ability and straightway [40 MAT 25 15](#) # And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

ability determined to [44 ACT 11 29](#) # Then the disciples, every man according to his ability, determined to send relief unto the brethren which dwelt in Judaea:

ability have redeemed [16 NEH 05 08](#) # And I said unto them, We after our ability have redeemed our brethren the Jews, which were sold unto the heathen; and will ye even sell your brethren? or shall they be sold unto us? Then held they their peace, and found nothing [to answer].

ability in them [27 DAN 01 04](#) # Children in whom [was] no blemish, but well favoured, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as [had] ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans.

ability that vowed [03 LEV 27 08](#) # But if he be poorer than thy estimation, then he shall present himself before the priest, and the priest shall value him; according to his ability that vowed shall the priest value him.

ability unto the [15 EZR 02 69](#) # They gave after their ability unto the treasure of the work threescore and one thousand drams of gold, and five thousand pound of silver, and one hundred priests' garments.

ability which God [60 1PE 04 11](#) # If any man speak, [let him speak] as the oracles of God; if any man minister, [let him do it] as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

immutability of his [58 HEB 06 17](#) # Wherein God, willing more abundantly to show unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed [it] by an oath:
