ailed thee O [19_PSA_114_05](#) # What [ailed] thee, O thou sea, that thou fleddest? thou Jordan, [that] thou wast driven back?

bewailed and lamented [42_LUK_23_27](#) # And there followed him a great company of people, and of women, which also bewailed and lamented him.

bewailed her but [42_LUK_08_52](#) # And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth.

bewailed her virginity [07_JUD_11_38](#) # And he said, Go. And he sent her away [for] two months: and she went with her companions, and bewailed her virginity upon the mountains.

failed and my [18_JOB_19_14](#) # My kinsfolk have failed, and my familiar friends have forgotten me.

failed and were [06_JOS_03_16](#) # That the waters which came down from above stood [and] rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that [is] beside Zaretan: and those that came down toward the sea of the plain, [even] the salt sea, failed, [and] were cut off: and the people passed over right against Jericho.

failed for our [25_LAM_04_17](#) # As for us, our eyes as yet failed for our vain help: in our watching we have watched for a nation [that] could not save [us].

failed in the [01_GEN_47_15](#) # And when money failed in the land of Egypt, and in the land of Canaan, all the Egyptians came unto Joseph, and said, Give us bread: for why should we die in thy presence? for the money faileth.

failed me no [19_PSA_142_04](#) # I looked on [my] right hand, and beheld, but [there was] no man that would know me: refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul.

failed not ought [06_JOS_21_45](#) # There failed not ought of any good thing which the LORD had spoken unto the house of Israel; all came to pass.

failed of all [06_JOS_23_14](#) # And, behold, this day I [am] going the way of all the earth: and ye know in all your hearts and in all your souls, that not one thing hath failed of all the good things which the LORD your God spake concerning you; all are come to pass unto you, [and] not one thing hath failed thereof.

failed one word [11_1KI_08_56](#) # Blessed [be] the LORD, that hath given rest unto his people Israel, according to all that he promised: there hath not failed one word of all his good promise, which he promised by the hand of Moses his servant.

failed them and [01_GEN_42_28](#) # And he said unto his brethren, My money is restored; and, lo, [it is] even in my sack: and their heart failed [them], and they were afraid, saying one to another, What [is] this [that] God hath done unto us?

failed thereof [06_JOS_23_14](#) # And, behold, this day I [am] going the way of all the earth: and ye know in all your hearts and in all your souls, that not one thing hath failed of all the good things which the LORD your God spake concerning you; all are come to pass unto you, [and] not one thing hath failed thereof.

failed they became [24_JER_51_30](#) # The mighty men of Babylon have forborne to fight, they have

remained in [their] holds: their might hath failed; they became as women: they have burned her dwellingplaces; her bars are broken.

failed when he [22 SON 05 06](#) # I opened to my beloved; but my beloved had withdrawn himself, [and] was gone: my soul failed when he spake: I sought him, but I could not find him; I called him, but he gave me no answer.

prevailed above his [13 1CH 05 02](#) # For Judah prevailed above his brethren, and of him [came] the chief ruler; but the birthright [was] Joseph's:]

prevailed above the [01 GEN 49 26](#) # The blessings of thy father have prevailed above the blessings of my progenitors unto the utmost bound of the everlasting hills: they shall be on the head of Joseph, and on the crown of the head of him that was separate from his brethren.

prevailed against Chushanrishathaim [07 JUD 03 10](#) # And the spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he judged Israel, and went out to war: and the LORD delivered Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand; and his hand prevailed against Chushanrishathaim.

prevailed against him [19 PSA 13 04](#) # Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; [and] those that trouble me rejoice when I am moved.

prevailed against Israel [07 JUD 06 02](#) # And the hand of Midian prevailed against Israel: [and] because of the Midianites the children of Israel made them the dens which [are] in the mountains, and caves, and strong holds.

prevailed against it [14 2CH 08 03](#) # And Solomon went to Hamathzobah, and prevailed against it.

