Ai an hundred 16\_NEH\_07\_32 # The men of Bethel and Ai, an hundred twenty and three.

Ai and all <u>06\_JOS\_10\_02</u># That they feared greatly, because Gibeon [was] a great city, as one of the royal cities, and because it [was] greater than Ai, and all the men thereof [were] mighty.

Ai and had <u>06\_JOS\_10\_01</u># Now it came to pass, when Adonizedek king of Jerusalem had heard how Joshua had taken Ai, and had utterly destroyed it; as he had done to Jericho and her king, so he had done to Ai and her king; and how the inhabitants of Gibeon had made peace with Israel, and were among them;

Ai and her <u>06\_JOS\_08\_02</u> # And thou shalt do to Ai and her king as thou didst unto Jericho and her king: only the spoil thereof, and the cattle thereof, shall ye take for a prey unto yourselves: lay thee an ambush for the city behind it.
