ague that shall <u>03_LEV_26_16</u># I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and ye shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.

league between me <u>11_1KI_15_19</u># [There is] a league between me and thee, [and] between my father and thy father: behold, I have sent unto thee a present of silver and gold; come and break thy league with Baasha king of Israel, that he may depart from me.

league between me <u>14_2CH_16_03</u># [There is] a league between me and thee, as [there was] between my father and thy father: behold, I have sent thee silver and gold; go, break thy league with Baasha king of Israel, that he may depart from me.

league made with <u>27_DAN_11_23</u># And after the league [made] with him he shall work deceitfully: for he shall come up, and shall become strong with a small people.

league shall fall <u>26_EZE_30_05</u># Ethiopia, and Libya, and Lydia, and all the mingled people, and Chub, and the men of the land that is in league, shall fall with them by the sword.

league together <u>11_1KI_05_12</u># And the LORD gave Solomon wisdom, as he promised him: and there was peace between Hiram and Solomon; and they two made a league together.

league with Baasha <u>11_1KI_15_19</u># [There is] a league between me and thee, [and] between my father and thy father: behold, I have sent unto thee a present of silver and gold; come and break thy league with Baasha king of Israel, that he may depart from me.

league with Baasha <u>14_2CH_16_03</u># [There is] a league between me and thee, as [there was] between my father and thy father: behold, I have sent thee silver and gold; go, break thy league with Baasha king of Israel, that he may depart from me.

league with me <u>10_2SA_03_12</u> # And Abner sent messengers to David on his behalf, saying, Whose [is] the land? saying [also], Make thy league with me, and, behold, my hand [shall be] with thee, to bring about all Israel unto thee.

league with the <u>09_1SA_22_08</u> # That all of you have conspired against me, and [there is] none that showeth me that my son hath made a league with the son of Jesse, and [there is] none of you that is sorry for me, or showeth unto me that my son hath stirred up my servant against me, to lie in wait, as at this day?

league with the <u>18_JOB_05_23</u># For thou shalt be in league with the stones of the field: and the beasts of the field shall be at peace with thee.

league with the <u>07_JUD_02_02</u> # And ye shall make no league with the inhabitants of this land; ye shall throw down their altars: but ye have not obeyed my voice: why have ye done this?

league with thee <u>10_2SA_03_13</u> # And he said, Well; I will make a league with thee: but one thing I require of thee, that is, Thou shalt not see my face, except thou first bring Michal Saul's daughter, when thou comest to see my face.

league with thee <u>10_2SA_03_21</u> # And Abner said unto David, I will arise and go, and will gather all Israel

unto my lord the king, that they may make a league with thee, and that thou mayest reign over all that thine heart desireth. And David sent Abner away; and he went in peace.

league with them <u>10_2SA_05_03</u> # So all the elders of Israel came to the king to Hebron; and king David made a league with them in Hebron before the LORD: and they anointed David king over Israel.

league with them <u>06_JOS_09_15</u> # And Joshua made peace with them, and made a league with them, to let them live: and the princes of the congregation sware unto them.

league with them <u>06_JOS_09_16</u># And it came to pass at the end of three days after they had made a league with them, that they heard that they [were] their neighbours, and [that] they dwelt among them.

league with us <u>06_JOS_09_06</u> # And they went to Joshua unto the camp at Gilgal, and said unto him, and to the men of Israel, We be come from a far country: now therefore make ye a league with us.

league with us <u>06_JOS_09_11</u> # Wherefore our elders and all the inhabitants of our country spake to us, saying, Take victuals with you for the journey, and go to meet them, and say unto them, We [are] your servants: therefore now make ye a league with us.

league with you <u>06_JOS_09_07</u># And the men of Israel said unto the Hivites, Peradventure ye dwell among us; and how shall we make a league with you?

plague after that <u>03_LEV_13_55</u> # And the priest shall look on the plague, after that it is washed: and, behold, [if] the plague have not changed his colour, and the plague be not spread; it [is] unclean; thou shalt burn it in the fire; it [is] fret inward, [whether] it [be] bare within or without.

plague among the <u>04_NUM_08_19</u> # And I have given the Levites [as] a gift to Aaron and to his sons from among the children of Israel, to do the service of the children of Israel in the tabernacle of the congregation, and to make an atonement for the children of Israel: that there be no plague among the children of Israel, when the children of Israel come nigh unto the sanctuary.

