Abia and Abia <u>40_MAT_01_07</u># And Solomon begat Roboam; and Roboam begat Abia; and Abia begat Asa;

Abia and his <u>42_LUK_01_05</u> # There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judaea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the course of Abia: and his wife [was] of the daughters of Aaron, and her name [was] Elisabeth.

Abia begat Asa <u>40_MAT_01_07</u># And Solomon begat Roboam; and Roboam begat Abia; and Abia begat Asa;

Abia his son <u>13_1CH_03_10</u> # And Solomon's son [was] Rehoboam, Abia his son, Asa his son, Jehoshaphat his son,

Abiah and Anathoth <u>13_1CH_07_08</u># And the sons of Becher; Zemira, and Joash, and Eliezer, and Elioenai, and Omri, and Jerimoth, and Abiah, and Anathoth, and Alameth. All these [are] the sons of Becher.

Abiah Hezron's wife <u>13_1CH_02_24</u># And after that Hezron was dead in Calebephratah, then Abiah Hezron's wife bare him Ashur the father of Tekoa.

Abiah they were <u>09_1SA_08_02</u> # Now the name of his firstborn was Joel; and the name of his second, Abiah: [they were] judges in Beersheba.

Abiah <u>13_1CH_06_28</u> # And the sons of Samuel; the firstborn Vashni, and Abiah.

Abialbon the Arbathite <u>10_2SA_23_31</u> # Abialbon the Arbathite, Azmaveth the Barhumite,

Abiasaph these are <u>02_EXO_06_24</u> # And the sons of Korah; Assir, and Elkanah, and Abiasaph: these [are] the families of the Korhites.

Abiathar and before <u>13_1CH_24_06</u># And Shemaiah the son of Nethaneel the scribe, [one] of the Levites, wrote them before the king, and the princes, and Zadok the priest, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, and [before] the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites: one principal household being taken for Eleazar, and [one] taken for Ithamar.

Abiathar and the <u>13_1CH_27_34</u># And after Ahithophel [was] Jehoiada the son of Benaiah, and Abiathar: and the general of the king's army [was] Joab.

Abiathar brought thither <u>09_1SA_30_07</u># And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David.

Abiathar carried the <u>10_2SA_15_29</u># Zadok therefore and Abiathar carried the ark of God again to Jerusalem: and they tarried there.

Abiathar escaped and <u>09_18A_22_20</u># And one of the sons of Ahimelech the son of Ahitub, named Abiathar, escaped, and fled after David.

Abiathar from being <u>11_1KI_02_27</u># So Solomon thrust out Abiathar from being priest unto the LORD;

that he might fulfil the word of the LORD, which he spake concerning the house of Eli in Shiloh.

Abiathar I knew <u>09_1SA_22_22</u># And David said unto Abiathar, I knew [it] that day, when Doeg the Edomite [was] there, that he would surely tell Saul: I have occasioned [the death] of all the persons of thy father's house.

Abiathar showed David <u>09_18A_22_21</u># And Abiathar showed David that Saul had slain the LORD'S priests.

Abiathar the high <u>41_MAR_02_26</u> # How he went into the house of God in the days of Abiathar the high priest, and did eat the showbread, which is not lawful to eat but for the priests, and gave also to them which were with him?

Abiathar the priest <u>11_1KI_01_07</u># And he conferred with Joab the son of Zeruiah, and with Abiathar the priest: and they following Adonijah helped [him].

Abiathar the priest <u>11_1KI_01_19</u># And he hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the sons of the king, and Abiathar the priest, and Joab the captain of the host: but Solomon thy servant hath he not called.

Abiathar the priest <u>11_1KI_01_25</u># For he is gone down this day, and hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the king's sons, and the captains of the host, and Abiathar the priest; and, behold, they eat and drink before him, and say, God save king Adonijah.

