Abijah and Attai [14 2CH 11 20](#) # And after her he took Maachah the daughter of Absalom; which bare him Abijah, and Attai, and Ziza, and Shelomith.

Abijah and his [14 2CH 13 17](#) # And Abijah and his people slew them with a great slaughter: so there fell down slain of Israel five hundred thousand chosen men.

Abijah and his [14 2CH 13 22](#) # And the rest of the acts of Abijah, and his ways, and his sayings, [are] written in the story of the prophet Iddo.

Abijah and Jeroboam [14 2CH 13 02](#) # He reigned three years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Michaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. And there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.

Abijah and Judah [14 2CH 13 15](#) # Then the men of Judah gave a shout: and as the men of Judah shouted, it came to pass, that God smote Jeroboam and all Israel before Abijah and Judah.

Abijah and the [14 2CH 13 20](#) # Neither did Jeroboam recover strength again in the days of Abijah: and the LORD struck him, and he died.

Abijah his son [14 2CH 12 16](#) # And Rehoboam slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David: and Abijah his son reigned in his stead.

Abijah Mijamin [16 NEH 10 07](#) # Meshullam, Abijah, Mijamin,

Abijah pursued after [14 2CH 13 19](#) # And Abijah pursued after Jeroboam, and took cities from him, Bethel with the towns thereof, and Jeshanah with the towns thereof, and Ephraim with the towns thereof.

Abijah set the [14 2CH 13 03](#) # And Abijah set the battle in array with an army of valiant men of war, [even] four hundred thousand chosen men: Jeroboam also set the battle in array against him with eight hundred thousand chosen men, [being] mighty men of valour.

Abijah slept with [14 2CH 14 01](#) # So Abijah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and Asa his son reigned in his stead. In his days the land was quiet ten years.

Abijah stood up [14 2CH 13 04](#) # And Abijah stood up upon mount Zemaraim, which [is] in mount Ephraim, and said, Hear me, thou Jeroboam, and all Israel;

Abijah the daughter [14 2CH 29 01](#) # Hezekiah began to reign [when he was] five and twenty years old, and he reigned nine and twenty years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Abijah, the daughter of Zechariah.

Abijah the son [11 1KI 14 01](#) # At that time Abijah the son of Jeroboam fell sick.

Abijah the son [14 2CH 11 22](#) # And Rehoboam made Abijah the son of Maachah the chief, [to be] ruler among his brethren: for [he thought] to make him king.

Abijah to reign [14 2CH 13 01](#) # Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam began Abijah to reign over Judah.

Abijah waxed mighty [14 2CH 13 21](#) # But Abijah waxed mighty, and married fourteen wives, and begat twenty and two sons, and sixteen daughters.
