affairs and how <u>49_EPH_06_21</u> # But that ye also may know my affairs, [and] how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things:

affairs and that <u>49_EPH_06_22</u> # Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that ye might know our affairs, and [that] he might comfort your hearts.

affairs of the <u>13_1CH_26_32</u> # And his brethren, men of valour, [were] two thousand and seven hundred chief fathers, whom king David made rulers over the Reubenites, the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, for every matter pertaining to God, and affairs of the king.

affairs of the <u>27_DAN_02_49</u> # Then Daniel requested of the king, and he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of the province of Babylon: but Daniel [sat] in the gate of the king.

affairs of the <u>27_DAN_03_12</u> # There are certain Jews whom thou hast set over the affairs of the province of Babylon, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; these men, O king, have not regarded thee: they serve not thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

affairs of this <u>55_2TI_02_04</u> # No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of [this] life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

affairs that ye <u>50_PHP_01_27</u># Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

affairs with discretion <u>19_PSA_112_05</u># A good man showeth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.

air and brought <u>01_GEN_02_19</u># And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought [them] unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that [was] the name thereof.

air and over <u>01_GEN_01_26</u># And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

air and over <u>01_GEN_01_28</u># And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

air and so <u>52_1TH_04_17</u># Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

air and the <u>19_PSA_08_08</u># The fowl of the air, and the fish of the sea, [and whatsoever] passeth through the paths of the seas.

air and there <u>66_REV_16_17</u># And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done.

air and they <u>18_JOB_12_07</u># But ask now the beasts, and they shall teach thee; and the fowls of the air, and they shall tell thee:

air by sevens <u>01_GEN_07_03</u> # Of fowls also of the air by sevens, the male and the female; to keep seed alive upon the face of all the earth.

air came and <u>41_MAR_04_04</u> # And it came to pass, as he sowed, some fell by the way side, and the fowls of the air came and devoured it up.

air can come <u>18_JOB_41_16</u> # One is so near to another, that no air can come between them.

air come and <u>40_MAT_13_32</u># Which indeed is the least of all seeds: but when it is grown, it is the greatest among herbs, and becometh a tree, so that the birds of the air come and lodge in the branches thereof.

air devoured it <u>42_LUK_08_05</u> # A sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it.

air eat for <u>11_1KI_14_11</u># Him that dieth of Jeroboam in the city shall the dogs eat; and him that dieth in the field shall the fowls of the air eat: for the LORD hath spoken [it].

air eat <u>11_1KI_16_04</u># Him that dieth of Baasha in the city shall the dogs eat; and him that dieth of his in the fields shall the fowls of the air eat.

air eat <u>11_1KI_21_24</u># Him that dieth of Ahab in the city the dogs shall eat; and him that dieth in the field shall the fowls of the air eat.

air for it <u>01_GEN_06_07</u> # And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.

air for they <u>40_MAT_06_26</u># Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?

air <u>44_ACT_10_12</u># Wherein were all manner of fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air.

air <u>44_ACT_11_06</u> # Upon the which when I had fastened mine eyes, I considered, and saw fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air.

air <u>44_ACT_22_23</u> # And as they cried out, and cast off [their] clothes, and threw dust into the air,

air <u>05_DEU_04_17</u> # The likeness of any beast that [is] on the earth, the likeness of any winged fowl that flieth in the air,

air 18_JOB_28_21 # Seeing it is hid from the eyes of all living, and kept close from the fowls of the air.

Bashanhavothjair unto this <u>05_DEU_03_14</u># Jair the son of Manasseh took all the country of Argob unto the coasts of Geshuri and Maachathi; and called them after his own name, Bashanhavothjair, unto this day.

Beerlahairoi behold it <u>01_GEN_16_14</u># Wherefore the well was called Beerlahairoi; behold, [it is] between Kadesh and Bered.

despair of all <u>21_ECC_02_20</u># Therefore I went about to cause my heart to despair of all the labour which I took under the sun.

despair of me <u>09_1SA_27_01</u># And David said in his heart, I shall now perish one day by the hand of Saul:

[there is] nothing better for me than that I should speedily escape into the land of the Philistines; and Saul shall despair of me, to seek me any more in any coast of Israel: so shall I escape out of his hand.

despair <u>47_2CO_04_08</u> # [We are] troubled on every side, yet not distressed; [we are] perplexed, but not in despair;

despaired even of <u>47_2CO_01_08</u> # For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that we were pressed out of measure, above strength, insomuch that we despaired even of life:

fair and beautiful <u>17_EST_02_07</u># And he brought up Hadassah, that [is], Esther, his uncle's daughter: for she had neither father nor mother, and the maid [was] fair and beautiful; whom Mordecai, when her father and mother were dead, took for his own daughter.

fair and of <u>24_JER_11_16</u># The LORD called thy name, A green olive tree, fair, [and] of goodly fruit: with the noise of a great tumult he hath kindled fire upon it, and the branches of it are broken.

fair and the <u>27_DAN_04_12</u># The leaves thereof [were] fair, and the fruit thereof much, and in it [was] meat for all: the beasts of the field had shadow under it, and the fowls of the heaven dwelt in the boughs thereof, and all flesh was fed of it.

fair branches and <u>26_EZE_31_03</u> # Behold, the Assyrian [was] a cedar in Lebanon with fair branches, and with a shadowing shroud, and of an high stature; and his top was among the thick boughs.

fair by the <u>26_EZE_31_09</u> # I have made him fair by the multitude of his branches: so that all the trees of Eden, that [were] in the garden of God, envied him.

fair colours and <u>23_ISA_54_11</u># O thou afflicted, tossed with tempest, [and] not comforted, behold, I will lay thy stones with fair colours, and lay thy foundations with sapphires.

fair one and <u>22_SON_02_10</u> # My beloved spake, and said unto me, Rise up, my love, my fair one, and come away.

fair one and <u>22_SON_02_13</u># The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines [with] the tender grape give a [good] smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.

fair show in <u>48_GAL_06_12</u># As many as desire to make a fair show in the flesh, they constrain you to be circumcised; only lest they should suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.

fair sister whose <u>10_2SA_13_01</u> # And it came to pass after this, that Absalom the son of David had a fair sister, whose name [was] Tamar; and Amnon the son of David loved her.

fair speech she <u>20_PRO_07_21</u> # With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him.

fair speeches deceive <u>45_ROM_16_18</u># For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.

fair thou hast <u>22_SON_01_15</u># Behold, thou [art] fair, my love; behold, thou [art] fair; thou [hast] doves' eyes.

fair thou hast <u>22_SON_04_01</u> # Behold, thou [art] fair, my love; behold, thou [art] fair; thou [hast] doves' eyes within thy locks: thy hair [is] as a flock of goats, that appear from mount Gilead.

fair thy lovers 24_JER_04_30 # And [when] thou [art] spoiled, what wilt thou do? Though thou clothest thyself with crimson, though thou deckest thee with ornaments of gold, though thou rentest thy face with painting, in vain shalt thou make thyself fair; [thy] lovers will despise thee, they will seek thy life.

fair to look <u>17_EST_01_11</u># To bring Vashti the queen before the king with the crown royal, to show the people and the princes her beauty: for she [was] fair to look on.

fair to look <u>01_GEN_24_16</u># And the damsel [was] very fair to look upon, a virgin, neither had any man known her: and she went down to the well, and filled her pitcher, and came up.

fair to look <u>01_GEN_26_07</u> # And the men of the place asked [him] of his wife; and he said, She [is] my sister: for he feared to say, [She is] my wife; lest, [said he], the men of the place should kill me for Rebekah; because she [was] fair to look upon.

fair virgins and <u>30_AMO_08_13</u># In that day shall the fair virgins and young men faint for thirst.

Fair weather cometh <u>18_JOB_37_22</u> # Fair weather cometh out of the north: with God [is] terrible majesty.

fair weather for <u>40_MAT_16_02</u># He answered and said unto them, When it is evening, ye say, [It will be] fair weather: for the sky is red.

fair without inhabitant 23_ISA_05_09 # In mine ears [said] the LORD of hosts, Of a truth many houses shall be desolate, [even] great and fair, without inhabitant.

fair woman to <u>01_GEN_12_11</u># And it came to pass, when he was come near to enter into Egypt, that he said unto Sarai his wife, Behold now, I know that thou [art] a fair woman to look upon:

fair woman which <u>20_PRO_11_22</u># [As] a jewel of gold in a swine's snout, [so is] a fair woman which is without discretion.

fair young virgins <u>17_EST_02_02</u> # Then said the king's servants that ministered unto him, Let there be fair young virgins sought for the king:

fairest among women <u>22_SON_05_09</u> # What [is] thy beloved more than [another] beloved, O thou fairest among women? what [is] thy beloved more than [another] beloved, that thou dost so charge us?

fairest among women <u>22_SON_06_01</u> # Whither is thy beloved gone, O thou fairest among women? whither is thy beloved turned aside? that we may seek him with thee.

fairs bright iron <u>26_EZE_27_19</u># Dan also and Javan going to and fro occupied in thy fairs: bright iron, cassia, and calamus, were in thy market.

fairs thy merchandise <u>26_EZE_27_27</u> # Thy riches, and thy fairs, thy merchandise, thy mariners, and thy pilots, thy calkers, and the occupiers of thy merchandise, and all thy men of war, that [are] in thee, and in all thy company which [is] in the midst of thee, shall fall into the midst of the seas in the day of thy ruin.

fairs with chief <u>26_EZE_27_22</u> # The merchants of Sheba and Raamah, they [were] thy merchants: they occupied in thy fairs with chief of all spices, and with all precious stones, and gold.

hair and a <u>40_MAT_03_04</u># And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.

hair and all <u>04_NUM_31_20</u># And purify all [your] raiment, and all that is made of skins, and all work of goats' [hair], and all things made of wood.

hair and made <u>16_NEH_13_25</u># And I contended with them, and cursed them, and smote certain of them, and plucked off their hair, and made them swear by God, [saying], Ye shall not give your daughters unto

hair I hid <u>23_ISA_50_06</u># I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.

hair in it <u>03_LEV_13_31</u># And if the priest look on the plague of the scall, and, behold, it [be] not in sight deeper than the skin, and [that there is] no black hair in it; then the priest shall shut up [him that hath] the plague of the scall seven days:

hair in the <u>03_LEV_13_03</u> # And the priest shall look on the plague in the skin of the flesh: and [when] the hair in the plague is turned white, and the plague in sight [be] deeper than the skin of his flesh, it [is] a plague of leprosy: and the priest shall look on him, and pronounce him unclean.

hair in the <u>03_LEV_13_25</u> # Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, [if] the hair in the bright spot be turned white, and it [be in] sight deeper than the skin; it [is] a leprosy broken out of the burning: wherefore the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] the plague of leprosy.

hair in the <u>03_LEV_13_26</u> # But if the priest look on it, and, behold, [there be] no white hair in the bright spot, and it [be] no lower than the [other] skin, but [be] somewhat dark; then the priest shall shut him up seven days:

hair is as <u>22_SON_04_01</u> # Behold, thou [art] fair, my love; behold, thou [art] fair; thou [hast] doves' eyes within thy locks: thy hair [is] as a flock of goats, that appear from mount Gilead.

hair is as <u>22_SON_06_05</u> # Turn away thine eyes from me, for they have overcome me: thy hair [is] as a flock of goats that appear from Gilead.

hair is fallen <u>03_LEV_13_40</u> # And the man whose hair is fallen off his head, he [is] bald; [yet is] he clean.

hair is given <u>46_1CO_11_15</u># But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for [her] hair is given her for a covering.

hair is grown <u>26_EZE_16_07</u> # I have caused thee to multiply as the bud of the field, and thou hast increased and waxen great, and thou art come to excellent ornaments: [thy] breasts are fashioned, and thine hair is grown, whereas thou [wast] naked and bare.

hair it is <u>46_1CO_11_14</u> # Doth not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him?

hair it is <u>46_1CO_11_15</u># But if a woman have long hair, it is a glory to her: for [her] hair is given her for a covering.

hair O Jerusalem <u>24_JER_07_29</u> # Cut off thine hair, [O Jerusalem], and cast [it] away, and take up a lamentation on high places; for the LORD hath rejected and forsaken the generation of his wrath.

hair of him <u>11_1KI_01_52</u># And Solomon said, If he will show himself a worthy man, there shall not an hair of him fall to the earth: but if wickedness shall be found in him, he shall die.

hair of his <u>09_1SA_14_45</u> # And the people said unto Saul, Shall Jonathan die, who hath wrought this great salvation in Israel? hair was heavy <u>10_2SA_14_26</u> # And when he polled his head, [for it was at every year's end that he polled [it]: because [the hair] was heavy on him, therefore he polled it:] he weighed the hair of his head at two hundred shekels after the king's weight.

hair white and <u>03_LEV_13_10</u># And the priest shall see [him]: and, behold, [if] the rising [be] white in the skin, and it have turned the hair white, and [there be] quick raw flesh in the rising;

hair white or <u>40_MAT_05_36</u># Neither shalt thou swear by thy head, because thou canst not make one hair white or black.

hair whose brother <u>43_JOH_11_02</u># [It was [that] Mary which anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.]

hair <u>02_EXO_25_04</u> # And blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen, and goats' [hair],

hair <u>02_EXO_35_06</u># And blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine linen, and goats' [hair],

hair <u>02_EXO_35_26</u># And all the women whose heart stirred them up in wisdom spun goats' [hair].

hair <u>26_EZE_05_01</u> # And thou, son of man, take thee a sharp knife, take thee a barber's razor, and cause [it] to pass upon thine head and upon thy beard: then take thee balances to weigh, and divide the [hair].

hairs are here <u>28_HOS_07_09</u># Strangers have devoured his strength, and he knoweth [it] not: yea, gray hairs are here and there upon him, yet he knoweth not.

hairs of her <u>42_LUK_07_38</u> # And stood at his feet behind [him] weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe [them] with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed [them] with the ointment.

hairs of her <u>42_LUK_07_44</u> # And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped [them] with the hairs of her head.

hairs of mine <u>19_PSA_40_12</u># For innumerable evils have compassed me about: mine iniquities have taken hold upon me, so that I am not able to look up; they are more than the hairs of mine head: therefore my heart faileth me.

Jair died and <u>07_JUD_10_05</u># And Jair died, and was buried in Camon.

Jair from them <u>13_1CH_02_23</u># And he took Geshur, and Aram, with the towns of Jair, from them, with Kenath, and the towns thereof, [even] threescore cities. All these [belonged to] the sons of Machir, the father of Gilead.

Jair slew Lahmi <u>13_1CH_20_05</u> # And there was war again with the Philistines; and Elhanan the son of Jair slew Lahmi the brother of Goliath the Gittite, whose spear staff [was] like a weaver's beam.

Jair the son <u>11_1KI_04_13</u># The son of Geber, in Ramothgilead; to him [pertained] the towns of Jair the son of Manasseh, which [are] in Gilead; to him [also pertained] the region of Argob, which [is] in Bashan, threescore great cities with walls and brazen bars:

Jair the son <u>05_DEU_03_14</u># Jair the son of Manasseh took all the country of Argob unto the coasts of Geshuri and Maachathi; and called them after his own name, Bashanhavothjair, unto this day.

Jair the son <u>17_EST_02_05</u> # [Now] in Shushan the palace there was a certain Jew, whose name [was] Mordecai, the son of Jair, the son of Shimei, the son of Kish, a Benjamite;

Jair the son <u>04_NUM_32_41</u> # And Jair the son of Manasseh went and took the small towns thereof, and called them Havothjair.

Jair which are <u>06_JOS_13_30</u> # And their coast was from Mahanaim, all Bashan, all the kingdom of Og king of Bashan, and all the towns of Jair, which [are] in Bashan, threescore cities:

Jair who had <u>13_1CH_02_22</u># And Segub begat Jair, who had three and twenty cities in the land of Gilead.

Jairite was a <u>10_2SA_20_26</u># And Ira also the Jairite was a chief ruler about David.

Jairus and he <u>42_LUK_08_41</u> # And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at Jesus' feet, and besought him that he would come into his house:

Jairus by name <u>41_MAR_05_22</u> # And, behold, there cometh one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name; and when he saw him, he fell at his feet,

Lahairoi for he <u>01_GEN_24_62</u># And Isaac came from the way of the well Lahairoi; for he dwelt in the south country.

Lahairoi <u>01_GEN_25_11</u># And it came to pass after the death of Abraham, that God blessed his son Isaac; and Isaac dwelt by the well Lahairoi.

pair of balances <u>66_REV_06_05</u> # And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

pair of shoes <u>30_AMO_02_06</u> # Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Israel, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they sold the righteous for silver, and the poor for a pair of shoes;

pair of shoes <u>30_AMO_08_06</u># That we may buy the poor for silver, and the needy for a pair of shoes; [yea], and sell the refuse of the wheat?

pair of turtledoves <u>42_LUK_02_24</u> # And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.

repair and amend <u>14_2CH_34_10</u> # And they put [it] in the hand of the workmen that had the oversight of the house of the LORD, and they gave it to the workmen that wrought in the house of the LORD, to repair and amend the house:

repair it <u>12_2KI_12_12</u> # And to masons, and hewers of stone, and to buy timber and hewed stone to repair the breaches of the house of the LORD, and for all that was laid out for the house to repair [it].

repaired Azariah the <u>16_NEH_03_23</u># After him repaired Benjamin and Hashub over against their house. After him repaired Azariah the son of Maaseiah the son of Ananiah by his house.

repaired Benjamin and <u>16_NEH_03_23</u># After him repaired Benjamin and Hashub over against their house. After him repaired Azariah the son of Maaseiah the son of Ananiah by his house.

repaired Binnui the <u>16_NEH_03_24</u> # After him repaired Binnui the son of Henadad another piece, from the house of Azariah unto the turning [of the wall], even unto the corner.

repaired but their <u>16_NEH_03_05</u># And next unto them the Tekoites repaired; but their nobles put not their necks to the work of their Lord.

repaired Ezer the <u>16_NEH_03_19</u># And next to him repaired Ezer the son of Jeshua, the ruler of Mizpah, another piece over against the going up to the armoury at the turning [of the wall].

repaired Hananiah the <u>16_NEH_03_08</u># Next unto him repaired Uzziel the son of Harhaiah, of the goldsmiths. Next unto him also repaired Hananiah the son of [one of] the apothecaries, and they fortified Jerusalem unto the broad wall.

repaired Hananiah the <u>16_NEH_03_30</u># After him repaired Hananiah the son of Shelemiah, and Hanun the sixth son of Zalaph, another piece. After him repaired Meshullam the son of Berechiah over against his chamber.

repaired Hanun and <u>16_NEH_03_13</u># The valley gate repaired Hanun, and the inhabitants of Zanoah; they built it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof, and a thousand cubits on the wall unto the dung gate.

repaired Hashabiah the <u>16_NEH_03_17</u> # After him repaired the Levites, Rehum the son of Bani. Next unto him repaired Hashabiah, the ruler of the half part of Keilah, in his part.

repaired Hattush the <u>16_NEH_03_10</u># And next unto them repaired Jedaiah the son of Harumaph, even over against his house. And next unto him repaired Hattush the son of Hashabniah.

repaired Jedaiah the <u>16_NEH_03_10</u> # And next unto them repaired Jedaiah the son of Harumaph, even over against his house. And next unto him repaired Hattush the son of Hashabniah.

repaired Jehoiada the <u>16_NEH_03_06</u># Moreover the old gate repaired Jehoiada the son of Paseah, and Meshullam the son of Besodeiah; they laid the beams thereof, and set up the doors thereof, and the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

repaired Malchiah the <u>16_NEH_03_14</u> # But the dung gate repaired Malchiah the son of Rechab, the ruler of part of Bethhaccerem; he built it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

repaired Malchiah the <u>16_NEH_03_31</u> # After him repaired Malchiah the goldsmith's son unto the place of the Nethinims, and of the merchants, over against the gate Miphkad, and to the going up of the corner.

repaired Melatiah the <u>16_NEH_03_07</u># And next unto them repaired Melatiah the Gibeonite, and Jadon the Meronothite, the men of Gibeon, and of Mizpah, unto the throne of the governor on this side the river.

repaired Meremoth the <u>16_NEH_03_04</u># And next unto them repaired Meremoth the son of Urijah, the son of Koz. And next unto them repaired Meshullam the son of Berechiah, the son of Meshezabeel. And next unto them repaired Zadok the son of Baana.

repaired Meremoth the <u>16_NEH_03_21</u> # After him repaired Meremoth the son of Urijah the son of Koz another piece, from the door of the house of Eliashib even to the end of the house of Eliashib.

repaired Meshullam the <u>16_NEH_03_04</u> # And next unto them repaired Meremoth the son of Urijah, the son of Koz. And next unto them repaired Meshullam the son of Berechiah, the son of Meshezabeel. And next unto them repaired Zadok the son of Baana.

repaired Meshullam the <u>16_NEH_03_30</u># After him repaired Hananiah the son of Shelemiah, and Hanun the sixth son of Zalaph, another piece. After him repaired Meshullam the son of Berechiah over against his chamber.

repaired Millo in <u>14_2CH_32_05</u># Also he strengthened himself, and built up all the wall that was broken, and raised [it] up to the towers, and another wall without, and repaired Millo [in] the city of David, and made darts and shields in abundance.

repaired Nehemiah the <u>16_NEH_03_16</u># After him repaired Nehemiah the son of Azbuk, the ruler of the half part of Bethzur, unto [the place] over against the sepulchres of David, and to the pool that was made, and unto the house of the mighty.

repaired Rephaiah the <u>16_NEH_03_09</u> # And next unto them repaired Rephaiah the son of Hur, the ruler of the half part of Jerusalem.

repaired Shallum the <u>16_NEH_03_12</u># And next unto him repaired Shallum the son of Halohesh, the ruler of the half part of Jerusalem, he and his daughters.

repaired Shallun the <u>16_NEH_03_15</u> # But the gate of the fountain repaired Shallun the son of Colhozeh, the ruler of part of Mizpah; he built it, and covered it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof, and the wall of the pool of Siloah by the king's garden, and unto the stairs that go down from the city of David.

repaired the altar <u>11_1KI_18_30</u># And Elijah said unto all the people, Come near unto me. And all the people came near unto him. And he repaired the altar of the LORD [that was] broken down.

repaired the altar <u>14_2CH_33_16</u># And he repaired the altar of the LORD, and sacrificed thereon peace offerings and thank offerings, and commanded Judah to serve the LORD God of Israel.

repaired the breaches <u>11_1KI_11_27</u># And this [was] the cause that he lifted up [his] hand against the king: Solomon built Millo, [and] repaired the breaches of the city of David his father.

repaired the breaches <u>12_2KI_12_06</u># But it was [so, that] in the three and twentieth year of king Jehoash the priests had not repaired the breaches of the house.

repaired the cities <u>07_JUD_21_23</u> # And the children of Benjamin did so, and took [them] wives, according to their number, of them that danced, whom they caught: and they went and returned unto their inheritance, and repaired the cities, and dwelt in them.

repaired the goldsmiths <u>16_NEH_03_32</u> # And between the going up of the corner unto the sheep gate repaired the goldsmiths and the merchants.

repaired the Levites <u>16_NEH_03_17</u> # After him repaired the Levites, Rehum the son of Bani. Next unto

him repaired Hashabiah, the ruler of the half part of Keilah, in his part.

repaired the other <u>16_NEH_03_11</u># Malchijah the son of Harim, and Hashub the son of Pahathmoab, repaired the other piece, and the tower of the furnaces.

repaired the other <u>16_NEH_03_20</u> # After him Baruch the son of Zabbai earnestly repaired the other piece, from the turning [of the wall] unto the door of the house of Eliashib the high priest.

repaired the priests <u>16_NEH_03_22</u># And after him repaired the priests, the men of the plain.