Abiathar the priest <u>11_1KI_01_42</u># And while he yet spake, behold, Jonathan the son of Abiathar the priest came: and Adonijah said unto him, Come in; for thou [art] a valiant man, and bringest good tidings.

Abiathar the priest <u>11_1KI_02_22</u># And king Solomon answered and said unto his mother, And why dost thou ask Abishag the Shunammite for Adonijah? ask for him the kingdom also; for he [is] mine elder brother; even for him, and for Abiathar the priest, and for Joab the son of Zeruiah.

Abiathar the son <u>09_1SA_23_06</u># And it came to pass, when Abiathar the son of Ahimelech fled to David to Keilah, [that] he came down [with] an ephod in his hand.

Abiathar went up <u>10_2SA_15_24</u> # And lo Zadok also, and all the Levites [were] with him, bearing the ark of the covenant of God: and they set down the ark of God; and Abiathar went up, until all the people had done passing out of the city.

Abiathar were the <u>13_1CH_18_16</u># And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Abimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Shavsha was scribe;

Abiathar were the <u>11_1KI_04_04</u># And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada [was] over the host: and Zadok and Abiathar [were] the priests:

Abiathar were the <u>10_2SA_08_17</u># And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Seraiah [was] the scribe;

Abiathar were the <u>10_2SA_20_25</u> # And Sheva [was] scribe: and Zadok and Abiathar [were] the priests:

Abiathar <u>11_1KI_02_35</u># And the king put Benaiah the son of Jehoiada in his room over the host: and Zadok the priest did the king put in the room of Abiathar.

Abiathar <u>10_2SA_15_27</u> # The king said also unto Zadok the priest, [Art not] thou a seer? return into the city in peace, and your two sons with you, Ahimaaz thy son, and Jonathan the son of Abiathar.

Arabia and returned <u>48_GAL_01_17</u> # Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus.

Hashabiah and with <u>15_EZR_08_19</u># And Hashabiah, and with him Jeshaiah of the sons of Merari, his brethren and their sons, twenty;

Hashabiah he his <u>13_1CH_25_19</u># The twelfth to Hashabiah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:

Hashabiah of the <u>13_1CH_09_14</u># And of the Levites; Shemaiah the son of Hasshub, the son of Azrikam, the son of Hashabiah, of the sons of Merari;

Hashabiah the ruler <u>16_NEH_03_17</u># After him repaired the Levites, Rehum the son of Bani. Next unto him repaired Hashabiah, the ruler of the half part of Keilah, in his part.

Hashabiah the son 13_1CH_06_45 # The son of Hashabiah, the son of Amaziah, the son of Hilkiah,

Hashabiah the son <u>13_1CH_27_17</u># Of the Levites, Hashabiah the son of Kemuel: of the Aaronites, Zadok:

Hashabiah the son <u>16_NEH_11_15</u># Also of the Levites: Shemaiah the son of Hashub, the son of Azrikam, the son of Bunni;

Hashabiah the son <u>16_NEH_11_22</u># The overseer also of the Levites at Jerusalem [was] Uzzi the son of Bani, the son of Hashabiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Micha. Of the sons of Asaph, the singers [were] over the business of the house of God.

Hashabiah <u>16_NEH_10_11</u># Micha, Rehob, Hashabiah,

Nedabiah <u>13_1CH_03_18</u># Malchiram also, and Pedaiah, and Shenazar, Jecamiah, Hoshama, and Nedabiah.

Rehabiah his son <u>13_1CH_26_25</u> # And his brethren by Eliezer; Rehabiah his son, and Jeshaiah his son, and Joram his son, and Zichri his son, and Shelomith his son.

Rehabiah of the <u>13_1CH_24_21</u> # Concerning Rehabiah: of the sons of Rehabiah, the first [was] Isshiah.

Rehabiah the chief <u>13_1CH_23_17</u># And the sons of Eliezer [were], Rehabiah the chief. And Eliezer had none other sons; but the sons of Rehabiah were very many.