plague among the <u>04_NUM_31_16</u> # Behold, these caused the children of Israel, through the counsel of Balaam, to commit trespass against the LORD in the matter of Peor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the LORD.

plague among them <u>02_EXO_30_12</u># When thou takest the sum of the children of Israel after their number, then shall they give every man a ransom for his soul unto the LORD, when thou numberest them; that there be no plague among them, when [thou] numberest them.

plague and behold <u>03_LEV_13_30</u> # Then the priest shall see the plague: and, behold, if it [be] in sight deeper than the skin; [and there be] in it a yellow thin hair; then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a dry scall, [even] a leprosy upon the head or beard.

plague and behold <u>03_LEV_13_32</u># And in the seventh day the priest shall look on the plague: and, behold, [if] the scall spread not, and there be in it no yellow hair, and the scall [be] not in sight deeper than the skin;

plague and behold <u>03_LEV_14_37</u> # And he shall look on the plague, and, behold, [if] the plague [be] in the walls of the house with hollow streaks, greenish or reddish, which in sight [are] lower than the wall;

plague and shut <u>03_LEV_13_50</u> # And the priest shall look upon the plague, and shut up [it that hath] the plague seven days:

plague be departed <u>03_LEV_13_58</u># And the garment, either warp, or woof, or whatsoever thing of skin [it be], which thou shalt wash, if the plague be departed from them, then it shall be washed the second time, and shall be clean.

plague be greenish <u>03_LEV_13_49</u> # And if the plague be greenish or reddish in the garment, or in the skin, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in any thing of skin; it [is] a plague of leprosy, and shall be showed unto the priest:

plague be in <u>03_LEV_14_37</u> # And he shall look on the plague, and, behold, [if] the plague [be] in the walls of the house with hollow streaks, greenish or reddish, which in sight [are] lower than the wall;

plague be not <u>03_LEV_13_53</u> # And if the priest shall look, and, behold, the plague be not spread in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in any thing of skin;

plague be not <u>03_LEV_13_55</u> # And the priest shall look on the plague, after that it is washed: and, behold, [if] the plague have not changed his colour, and the plague be not spread; it [is] unclean; thou shalt burn it in the fire; it [is] fret inward, [whether] it [be] bare within or without.

plague be somewhat <u>03_LEV_13_06</u> # And the priest shall look on him again the seventh day: and, behold, [if] the plague [be] somewhat dark, [and] the plague spread not in the skin, the priest shall pronounce him clean: it [is but] a scab: and he shall wash his clothes, and be clean.

plague be somewhat <u>03_LEV_13_56</u># And if the priest look, and, behold, the plague [be] somewhat dark after the washing of it; then he shall rend it out of the garment, or out of the skin, or out of the warp, or out of the woof:

plague be spread <u>03_LEV_13_51</u> # And he shall look on the plague on the seventh day: if the plague be spread in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in a skin, [or] in any work that is made of skin; the plague [is] a fretting leprosy; it [is] unclean.

plague be spread <u>03_LEV_14_39</u> # And the priest shall come again the seventh day, and shall look: and, behold, [if] the plague be spread in the walls of the house;

plague be spread <u>03_LEV_14_44</u> # Then the priest shall come and look, and, behold, [if] the plague be spread in the house, it [is] a fretting leprosy in the house: it [is] unclean.

plague be turned <u>03_LEV_13_17</u># And the priest shall see him: and, behold, [if] the plague be turned into white; then the priest shall pronounce [him] clean [that hath] the plague: he [is] clean.

plague before the <u>04_NUM_14_37</u># Even those men that did bring up the evil report upon the land, died by the plague before the LORD.

plague brake in <u>19_PSA_106_29</u># Thus they provoked [him] to anger with their inventions: and the plague brake in upon them.

plague come again <u>03_LEV_14_43</u> # And if the plague come again, and break out in the house, after that he hath taken away the stones, and after he hath scraped the house, and after it is plastered;

plague come nigh <u>19_PSA_91_10</u># There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

plague for Peor's <u>04_NUM_25_18</u># For they vex you with their wiles, wherewith they have beguiled you in the matter of Peor, and in the matter of Cozbi, the daughter of a prince of Midian, their sister, which was slain in the day of the plague for Peor's sake.

