Abner was beaten <u>10_2SA_02_17</u># And there was a very sore battle that day; and Abner was beaten, and the men of Israel, before the servants of David.

Abner was dead <u>10_2SA_04_01</u># And when Saul's son heard that Abner was dead in Hebron, his hands were feeble, and all the Israelites were troubled.
