accept an offering <u>09\_1SA\_26\_19</u># Now therefore, I pray thee, let my lord the king hear the words of his servant. If the LORD have stirred thee up against me, let him accept an offering: but if [they be] the children of men, cursed [be] they before the LORD; for they have driven me out this day from abiding in the inheritance of the LORD, saying, Go, serve other gods.

accept an offering 39 MAL\_01\_10 # Who [is there] even among you that would shut the doors [for nought]? neither do ye kindle [fire] on mine altar for nought. I have no pleasure in you, saith the LORD of hosts, neither will I accept an offering at your hand.

accept any man's <u>18\_JOB\_32\_21</u># Let me not, I pray you, accept any man's person, neither let me give flattering titles unto man.

accept his person 18\_JOB\_13\_08 # Will ye accept his person? will ye contend for God?

Accept I beseech 19\_PSA\_119\_108# Accept, I beseech thee, the freewill offerings of my mouth, O LORD, and teach me thy judgments.

accept it always <u>44\_ACT\_24\_03</u># We accept [it] always, and in all places, most noble Felix, with all thankfulness.

accept lest I <u>18 JOB\_42\_08</u># Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you [after your] folly, in that ye have not spoken of me [the thing which is] right, like my servant Job.

accept of me <u>01\_GEN\_32\_20</u># And say ye moreover, Behold, thy servant Jacob [is] behind us. For he said, I will appease him with the present that goeth before me, and afterward I will see his face; peradventure he will accept of me.

accept of the <u>03\_LEV\_26\_41</u> # And [that] I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity:

accept of the <u>03\_LEV\_26\_43</u># The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised my judgments, and because their soul abhorred my statutes.

accept persons 18\_JOB\_13\_10 # He will surely reprove you, if ye do secretly accept persons.

accept the person 20\_PRO\_18\_05 # [It is] not good to accept the person of the wicked, to overthrow the righteous in judgment.

accept the persons <u>19\_PSA\_82\_02</u># How long will ye judge unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked? Selah.

accept the work <u>05\_DEU\_33\_11</u># Bless, LORD, his substance, and accept the work of his hands: smite through the loins of them that rise against him, and of them that hate him, that they rise not again.

accept thee <u>10\_2SA\_24\_23</u># All these [things] did Araunah, [as] a king, give unto the king. And Araunah said unto the king, The LORD thy God accept thee.

accept them and <u>26\_EZE\_20\_40</u># For in mine holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, there shall all the house of Israel, all of them in the land, serve me: there will I accept them, and there will I require your offerings, and the firstfruits of your oblations, with all your holy things.

accept them but 24 JER\_14\_12 # When they fast, I will not hear their cry; and when they offer burnt offering and an oblation, I will not accept them: but I will consume them by the sword, and by the famine, and by the pestilence.

accept them he <u>24\_JER\_14\_10</u># Thus saith the LORD unto this people, Thus have they loved to wander, they have not refrained their feet, therefore the LORD doth not accept them; he will now remember their iniquity, and visit their sins.

accept them neither 30\_AMO\_05\_22 # Though ye offer me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept [them]: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts.

accept thereof and <u>02\_EXO\_22\_11</u># [Then] shall an oath of the LORD be between them both, that he hath not put his hand unto his neighbour's goods; and the owner of it shall accept [thereof], and he shall not make [it] good.

accept this of <u>39\_MAL\_01\_13</u> # Ye said also, Behold, what a weariness [is it]! and ye have snuffed at it, saith the LORD of hosts; and ye brought [that which was] torn, and the lame, and the sick; thus ye brought an offering: should I accept this of your hand? saith the LORD.

accept thy burnt 19\_PSA\_20\_03 # Remember all thy offerings, and accept thy burnt sacrifice; Selah.

accept thy person 39\_MAL\_01\_08 # And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, [is it] not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, [is it] not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.

accept you saith <u>26\_EZE\_43\_27</u> # And when these days are expired, it shall be, [that] upon the eighth day, and [so] forward, the priests shall make your burnt offerings upon the altar, and your peace offerings; and I will accept you, saith the Lord GOD.

accept you with <u>26\_EZE\_20\_41</u># I will accept you with your sweet savour, when I bring you out from the people, and gather you out of the countries wherein ye have been scattered; and I will be sanctified in you before the heathen.

acceptable and perfect 45\_ROM\_12\_02 # And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

acceptable before God <u>54\_1TI\_05\_04</u># But if any widow have children or nephews, let them learn first to show piety at home, and to requite their parents: for that is good and acceptable before God.

