would not hearken [10 2SA 13 14](#) # Howbeit he would not hearken unto her voice: but, being stronger than she, forced her, and lay with her.

would not hearken [10 2SA 13 16](#) # And she said unto him, [There is] no cause: this evil in sending me away [is] greater than the other that thou didst unto me. But he would not hearken unto her.

would not show [06_JOS_05_06](#) # For the children of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness, till all the people [that were] men of war, which came out of Egypt, were consumed, because they obeyed not the voice of the LORD: unto whom the LORD swore that he would not show them the land, which the LORD swore unto their fathers that he would give us, a land that floweth with milk and honey.

would not slay [07_JUD_08_19](#) # And he said, They [were] my brethren, [even] the sons of my mother: [as] the LORD liveth, if ye had saved them alive, I would not slay you.

would [43_JOH_06_11](#) # And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.

would [40_MAT_27_15](#) # Now at [that] feast the governor was wont to release unto the people a prisoner, whom they would.

would [16_NEH_09_24](#) # So the children went in and possessed the land, and thou subduedst before them the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites, and gavest them into their hands, with their kings, and the people of the land, that they might do with them as they would.

wouldest appoint me [18 JOB 14 13](#) # O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave, that thou wouldest keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou wouldest appoint me a set time, and remember me!
