanship every willing skilful man, for any manner of service: also the princes and all the people [will be] wholly at thy commandment.

willing that any [61\\_2PE\\_03\\_09](#) # The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

willing to bring [02\\_EXO\\_35\\_29](#) # The children of Israel brought a willing offering unto the LORD, every man and woman, whose heart made them willing to bring for all manner of work, which the LORD had commanded to be made by the hand of Moses.

willing to communicate [54\\_1TI\\_06\\_18](#) # That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;

willing to consecrate [13\\_1CH\\_29\\_05](#) # The gold for [things] of gold, and the silver for [things] of silver, and for all manner of work [to be made] by the hands of artificers. And who [then] is willing to consecrate his service this day unto the LORD?

willing to content [41\\_MAR\\_15\\_15](#) # And [so] Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged [him], to be crucified.

willing to do [44\\_ACT\\_25\\_09](#) # But Festus, willing to do the Jews a pleasure, answered Paul, and said, Wilt thou go up to Jerusalem, and there be judged of these things before me?

willing to follow [01\\_GEN\\_24\\_05](#) # And the servant said unto him, Peradventure the woman will not be willing to follow me unto this land: must I needs bring thy son again unto the land from whence thou camest?

willing to follow [01\\_GEN\\_24\\_08](#) # And if the woman will not be willing to follow thee, then thou shalt be clear from this my oath: only bring not my son thither again.

willing to have [52\\_1TH\\_02\\_08](#) # So being affectionately desirous of you, we were willing to have imparted unto you, not the gospel of God only, but also our own souls, because ye were dear unto us.

willing to justify [42\\_LUK\\_10\\_29](#) # But he, willing to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbour?

willing to live [58\\_HEB\\_13\\_18](#) # Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly.

willing to make [40\\_MAT\\_01\\_19](#) # Then Joseph her husband, being a just [man], and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her away privily.

willing to release [42\\_LUK\\_23\\_20](#) # Pilate therefore, willing to release Jesus, spake again to them.

willing to save [44\\_ACT\\_27\\_43](#) # But the centurion, willing to save Paul, kept them from [their] purpose; and commanded that they which could swim should cast [themselves] first [into the sea], and get to land:

willing to serve [18\\_JOB\\_39\\_09](#) # Will the unicorn be willing to serve thee, or abide by thy crib?

willing to show [44\\_ACT\\_24\\_27](#) # But after two years Porcius Festus came into Felix' room: and Felix, willing to show the Jews a pleasure, left Paul bound.

willing to show [45\\_ROM\\_09\\_22](#) # [What] if God, willing to show [his] wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction:

willingly after this [13 1CH 29 14](#) # But who [am] I, and what [is] my people, that we should be able to offer so willingly after this sort? for all things [come] of thee, and of thine own have we given thee.

willingly among the [07 JUD 05 09](#) # My heart [is] toward the governors of Israel, that offered themselves willingly among the people. Bless ye the LORD.

willingly are ignorant [61 2PE 03 05](#) # For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:

willingly because with [13 1CH 29 09](#) # Then the people rejoiced, for that they offered willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also rejoiced with great joy.

willingly but by [45 ROM 08 20](#) # For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected [the same] in hope,

willingly for the [15 EZR 07 16](#) # And all the silver and gold that thou canst find in all the province of Babylon, with the freewill offering of the people, and of the priests, offering willingly for the house of their God which [is] in Jerusalem:

willingly give them [07 JUD 08 25](#) # And they answered, We will willingly give [them]. And they spread a garment, and did cast therein every man the earrings of his prey.

willingly I have [46 1CO 09 17](#) # For if I do this thing willingly, I have a reward: but if against my will, a dispensation [of the gospel] is committed unto me.

willingly nor grieve [25 LAM 03 33](#) # For he doth not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men.

willingly not for [60 1PE 05 02](#) # Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight [thereof], not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind;

willingly offered a [15 EZR 03 05](#) # And afterward [offered] the continual burnt offering, both of the new moons, and of all the set feasts of the LORD that were consecrated, and of every one that willingly offered a freewill offering unto the LORD.

willingly offered all [13 1CH 29 17](#) # I know also, my God, that thou triest the heart, and hast pleasure in uprightness. As for me, in the uprightness of mine heart I have willingly offered all these things: and now have I seen with joy thy people, which are present here, to offer willingly unto thee.

willingly offered himself [14 2CH 17 16](#) # And next him [was] Amasiah the son of Zichri, who willingly offered himself unto the LORD; and with him two hundred thousand mighty men of valour.

willingly offered themselves [07 JUD 05 02](#) # Praise ye the LORD for the avenging of Israel, when the people willingly offered themselves.

willingly offered themselves [16 NEH 11 02](#) # And the people blessed all the men, that willingly offered themselves to dwell at Jerusalem.

willingly offered [15 EZR 01 06](#) # And all they that [were] about them strengthened their hands with vessels of silver, with gold, with goods, and with beasts, and with precious things, beside all [that] was willingly offered.

willingly received him [43 JOH 06 21](#) # Then they willingly received him into the ship: and immediately the ship was at the land whither they went.

willingly to the [13 1CH 29 09](#) # Then the people rejoiced, for that they offered willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also rejoiced with great joy.

willingly unto the [14 2CH 35 08](#) # And his princes gave willingly unto the people, to the priests, and to the Levites: Hilkiah and Zechariah and Jehiel, rulers of the house of God, gave unto the priests for the passover offerings two thousand and six hundred [small cattle], and three hundred oxen.

willingly unto thee [13 1CH 29 17](#) # I know also, my God, that thou triest the heart, and hast pleasure in uprightness. willingly walked after [28 HOS 05 11](#) # Ephraim [is] oppressed [and] broken in judgment, because he willingly walked after the commandment.

willingly with her [20 PRO 31 13](#) # She seeketh wool, and flax, and worketh willingly with her hands.

willingly with his [02 EXO 25 02](#) # Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring me an offering: of every man that giveth it willingly with his heart ye shall take my offering.

willingly [13 1CH 29 06](#) # Then the chief of the fathers and princes of the tribes of Israel, and the captains of thousands and of hundreds, with the rulers of the king's work, offered willingly,

willingly [57 PHM 01 14](#) # But without thy mind would I do nothing; that thy benefit should not be as it were of necessity, but willingly.