prevailed against Jabin [07 JUD 04 24](#) # And the hand of the children of Israel prospered, and prevailed against Jabin the king of Canaan, until they had destroyed Jabin king of Canaan.

prevailed against Joab [13 1CH 21 04](#) # Nevertheless the king's word prevailed against Joab. Wherefore Joab departed, and went throughout all Israel, and came to Jerusalem.

prevailed against Joab [10 2SA 24 04](#) # Notwithstanding the king's word prevailed against Joab, and against the captains of the host. And Joab and the captains of the host went out from the presence of the king, to number the people of Israel.

prevailed against me [19 PSA 129 02](#) # Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth: yet they have not prevailed against me.

prevailed against the [11 1KI 16 22](#) # But the people that followed Omri prevailed against the people that followed Tibni the son of Ginath: so Tibni died, and Omri reigned.

prevailed against thee [24 JER 38 22](#) # And, behold, all the women that are left in the king of Judah's house [shall be] brought forth to the king of Babylon's princes, and those [women] shall say, Thy friends have set thee on, and have prevailed against thee: thy feet are sunk in the mire, [and] they are turned away back.

prevailed against thee [31 OBA 01 07](#) # All the men of thy confederacy have brought thee [even] to the border: the men that were at peace with thee have deceived thee, [and] prevailed against thee; [they that eat] thy bread have laid a wound under thee: [there is] none understanding in him.

prevailed against them [14 2CH 27 05](#) # He fought also with the king of the Ammonites, and prevailed against them. And the children of Ammon gave him the same year an hundred talents of silver, and ten thousand measures of wheat, and ten thousand of barley. So much did the children of Ammon pay unto

him, both the second year, and the third.

prevailed against them [44 ACT 19 16](#) # And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

prevailed against them [27 DAN 07 21](#) # I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them;

prevailed against us [10 2SA 11 23](#) # And the messenger said unto David, Surely the men prevailed against us, and came out unto us into the field, and we were upon them even unto the entering of the gate.

prevailed and she [01 GEN 30 08](#) # And Rachel said, With great wrestlings have I wrestled with my sister, and I have prevailed: and she called his name Naphtali.

prevailed and were [01 GEN 07 18](#) # And the waters prevailed, and were increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters.

prevailed and when [02 EXO 17 11](#) # And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

prevailed because they [14 2CH 13 18](#) # Thus the children of Israel were brought under at that time, and the children of Judah prevailed, because they relied upon the LORD God of their fathers.

prevailed exceedingly upon [01 GEN 07 19](#) # And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth; and all the high hills, that [were] under the whole heaven, were covered.

prevailed he wept [28 HOS 12 04](#) # Yea, he had power over the angel, and prevailed: he wept, and made supplication unto him: he found him [in] Bethel, and there he spake with us;

prevailed I am [24 JER 20 07](#) # O LORD, thou hast deceived me, and I was deceived: thou art stronger than I, and hast prevailed: I am in derision daily, every one mocketh me.

prevailed in the [12 2KI 25 03](#) # And on the ninth [day] of the [fourth] month the famine prevailed in the city, and there was no bread for the people of the land.

prevailed not against [01 GEN 32 25](#) # And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh; and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him.

prevailed not neither [66 REV 12 08](#) # And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven.

prevailed over the [09 ISA 17 50](#) # So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and with a stone, and smote the Philistine, and slew him; but [there was] no sword in the hand of David.

prevailed over them [01 GEN 47 20](#) # And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

prevailed so that [07 JUD 01 35](#) # But the Amorites would dwell in mount Heres in Aijalon, and in Shaalbim: yet the hand of the house of Joseph prevailed, so that they became tributaries.

prevailed to open [66 REV 05 05](#) # And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

prevailed upon the [01 GEN 07 24](#) # And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days.

prevailed [44 ACT 19 20](#) # So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed.

prevailed [02 EXO 17 11](#) # And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

prevailed [01 GEN 32 28](#) # And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed.