acceptable being sanctified <u>45\_ROM\_15\_16</u> # That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.

acceptable but the <u>20\_PRO\_10\_32</u># The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable: but the mouth of the wicked [speaketh] frowardness.

acceptable day to 23\_ISA\_58\_05# Is it such a fast that I have chosen? a day for a man to afflict his soul? [is it] to bow down his head as a bulrush, and to spread sackcloth and ashes [under him]? wilt thou call this a

fast, and an acceptable day to the LORD?

acceptable for you <u>03\_LEV\_22\_20</u># [But] whatsoever hath a blemish, [that] shall ye not offer: for it shall not be acceptable for you.

acceptable in the 54\_1TI\_02\_03 # For this [is] good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;

acceptable in thy 19\_PSA\_19\_14 # Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.

acceptable nor your <u>24\_JER\_06\_20</u> # To what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, and the sweet cane from a far country? your burnt offerings [are] not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me.

acceptable time have <u>23\_ISA\_49\_08</u> # Thus saith the LORD, In an acceptable time have I heard thee, and in a day of salvation have I helped thee: and I will preserve thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages;

acceptable time O 19\_PSA\_69\_13 # But as for me, my prayer [is] unto thee, O LORD, [in] an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the truth of thy salvation.

acceptable to God <u>60\_1PE\_02\_05</u># Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.

acceptable to God <u>45\_ROM\_14\_18</u># For he that in these things serveth Christ [is] acceptable to God, and approved of men.

acceptable to his <u>05\_DEU\_33\_24</u> # And of Asher he said, [Let] Asher [be] blessed with children; let him be acceptable to his brethren, and let him dip his foot in oil.

acceptable to the <u>20\_PRO\_21\_03</u># To do justice and judgment [is] more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.

acceptable unto God <u>45\_ROM\_12\_01</u># I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, [which is] your reasonable service.

acceptable unto the 49\_EPH\_05\_10 # Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.

acceptable unto thee <u>27\_DAN\_04\_27</u># Wherefore, O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by showing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of thy tranquillity.

acceptable wellpleasing to <u>50\_PHP\_04\_18</u> # But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things [which were sent] from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.

acceptable with God 60\_1PE\_02\_20 # For what glory [is it], if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer [for it], ye take it patiently, this [is] acceptable with God.

acceptable words and <u>21\_ECC\_12\_10</u> # The preacher sought to find out acceptable words: and [that which was] written [was] upright, [even] words of truth.

acceptable year of <a href="mailto:23\_ISA\_61\_02">23\_ISA\_61\_02</a> # To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

acceptable year of 42\_LUK\_04\_19 # To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

acceptably with reverence <u>58\_HEB\_12\_28</u> # Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:

acceptance on mine <u>23\_ISA\_60\_07</u># All the flocks of Kedar shall be gathered together unto thee, the rams of Nebaioth shall minister unto thee: they shall come up with acceptance on mine altar, and I will glorify the house of my glory.

acceptation that Christ <u>54\_1TI\_01\_15</u># This [is] a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

acceptation 54\_1TI\_04\_09 # This [is] a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptation.

accepted according to <u>47\_2CO\_08\_12</u> # For if there be first a willing mind, [it is] accepted according to that a man hath, [and] not according to that he hath not.

accepted and if <u>01\_GEN\_04\_07</u> # If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee [shall be] his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.

accepted and in <u>47\_2CO\_06\_02</u> # [For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now [is] the accepted time; behold, now [is] the day of salvation.]

accepted before the <u>02\_EXO\_28\_38</u># And it shall be upon Aaron's forehead, that Aaron may bear the iniquity of the holy things, which the children of Israel shall hallow in all their holy gifts; and it shall be always upon his forehead, that they may be accepted before the LORD.

accepted before thee <u>24\_JER\_37\_20</u># Therefore hear now, I pray thee, O my lord the king: let my supplication, I pray thee, be accepted before thee; that thou cause me not to return to the house of Jonathan the scribe, lest I die there.

accepted before thee <u>24\_JER\_42\_02</u># And said unto Jeremiah the prophet, Let, we beseech thee, our supplication be accepted before thee, and pray for us unto the LORD thy God, [even] for all this remnant; [for we are left [but] a few of many, as thine eyes do behold us:]

accepted for an <u>03\_LEV\_22\_27</u># When a bullock, or a sheep, or a goat, is brought forth, then it shall be seven days under the dam; and from the eighth day and thenceforth it shall be accepted for an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

accepted for him <u>03\_LEV\_01\_04</u> # And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him.

