am a child 24\_JER\_01\_06 # Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! behold, I cannot speak: for I [am] a child.

am a Jew 44\_ACT\_21\_39 # But Paul said, I am a man [which am] a Jew of Tarsus, [a city] in Cilicia, a citizen of no mean city: and, I beseech thee, suffer me to speak unto the people.

am a Levite <u>07\_JUD\_17\_09</u># And Micah said unto him, Whence comest thou? And he said unto him, I [am] a Levite of Bethlehemjudah, and I go to sojourn where I may find [a place].

am a man 44\_ACT\_10\_26 # But Peter took him up, saying, Stand up; I myself also am a man.

am a man 44 ACT 21 39 # But Paul said, I am a man [which am] a Jew of Tarsus, [a city] in Cilicia, a citizen of no mean city: and, I beseech thee, suffer me to speak unto the people.

am a man 23 ISA 06 05 # Then said I, Woe [is] me! for I am undone; because I [am] a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.

am a man <u>42\_LUK\_07\_08</u># For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth [it].

am a poor <u>09\_1SA\_18\_23</u> # And Saul's servants spake those words in the ears of David. And David said, Seemeth it to you [a] light [thing] to be a king's son in law, seeing that I [am] a poor man, and lightly esteemed?

am a prophet 11\_1KI\_13\_18# He said unto him, I [am] a prophet also as thou [art]; and an angel spake unto me by the word of the LORD, saying, Bring him back with thee into thine house, that he may eat bread and drink water. [But] he lied unto him.

am a sinful <u>42\_LUK\_05\_08</u> # When Simon Peter saw [it], he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord.

am a smooth <u>01\_GEN\_27\_11</u># And Jacob said to Rebekah his mother, Behold, Esau my brother [is] a hairy man, and I [am] a smooth man:

am a stranger <u>01\_GEN\_23\_04</u> # I [am] a stranger and a sojourner with you: give me a possession of a buryingplace with you, that I may bury my dead out of my sight.

am a stranger 19\_PSA\_119\_19 # I [am] a stranger in the earth: hide not thy commandments from me.

am a stranger 19\_PSA\_39\_12 # Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not thy peace at my tears: for I [am] a stranger with thee, [and] a sojourner, as all my fathers [were].

am a stranger <u>08\_RUT\_02\_10</u># Then she fell on her face, and bowed herself to the ground, and said unto him, Why have I found grace in thine eyes, that thou shouldest take knowledge of me, seeing I [am] a stranger?

am a wall <u>22\_SON\_08\_10</u> # I [am] a wall, and my breasts like towers: then was I in his eyes as one that found favour.

am a witness <u>24\_JER\_29\_23</u># Because they have committed villany in Israel, and have committed adultery with their neighbours' wives, and have spoken lying words in my name, which I have not commanded them; even I know, and [am] a witness, saith the LORD.

am a woman <u>09\_1SA\_01\_15</u># And Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I [am] a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD.

am a woman <u>43\_JOH\_04\_09</u># Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.

am a worm 19\_PSA\_22\_06 # But I [am] a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people.

am a young <u>09\_1SA\_30\_13</u> # And David said unto him, To whom [belongest] thou? and whence [art] thou? And he said, I [am] a young man of Egypt, servant to an Amalekite; and my master left me, because three days ago I fell sick.

am able to <u>40\_MAT\_09\_28</u># And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord.

am able to <u>40\_MAT\_26\_61</u># And said, This [fellow] said, I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to build it in three days.

am about to 14\_2CH\_02\_09 # Even to prepare me timber in abundance: for the house which I am about to build [shall be] wonderful great.

am Abraham's servant 01\_GEN\_24\_34 # And he said, I [am] Abraham's servant.

am according to <u>18\_JOB\_33\_06</u># Behold, I [am] according to thy wish in God's stead: I also am formed out of the clay.

am accused of <u>44\_ACT\_26\_02</u># I think myself happy, king Agrippa, because I shall answer for myself this day before thee touching all the things whereof I am accused of the Jews:

am afraid and <u>18\_JOB\_21\_06</u># Even when I remember I am afraid, and trembling taketh hold on my flesh.

am afraid I 19\_PSA\_56\_03 # What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee.

am afraid of 48\_GAL\_04\_11 # I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain.

am afraid of <u>24\_JER\_38\_19</u> # And Zedekiah the king said unto Jeremiah, I am afraid of the Jews that are fallen to the Chaldeans, lest they deliver me into their hand, and they mock me.

am afraid of 18\_JOB\_09\_28 # I am afraid of all my sorrows, I know that thou wilt not hold me innocent.

am afraid of 18\_JOB\_23\_15 # Therefore am I troubled at his presence: when I consider, I am afraid of him.

am afraid of 19\_PSA\_119\_120 # My flesh trembleth for fear of thee; and I am afraid of thy judgments.

am after thee <u>08\_RUT\_04\_04</u># And I thought to advertise thee, saying, Buy [it] before the inhabitants, and before the elders of my people. If thou wilt redeem [it], redeem [it]: but if thou wilt not redeem [it, then] tell me, that I may know: for [there is] none to redeem [it] beside thee; and I [am] after thee.