prevailed [25 LAM 01 16](#) # For these [things] I weep; mine eye, mine eye runneth down with water, because the comforter that should relieve my soul is far from me: my children are desolate, because the enemy prevailed.

prevailed [42 LUK 23 23](#) # And they were instant with loud voices, requiring that he might be crucified. And the voices of them and of the chief priests prevailed.

railed on him [42 LUK 23 39](#) # And one of the malefactors which were hanged railed on him, saying, If thou be Christ, save thyself and us.

railed on him [41 MAR 15 29](#) # And they that passed by railed on him, wagging their heads, and saying, Ah, thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest [it] in three days,

railed on them [09 ISA 25 14](#) # But one of the young men told Abigail, Nabal's wife, saying, Behold, David sent messengers out of the wilderness to salute our master; and he railed on them.

sailed away from [44 ACT 20 06](#) # And we sailed away from Philippi after the days of unleavened bread, and came unto them to Troas in five days; where we abode seven days.

sailed close by [44 ACT 27 13](#) # And when the south wind blew softly, supposing that they had obtained [their] purpose, loosing [thence], they sailed close by Crete.

sailed from Ephesus [44 ACT 18 21](#) # But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

sailed he fell [42 LUK 08 23](#) # But as they sailed he fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled [with water], and were in jeopardy.

sailed into Syria [44 ACT 21 03](#) # Now when we had discovered Cyprus, we left it on the left hand, and sailed into Syria, and landed at Tyre: for there the ship was to unlade her burden.

sailed over the [44 ACT 27 05](#) # And when we had sailed over the sea of Cilicia and Pamphylia, we came to Myra, [a city] of Lycia.

sailed slowly many [44 ACT 27 07](#) # And when we had sailed slowly many days, and scarce were come over against Cnidus, the wind not suffering us, we sailed under Crete, over against Salmone;

sailed thence and [44 ACT 20 15](#) # And we sailed thence, and came the next [day] over against Chios; and the next [day] we arrived at Samos, and tarried at Trogyllium; and the next [day] we came to Miletus.

sailed thence into [44 ACT 18 18](#) # And Paul [after this] tarried [there] yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn [his] head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow.

sailed to Antioch [44 ACT 14 26](#) # And thence sailed to Antioch, from whence they had been recommended to the grace of God for the work which they fulfilled.

sailed to Cyprus [44 ACT 13 04](#) # So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus.

sailed under Crete [44 ACT 27 07](#) # And when we had sailed slowly many days, and scarce were come over against Cnidus, the wind not suffering us, we sailed under Crete, over against Salmone;

sailed under Cyprus [44 ACT 27 04](#) # And when we had launched from thence, we sailed under Cyprus, because the winds were contrary.

sailed unto Assos [44 ACT 20 13](#) # And we went before to ship, and sailed unto Assos, there intending to take in Paul: for so had he appointed, minding himself to go afoot.

sailed unto Cyprus [44 ACT 15 39](#) # And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;

travailed and she [01 GEN 35 16](#) # And they journeyed from Bethel; and there was but a little way to come to Ephrath: and Rachel travailed, and she had hard labour.

travailed for her [09 ISA 04 19](#) # And his daughter in law, Phinehas' wife, was with child, [near] to be delivered: and when she heard the tidings that the ark of God was taken, and that her father in law and her husband were dead, she bowed herself and travailed; for her pains came upon her.

travailed she brought [23 ISA 66 07](#) # Before she travailed, she brought forth; before her pain came, she was delivered of a man child.

travailed she brought [23 ISA 66 08](#) # Who hath heard such a thing? who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? [or] shall a nation be born at once? for as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children.

travailed that the [01 GEN 38 28](#) # And it came to pass, when she travailed, that [the one] put out [his] hand: and the midwife took and bound upon his hand a scarlet thread, saying, This came out first.

wailed greatly [41 MAR 05 38](#) # And he cometh to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and seeth the tumult, and them that wept and wailed greatly.