plague from his <u>03_LEV_13_12</u> # And if a leprosy break out abroad in the skin, and the leprosy cover all the skin of [him that hath] the plague from his head even to his foot, wheresoever the priest looketh;

plague hath not <u>03_LEV_14_48</u> # And if the priest shall come in, and look [upon it], and, behold, the plague hath not spread in the house, after the house was plastered: then the priest shall pronounce the house clean, because the plague is healed.

plague have not <u>03_LEV_13_55</u> # And the priest shall look on the plague, after that it is washed: and, behold, [if] the plague have not changed his colour, and the plague be not spread; it [is] unclean; thou shalt burn it in the fire; it [is] fret inward, [whether] it [be] bare within or without.

plague he is <u>03_LEV_13_17</u># And the priest shall see him: and, behold, [if] the plague be turned into white; then the priest shall pronounce [him] clean [that hath] the plague: he [is] clean.

plague in his <u>03_LEV_13_05</u> # And the priest shall look on him the seventh day: and, behold, [if] the plague in his sight be at a stay, [and] the plague spread not in the skin; then the priest shall shut him up seven days more:

plague in sight <u>03_LEV_13_03</u> # And the priest shall look on the plague in the skin of the flesh: and [when] the hair in the plague is turned white, and the plague in sight [be] deeper than the skin of his flesh, it [is] a plague of leprosy: and the priest shall look on him, and pronounce him unclean.

plague in the <u>06_JOS_22_17</u> # [Is] the iniquity of Peor too little for us, from which we are not cleansed until this day, although there was a plague in the congregation of the LORD,

plague in the <u>03_LEV_13_03</u># And the priest shall look on the plague in the skin of the flesh: and [when] the hair in the plague is turned white, and the plague in sight [be] deeper than the skin of his flesh, it [is] a plague of leprosy: and the priest shall look on him, and pronounce him unclean.

plague in the <u>03_LEV_14_35</u># And he that owneth the house shall come and tell the priest, saying, It seemeth to me [there is] as it were a plague in the house:

plague is a <u>03_LEV_13_51</u># And he shall look on the plague on the seventh day: if the plague be spread in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in a skin, [or] in any work that is made of skin; the plague [is] a fretting leprosy; it [is] unclean.

plague is and <u>03_LEV_13_54</u> # Then the priest shall command that they wash [the thing] wherein the plague [is], and he shall shut it up seven days more:

plague is and <u>03_LEV_14_40</u> # Then the priest shall command that they take away the stones in which the plague [is], and they shall cast them into an unclean place without the city:

plague is begun <u>04_NUM_16_46</u># And Moses said unto Aaron, Take a censer, and put fire therein from off the altar, and put on incense, and go quickly unto the congregation, and make an atonement for them: for there is wrath gone out from the LORD; the plague is begun.

plague is for <u>03_LEV_13_52</u> # He shall therefore burn that garment, whether warp or woof, in woollen or in linen, or any thing of skin, wherein the plague is: for it [is] a fretting leprosy; it shall be burnt in the fire.

plague is healed <u>03_LEV_14_48</u> # And if the priest shall come in, and look [upon it], and, behold, the plague hath not spread in the house, after the house was plastered: then the priest shall pronounce the house clean, because the plague is healed.

plague is his <u>03_LEV_13_45</u> # And the leper in whom the plague [is], his clothes shall be rent, and his head bare, and he shall put a covering upon his upper lip, and shall cry, Unclean, unclean.

plague is in <u>03_LEV_13_44</u> # He is a leprous man, he [is] unclean: the priest shall pronounce him utterly unclean; his plague [is] in his head.

plague is turned <u>03_LEV_13_03</u># And the priest shall look on the plague in the skin of the flesh: and [when] the hair in the plague is turned white, and the plague in sight [be] deeper than the skin of his flesh, it [is] a plague of leprosy: and the priest shall look on him, and pronounce him unclean.

plague is with <u>03_LEV_13_57</u># And if it appear still in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in any thing of skin; it [is] a spreading [plague]: thou shalt burn that wherein the plague [is] with fire.

plague it is <u>03 LEV 13 13</u> # Then the priest shall consider: and, behold, [if] the leprosy have covered all his flesh, he shall pronounce [him] clean [that hath] the plague: it is all turned white: he [is] clean.

plague may be <u>13_1CH_21_22</u># Then David said to Ornan, Grant me the place of [this] threshingfloor, that I may build an altar therein unto the LORD: thou shalt grant it me for the full price: that the plague may be stayed from the people.

plague may be <u>10_2SA_24_21</u> # And Araunah said, Wherefore is my lord the king come to his servant? And David said, To buy the threshingfloor of thee, to build an altar unto the LORD, that the plague may be stayed from the people.

plague more upon <u>02_EXO_11_01</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Yet will I bring one plague [more] upon Pharaoh, and upon Egypt; afterwards he will let you go hence: when he shall let [you] go, he shall surely thrust you out hence altogether.

plague of his <u>11_1KI_08_38</u># What prayer and supplication soever be [made] by any man, [or] by all thy people Israel, which shall know every man the plague of his own heart, and spread forth his hands toward this house:

plague of leprosy <u>05 DEU 24 08</u> # Take heed in the plague of leprosy, that thou observe diligently, and do according to all that the priests the Levites shall teach you: as I commanded them, [so] ye shall observe to do.

plague of leprosy <u>03 LEV 13 02</u> # When a man shall have in the skin of his flesh a rising, a scab, or bright spot, and it be in the skin of his flesh [like] the plague of leprosy; then he shall be brought unto Aaron the priest, or unto one of his sons the priests:

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_13_03</u> # And the priest shall look on the plague in the skin of the flesh: and [when] the hair in the plague is turned white, and the plague in sight [be] deeper than the skin of his flesh, it [is] a plague of leprosy: and the priest shall look on him, and pronounce him unclean.

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_13_09</u># When the plague of leprosy is in a man, then he shall be brought unto the priest;

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_13_20</u> # And if, when the priest seeth it, behold, it [be] in sight lower than the skin, and the hair thereof be turned white; the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a plague of leprosy broken out of the boil.

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_13_25</u> # Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, [if] the hair in the bright spot be turned white, and it [be in] sight deeper than the skin; it [is] a leprosy broken out of the burning: wherefore the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_13_27</u> # And the priest shall look upon him the seventh day: [and] if it be spread much abroad in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_13_47</u># The garment also that the plague of leprosy is in, [whether it be] a woollen garment, or a linen garment;

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_13_49</u> # And if the plague be greenish or reddish in the garment, or in the skin, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in any thing of skin; it [is] a plague of leprosy, and shall be showed unto the priest:

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_13_59</u> # This [is] the law of the plague of leprosy in a garment of woollen or linen, either in the warp, or woof, or any thing of skins, to pronounce it clean, or to pronounce it unclean.

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_14_03</u> # And the priest shall go forth out of the camp; and the priest shall look, and, behold, [if] the plague of leprosy be healed in the leper;

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_14_32</u># This [is] the law [of him] in whom [is] the plague of leprosy, whose hand is not able to get [that which pertaineth] to his cleansing.

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_14_34</u> # When ye be come into the land of Canaan, which I give to you for a possession, and I put the plague of leprosy in a house of the land of your possession;

plague of leprosy <u>03_LEV_14_54</u># This [is] the law for all manner of plague of leprosy, and scall,

plague of the <u>03_LEV_13_31</u># And if the priest look on the plague of the scall, and, behold, it [be] not in sight deeper than the skin, and [that there is] no black hair in it; then the priest shall shut up [him that hath] the plague of the scall seven days:

plague of the <u>03_LEV_13_31</u># And if the priest look on the plague of the scall, and, behold, it [be] not in sight deeper than the skin, and [that there is] no black hair in it; then the priest shall shut up [him that hath] the plague of the scall seven days:

plague of the <u>66_REV_16_21</u> # And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, [every stone] about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

plague of the <u>38_ZEC_14_15</u># And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague.

plague on the <u>03_LEV_13_51</u> # And he shall look on the plague on the seventh day: if the plague be spread in the garment, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in a skin, [or] in any work that is made of skin; the plague [is] a fretting leprosy; it [is] unclean.

plague seven days <u>03_LEV_13_04</u># If the bright spot [be] white in the skin of his flesh, and in sight [be] not deeper than the skin, and the hair thereof be not turned white; then the priest shall shut up [him that hath] the plague seven days:

plague seven days <u>03_LEV_13_50</u># And the priest shall look upon the plague, and shut up [it that hath] the plague seven days:

plague shall be <u>03_LEV_13_46</u> # All the days wherein the plague [shall be] in him he shall be defiled; he [is] unclean: he shall dwell alone; without the camp [shall] his habitation [be].

plague shall not <u>02_EXO_12_13</u> # And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye [are]: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy [you], when I smite the land of Egypt.

plague spread not <u>03_LEV_13_05</u> # And the priest shall look on him the seventh day: and, behold, [if] the plague in his sight be at a stay, [and] the plague spread not in the skin; then the priest shall shut him up seven days more:

plague spread not <u>03_LEV_13_06</u># And the priest shall look on him again the seventh day: and, behold, [if] the plague [be] somewhat dark, [and] the plague spread not in the skin, the priest shall pronounce him clean: it [is but] a scab: and he shall wash his clothes, and be clean.

plague that all <u>03_LEV_14_36</u># Then the priest shall command that they empty the house, before the priest go [into it] to see the plague, that all that [is] in the house be not made unclean: and afterward the priest shall go in to see the house:

plague that the <u>04_NUM_26_01</u> # And it came to pass after the plague, that the LORD spake unto Moses and unto Eleazar the son of Aaron the priest, saying,

plague them that <u>19_PSA_89_23</u># And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that hate him.

plague thereof was <u>66_REV_16_21</u> # And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, [every stone] about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

plague upon the <u>03_LEV_13_29</u> # If a man or woman have a plague upon the head or the beard;

plague was begun <u>04_NUM_16_47</u> # And Aaron took as Moses commanded, and ran into the midst of the congregation; and, behold, the plague was begun among the people: and he put on incense, and made an atonement for the people.

plague was on <u>09_1SA_06_04</u> # Then said they, What [shall be] the trespass offering which we shall return to him? They answered, Five golden emerods, and five golden mice, [according to] the number of the lords of the Philistines: for one plague [was] on you all, and on your lords.

plague was stayed <u>10_2SA_24_25</u> # And David built there an altar unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD was entreated for the land, and the plague was stayed from Israel.

plague was stayed <u>04_NUM_16_48</u> # And he stood between the dead and the living; and the plague was stayed.

plague was stayed <u>04_NUM_16_50</u> # And Aaron returned unto Moses unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: and the plague was stayed.

plague was stayed <u>04_NUM_25_08</u> # And he went after the man of Israel into the tent, and thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman through her belly. So the plague was stayed from the children of Israel.

plague was stayed <u>19_PSA_106_30</u># Then stood up Phinehas, and executed judgment: and [so] the plague was stayed.

plague were fourteen <u>04_NUM_16_49</u> # Now they that died in the plague were fourteen thousand and seven hundred, beside them that died about the matter of Korah.

plague were twenty <u>04_NUM_25_09</u> # And those that died in the plague were twenty and four thousand.

plague whatsoever sickness <u>11_1KI_08_37</u># If there be in the land famine, if there be pestilence, blasting,

mildew, locust, [or] if there be caterpillar; if their enemy besiege them in the land of their cities; whatsoever plague, whatsoever sickness [there be];

plague wherewith the <u>38_ZEC_14_12</u> # And this shall be the plague wherewith the LORD will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth.

plague wherewith the <u>38_ZEC_14_18</u># And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that [have] no [rain]; there shall be the plague, wherewith the LORD will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

plague which is <u>05_DEU_28_61</u> # Also every sickness, and every plague, which [is] not written in the book of this law, them will the LORD bring upon thee, until thou be destroyed.

plague will the <u>14_2CH_21_14</u> # Behold, with a great plague will the LORD smite thy people, and thy children, and thy wives, and all thy goods:

plague <u>03_LEV_13_22</u> # And if it spread much abroad in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a plague.

plague <u>41_MAR_05_29</u> # And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in [her] body that she was healed of that plague.

plague <u>41_MAR_05_34</u> # And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

plague <u>04_NUM_11_33</u># And while the flesh [was] yet between their teeth, ere it was chewed, the wrath of the LORD was kindled against the people, and the LORD smote the people with a very great plague.