accepted for you <u>03\_LEV\_22\_25</u> # Neither from a stranger's hand shall ye offer the bread of your God of any of these; because their corruption [is] in them, [and] blemishes [be] in them: they shall not be accepted for you.

accepted for you <u>03\_LEV\_23\_11</u> # And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.

accepted in his <u>42\_LUK\_04\_24</u># And he said, Verily, I say unto you, No prophet is accepted in his own country.

accepted in the <u>09\_1SA\_18\_05</u># And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

accepted in the <u>49\_EPH\_01\_06</u> # To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.

accepted in the <u>03\_LEV\_10\_19</u># And Aaron said unto Moses, Behold, this day have they offered their sin offering and their burnt offering before the LORD; and such things have befallen me: and [if] I had eaten the sin offering to day, should it have been accepted in the sight of the LORD?

accepted Job <u>18\_JOB\_42\_09</u> # So Eliphaz the Temanite and Bildad the Shuhite [and] Zophar the Naamathite went, and did according as the LORD commanded them: the LORD also accepted Job.

accepted neither shall <u>03\_LEV\_07\_18</u># And if [any] of the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings be eaten at all on the third day, it shall not be accepted, neither shall it be imputed unto him that offereth it: it shall be an abomination, and the soul that eateth of it shall bear his iniquity.

accepted of him <u>47\_2CO\_05\_09</u> # Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him.

accepted of the <a href="I7\_EST\_10\_03">I7\_EST\_10\_03</a> # For Mordecai the Jew [was] next unto king Ahasuerus, and great among the Jews, and accepted of the multitude of his brethren, seeking the wealth of his people, and speaking peace to all his seed.

accepted of the <u>45\_ROM\_15\_31</u> # That I may be delivered from them that do not believe in Judaea; and that my service which [I have] for Jerusalem may be accepted of the saints;

accepted the exhortation <u>47\_2CO\_08\_17</u> # For indeed he accepted the exhortation; but being more forward, of his own accord he went unto you.

accepted thee concerning <u>01\_GEN\_19\_21</u># And he said unto him, See, I have accepted thee concerning this thing also, that I will not overthrow this city, for the which thou hast spoken.

accepted there shall <u>03\_LEV\_22\_21</u> # And whosoever offereth a sacrifice of peace offerings unto the LORD to accomplish [his] vow, or a freewill offering in beeves or sheep, it shall be perfect to be accepted; there shall be no blemish therein.

accepted thy person <u>09\_1SA\_25\_35</u># So David received of her hand [that] which she had brought him, and said unto her, Go up in peace to thine house; see, I have hearkened to thy voice, and have accepted thy person.

accepted time behold <u>47\_2CO\_06\_02</u> # [For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now [is] the accepted time; behold, now [is] the day of salvation.]

accepted upon mine <u>23\_ISA\_56\_07</u># Even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices [shall be] accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people.

accepted with him <u>44\_ACT\_10\_35</u># But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him.

accepted ye might <u>47\_2CO\_11\_04</u># For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or [if] ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with [him].

accepted <u>03\_LEV\_19\_07</u> # And if it be eaten at all on the third day, it [is] abominable; it shall not be accepted.

accepted <u>03\_LEV\_22\_23</u> # Either a bullock or a lamb that hath any thing superfluous or lacking in his parts, that mayest thou offer [for] a freewill offering; but for a vow it shall not be accepted.

acceptest thou the <u>42\_LUK\_20\_21</u># And they asked him, saying, Master, we know that thou sayest and teachest rightly, neither acceptest thou the person [of any], but teachest the way of God truly:

accepteth no man's <u>48\_GAL\_02\_06</u># But of these who seemed to be somewhat, [whatsoever they were, it maketh no matter to me: God accepteth no man's person:] for they who seemed [to be somewhat] in conference added nothing to me:

accepteth not the <u>18\_JOB\_34\_19</u> # [How much less to him] that accepteth not the persons of princes, nor regardeth the rich more than the poor? for they all [are] the work of his hands.

accepteth them not <u>28\_HOS\_08\_13</u> # They sacrifice flesh [for] the sacrifices of mine offerings, and eat [it; but] the LORD accepteth them not; now will he remember their iniquity, and visit their sins: they shall return to Egypt.

accepteth thy works 21\_ECC\_09\_07 # Go thy way, eat thy bread with joy, and drink thy wine with a merry heart; for God now accepteth thy works.

accepting deliverance that <u>58\_HEB\_11\_35</u># Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:
