bewaileth herself that 24\_JER\_04\_31 # For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, [and] the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, [that] bewaileth herself, [that] spreadeth her hands, [saying], Woe [is] me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.

faileth and he <u>23\_ISA\_59\_15</u> # Yea, truth faileth; and he [that] departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw [it], and it displeased him that [there was] no judgment.

faileth because of 19\_PSA\_31\_10 # For my life is spent with grief, and my years with sighing: my strength faileth because of mine iniquity, and my bones are consumed.