plague <u>38_ZEC_14_15</u># And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague.

plagued and chastened <u>19_PSA_73_14</u># For all the day long have I been plagued, and chastened every morning.

plagued Egypt according <u>06_JOS_24_05</u># I sent Moses also and Aaron, and I plagued Egypt, according to that which I did among them: and afterward I brought you out.

plagued like other <u>19_PSA_73_05</u># They [are] not in trouble [as other] men; neither are they plagued like [other] men.

plagued Pharaoh and <u>01_GEN_12_17</u># And the LORD plagued Pharaoh and his house with great plagues because of Sarai Abram's wife.

plagued the people <u>02_EXO_32_35</u> # And the LORD plagued the people, because they made the calf, which Aaron made.

plagued <u>13_1CH_21_17</u># And David said unto God, [Is it] not I [that] commanded the people to be numbered? even I it is that have sinned and done evil indeed; but [as for] these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, O LORD my God, be on me, and on my father's house; but not on thy people, that they should be plagued.

plagues and of <u>05_DEU_28_59</u> # Then the LORD will make thy plagues wonderful, and the plagues of thy seed, [even] great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance.

plagues and of <u>42_LUK_07_21</u> # And in that same hour he cured many of [their] infirmities and plagues, and of evil spirits; and unto many [that were] blind he gave sight.

plagues and talked <u>66_REV_21_09</u># And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will show thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

plagues and they <u>66_REV_16_09</u># And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.

plagues as often <u>66_REV_11_06</u># These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

plagues because of <u>01_GEN_12_17</u># And the LORD plagued Pharaoh and his house with great plagues because of Sarai Abram's wife.

plagues clothed in <u>66_REV_15_06</u># And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles.

plagues come in <u>66_REV_18_08</u># Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong [is] the Lord God who judgeth her.

plagues for in <u>66_REV_15_01</u> # And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.

plagues in the <u>09_1SA_04_08</u># Woe unto us! who shall deliver us out of the hand of these mighty Gods? these [are] the Gods that smote the Egyptians with all the plagues in the wilderness.

plagues O grave <u>28_HOS_13_14</u> # I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.

plagues of that <u>05_DEU_29_22</u># So that the generation to come of your children that shall rise up after you, and the stranger that shall come from a far land, shall say, when they see the plagues of that land, and the sicknesses which the LORD hath laid upon it;

plagues of the <u>66_REV_15_08</u># And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

plagues of thy <u>05_DEU_28_59</u># Then the LORD will make thy plagues wonderful, and the plagues of thy seed, [even] great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance.

plagues that are <u>66_REV_22_18</u># For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book:

plagues thereof <u>24_JER_19_08</u> # And I will make this city desolate, and an hissing; every one that passeth thereby shall be astonished and hiss because of all the plagues thereof.

plagues thereof <u>24_JER_49_17</u> # Also Edom shall be a desolation: every one that goeth by it shall be astonished, and shall hiss at all the plagues thereof.

plagues upon thine <u>02_EXO_09_14</u> # For I will at this time send all my plagues upon thine heart, and upon

thy servants, and upon thy people; that thou mayest know that [there is] none like me in all the earth.

plagues upon you <u>03_LEV_26_21</u># And if ye walk contrary unto me, and will not hearken unto me; I will bring seven times more plagues upon you according to your sins.

plagues wonderful and <u>05_DEU_28_59</u># Then the LORD will make thy plagues wonderful, and the plagues of thy seed, [even] great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance.

plagues yet repented <u>66_REV_09_20</u> # And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

plagues <u>24_JER_50_13</u> # Because of the wrath of the LORD it shall not be inhabited, but it shall be wholly desolate: every one that goeth by Babylon shall be astonished, and hiss at all her plagues.

plagues <u>41_MAR_03_10</u> # For he had healed many; insomuch that they pressed upon him for to touch him, as many as had plagues.

plagues <u>66_REV_18_04</u> # And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

Raguel the Midianite <u>04_NUM_10_29</u> # And Moses said unto Hobab, the son of Raguel the Midianite, Moses' father in law, We are journeying unto the place of which the LORD said, I will give it you: come thou with us, and we will do thee good: for the LORD hath spoken good concerning Israel.
