Abdi and Azariah <u>14_2CH_29_12</u> # Then the Levites arose, Mahath the son of Amasai, and Joel the son of Azariah, of the sons of the Kohathites: and of the sons of Merari, Kish the son of Abdi, and Azariah the son of Jehalelel: and of the Gershonites; Joah the son of Zimmah, and Eden the son of Joah:

Abdi and Jeremoth 15_EZR_10_26 # And of the sons of Elam; Mattaniah, Zechariah, and Jehiel, and Abdi, and Jeremoth, and Eliah.

Abdi the son <u>13_1CH_06_44</u># And their brethren the sons of Merari [stood] on the left hand: Ethan the son of Kishi, the son of Abdi, the son of Malluch,

Abdiel the son 13_1CH_05_15# Ahi the son of Abdiel, the son of Guni, chief of the house of their fathers.

Zabdi the Shiphmite 13_1CH_27_27 # And over the vineyards [was] Shimei the Ramathite: over the increase of the vineyards for the wine cellars [was] Zabdi the Shiphmite:

Zabdi the son <u>06_JOS_07_01</u># But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel.

Zabdi the son <u>06_JOS_07_18</u># And he brought his household man by man; and Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, was taken.

Zabdi the son <u>16_NEH_11_17</u># And Mattaniah the son of Micha, the son of Zabdi, the son of Asaph, [was] the principal to begin the thanksgiving in prayer: and Bakbukiah the second among his brethren, and Abda the son of Shammua, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun.

Zabdi was taken <u>06_JOS_07_17</u> # And he brought the family of Judah; and he took the family of the Zarhites: and he brought the family of the Zarhites man by man; and Zabdi was taken:

Zabdi 13_1CH_08_19 # And Jakim, and Zichri, and Zabdi,

Zabdiel and in <u>13_1CH_27_02</u> # Over the first course for the first month [was] Jashobeam the son of Zabdiel: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

Zabdiel the son <u>16_NEH_11_14</u># And their brethren, mighty men of valour, an hundred twenty and eight: and their overseer [was] Zabdiel, the son of [one of] the great men.
