Achish answered and <u>09_1SA_29_09</u># And Achish answered and said to David, I know that thou [art] good in my sight, as an angel of God: notwithstanding the princes of the Philistines have said, He shall not go up with us to the battle.

Achish at Gath <u>09_1SA_27_03</u># And David dwelt with Achish at Gath, he and his men, every man with his household, [even] David with his two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the Carmelitess, Nabal's wife.

Achish believed David <u>09_1SA_27_12</u> # And Achish believed David, saying, He hath made his people Israel utterly to abhor him; therefore he shall be my servant for ever.

Achish son of 11_1KI_02_39 # And it came to pass at the end of three years, that two of the servants of

Shimei ran away unto Achish son of Maachah king of Gath. And they told Shimei, saying, Behold, thy servants [be] in Gath.

Achish Surely thou <u>09_18A_28_02</u> # And David said to Achish, Surely thou shalt know what thy servant can do. And Achish said to David, Therefore will I make thee keeper of mine head for ever.

Achish the king <u>09_1SA_21_10</u># And David arose, and fled that day for fear of Saul, and went to Achish the king of Gath.

Achish the king <u>09_1SA_21_12</u># And David laid up these words in his heart, and was sore afraid of Achish the king of Gath.

Achish the son <u>09_18A_27_02</u> # And David arose, and he passed over with the six hundred men that [were] with him unto Achish, the son of Maoch, king of Gath.

Achish to seek <u>11_1KI_02_40</u># And Shimei arose, and saddled his ass, and went to Gath to Achish to seek his servants: and Shimei went, and brought his servants from Gath.

Achish unto his <u>09_1SA_21_14</u> # Then said Achish unto his servants, Lo, ye see the man is mad: wherefore [then] have ye brought him to me?

Lachish and the 16 NEH 11 30 # Zanoah, Adullam, and [in] their villages, at Lachish, and the fields thereof, at Azekah, and [in] the villages thereof. And they dwelt from Beersheba unto the valley of Hinnom.
