wool and flax [20 PRO 31 13](#) # She seeketh wool, and flax, and worketh willingly with her hands.

wool and hyssop [58 HEB 09 19](#) # For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,

wool and my [28 HOS 02 05](#) # For their mother hath played the harlot: she that conceived them hath done shamefully: for she said, I will go after my lovers, that give [me] my bread and my water, my wool and my flax, mine oil and my drink.

wool and my [28 HOS 02 09](#) # Therefore will I return, and take away my corn in the time thereof, and my wine in the season thereof, and will recover my wool and my flax [given] to cover her nakedness.

wool as white [66 REV 01 14](#) # His head and [his] hairs [were] white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes [were] as a flame of fire;

wool but my [23 ISA 51 08](#) # For the moth shall eat them up like a garment, and the worm shall eat them like wool: but my righteousness shall be for ever, and my salvation from generation to generation.

wool he scattereth [19 PSA 147 16](#) # He giveth snow like wool: he scattereth the hoarfrost like ashes.

wool his throne [27 DAN 07 09](#) # I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment [was] white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne [was like] the fiery flame, [and] his wheels [as] burning fire.

wool in the [07 JUD 06 37](#) # Behold, I will put a fleece of wool in the floor; [and] if the dew be on the fleece only, and [it be] dry upon all the earth [beside], then shall I know that thou wilt save Israel by mine hand, as thou hast said.

wool shall come [26 EZE 44 17](#) # And it shall come to pass, [that] when they enter in at the gates of the inner court, they shall be clothed with linen garments; and no wool shall come upon them, whiles they minister in the gates of the inner court, and within.

wool ye kill [26 EZE 34 03](#) # Ye eat the fat, and ye clothe you with the wool, ye kill them that are fed: [but] ye feed not the flock.

wool [12 2KI 03 04](#) # And Mesha king of Moab was a sheepmaster, and rendered unto the king of Israel an hundred thousand lambs, and an hundred thousand rams, with the wool.

wool [26 EZE 27 18](#) # Damascus [was] thy merchant in the multitude of the wares of thy making, for the multitude of all riches; in the wine of Helbon, and white wool.

wool [23 ISA 01 18](#) # Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

woollen and linen [05 DEU 22 11](#) # Thou shalt not wear a garment of divers sorts, [as] of woollen and linen together.

woollen come upon [03 LEV 19 19](#) # Ye shall keep my statutes. Thou shalt not let thy cattle gender with a diverse kind: thou shalt not sow thy field with mingled seed: neither shall a garment mingled of linen and woollen come upon thee.

woollen garment or [03 LEV 13 47](#) # The garment also that the plague of leprosy is in, [whether it be] a woollen garment, or a linen garment;

woollen or in [03 LEV 13 52](#) # He shall therefore burn that garment, whether warp or woof, in woollen or in linen, or any thing of skin, wherein the plague is: for it [is] a fretting leprosy; it shall be burnt in the fire.

woollen or linen [03 LEV 13 59](#) # This [is] the law of the plague of leprosy in a garment of woollen or linen, either in the warp, or woof, or any thing of skins, to pronounce it clean, or to pronounce it unclean.

woollen whether in [03 LEV 13 48](#) # Whether [it be] in the warp, or woof; of linen, or of woollen; whether in a skin, or in any thing made of skin;