repaired the priests <u>16_NEH_03_28</u># From above the horse gate repaired the priests, every one over against his house.

repaired the rest <u>13_1CH_11_08</u># And he built the city round about, even from Millo round about: and Joab repaired the rest of the city.

repaired their brethren <u>16_NEH_03_18</u># After him repaired their brethren, Bavai the son of Henadad, the ruler of the half part of Keilah.

repaired them <u>14_2CH_29_03</u> # He in the first year of his reign, in the first month, opened the doors of the house of the LORD, and repaired them.

repaired therewith the <u>12_2KI_12_14</u> # But they gave that to the workmen, and repaired therewith the house of the LORD.

repaired Uzziel the <u>16_NEH_03_08</u># Next unto him repaired Uzziel the son of Harhaiah, of the goldsmiths. Next unto him also repaired Hananiah the son of [one of] the apothecaries, and they fortified Jerusalem unto the broad wall.

repaired Zadok the <u>16_NEH_03_04</u> # And next unto them repaired Meremoth the son of Urijah, the son of Koz. And next unto them repaired Meshullam the son of Berechiah, the son of Meshezabeel. And next unto them repaired Zadok the son of Baana.

repaired Zadok the <u>16_NEH_03_29</u># After them repaired Zadok the son of Immer over against his house. After him repaired also Shemaiah the son of Shechaniah, the keeper of the east gate.

repairer of the <u>23_ISA_58_12</u> # And [they that shall be] of thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach, The restorer of paths to dwell in.

repairing of the <u>14_2CH_24_27</u> # Now [concerning] his sons, and the greatness of the burdens [laid] upon him, and the repairing of the house of God, behold, they [are] written in the story of the book of the kings. And Amaziah his son reigned in his stead.

stairs and beckoned <u>44_ACT_21_40</u># And when he had given him licence, Paul stood on the stairs, and beckoned with the hand unto the people. And when there was made a great silence, he spake unto [them] in the Hebrew tongue, saying,

stairs and blew <u>12_2KI_09_13</u> # Then they hasted, and took every man his garment, and put [it] under him on the top of the stairs, and blew with trumpets, saying, Jehu is king.

stairs into the <u>11_1KI_06_08</u># The door for the middle chamber [was] in the right side of the house: and they went up with winding stairs into the middle [chamber], and out of the middle into the third.

stairs let me <u>22_SON_02_14</u> # O my dove, [that art] in the clefts of the rock, in the secret [places] of the

stairs, let me see thy countenance, let me hear thy voice; for sweet [is] thy voice, and thy countenance [is] comely.

stairs of the <u>16_NEH_09_04</u> # Then stood up upon the stairs, of the Levites, Jeshua, and Bani, Kadmiel, Shebaniah, Bunni, Sherebiah, Bani, [and] Chenani, and cried with a loud voice unto the LORD their God.

stairs of the <u>16_NEH_12_37</u># And at the fountain gate, which was over against them, they went up by the stairs of the city of David, at the going up of the wall, above the house of David, even unto the water gate eastward.

stairs shall look <u>26_EZE_43_17</u> # And the settle [shall be] fourteen [cubits] long and fourteen broad in the four squares thereof; and the border about it [shall be] half a cubit; and the bottom thereof [shall be] a cubit about; and his stairs shall look toward the east.

stairs so it <u>44_ACT_21_35</u> # And when he came upon the stairs, so it was, that he was borne of the soldiers for the violence of the people.

stairs that go <u>16_NEH_03_15</u> # But the gate of the fountain repaired Shallun the son of Colhozeh, the ruler of part of Mizpah; he built it, and covered it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof, and the wall of the pool of Siloah by the king's garden, and unto the stairs that go down from the city of David.

stairs thereof and <u>26_EZE_40_06</u># Then came he unto the gate which looketh toward the east, and went up the stairs thereof, and measured the threshold of the gate, [which was] one reed broad; and the other threshold [of the gate, which was] one reed broad.

Zair and all <u>12_2KI_08_21</u># So Joram went over to Zair, and all the chariots with him: and he rose by night, and smote the Edomites which compassed him about, and the captains of the chariots: and the people fled into their tents.
